## FEAST OF MOST HOLY NAME OF JESUS

THE 150TH. ANNIVERSARY of the Battle of New Orleans will be observed during the week of January 1 - 8th. Our Lady of Prompt Succor was influential in the Battle of New Orleans. This feast day will be observed on January 8th. Special prayers will be read on January 5, 6, 7th. after the morning Masses at the Rectory Chapel.

All are invited to the Open House at Ursuline on January 8th from 1:30 to 3:30 pm. Mementos and historical souvenirs preserved by the Ursuline Nuns since 1815 will be on display. ON FRIDAY JANUARY 8th, we are dispensed from the law of abstinence and may eat meat.

OPERATION UNDERSTANDING: The Catholic, Protestant, Evangelical, Orthodox and Jewish churches of the New Orleans area will participate in the second "Operation Understanding" program during the month of January. All are urged to visit the churches and temples of other faiths in order to spread understanding. This year's program is dedicated to the memory of Archbishop Joseph F. Rummel.

TEST PILINGS HAVE BEEN DRIVEN on our Church site. Though the construction of our Church and school is in its preliminary stages, nonetheless work has begun. The cost of these facilities, unfurnished, is \$711,200.00. The two floors will include some 50,000 sq.ft. of church and school. ST. 



## FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

IN SEPTEMBER WE WILL OPEN ST. ANGELA SCHOOL. We will definitely have a Kindergarten, half-day style, with one group in the morning and one in the afternoon. Classes will be available for children from the first grade through the fifth grade, adding a grade thereafter each year. Ultimately the school will accomodate the children through the eighth grade. The official registration will take place in April according to the Archdiocesan schedule. More information about the school uniforms and tuition will be given in the very near future.

THE URSULINE NUNS will staff our school. As yet we do not know the exact number of nuns we will receive in September. We are now in the process of interviewing degreed lay teachers who will complete the faculty. Anyone interested should get in touch with the pastor. It will be the policy of St. Angela School no to overcrowd classrooms.

THE UNITED CATHOLIC EDUCATIONAL FUND will be a pledge type campaign for funds to establish new High Schools in the Archdiocese and also to expand existing schools - in our area Rummel and Chapelle Schools will be expanded. Though St. Angela Parish has had its own campaign for parochial facilities, we will participate in the Archdiocesan Campaign. The established quota for our parish is \$20,000. All pledges in excess of this quota will revert to our parish funds. More news about the Campaign is covered in the Clarion Herald.



## QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY





## ST. ANGELA SCHOOL REGISTRATION

Registration for St. Angela Merici school will take place on April 1st, 10:00 to 12 noon and 1:00 to 3:00 pm., and on April 3rd, 10:00 to 12 noon and 1:00 to 3:00 pm. at Leon's, 706 Phosphor Ave.

This registration will serve as an application for entrance into St. Angela school. Notification of acceptance into school will be sent to families shortly after the registration. Registrations will be accepted for Kindergarten, First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth grades. All entering Kindergarten must be 5 years old by December 31st. All entering First grade must be 6 years old by December 31st.

The following tuition scale has been set for St. Angela Merici School:

Kindergarten ------\$10.00 per child (no exceptions)

Grades First thru Fifth ------ \$10.00 one child \$18.00 two children

\$25.00 three or more children

Tuition will be paid in 10 monthly installments. The first month's tuition must be paid when a child is notified that he or she is accepted for school. The date and time for this will be sent to the family. In the event a child does not attend our school the payment will be refunded. There will be no extra registration fee. Families who are not in a position to afford full tuition should make private arrangements with Father Calato. Please phone for an appointment.

Only qualified teachers who are College graduates will be hired for St. Angela school. Enrollment will be limited to a maximum of 40 children per classroom - no exceptions. Kindergarten will be a half day - one class in the morning and one class in the afternoon. Grades First thru Fifth will be a full day. Kindergarten tuition is seperate and does not come under the Family Plan.

On the day of registration, no records will be required. Once a child has been notified of his acceptance, the following certificates will be required:

- 1 Baptismal Record
- 2 Certified Birth Certificate
- 3 Health Record

Children now attending a Catholic school need not furnish the above certificates; we will procure them from the schools.
