PASSION SUNDAY

THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT is quickly coming to a very dramatic climax as we again review and re-live the passion and death of Our Lord Jesus Christ. As these memories of our redemption unfold before us, His graces are renewed in our lives. By participation in the Liturgy of Holy Week, we actually receive the same graces and the same blessings as His Blessed Mother and St. John did. We like them should stand at the foot of the cross, ever ready to promote His cause so that He might not have died in vain.

ON SUNDAY COMING our men will again go out to solicit pledges for the United Catholic Educational Fund. The men will meet at Leon's at 1:30 pm. They are being asked to work only for 3 hours, until 4:30 pm. Last Sunday our 77 workers did a tremendous job of contacting more than 400 families. This Sunday we hope to complete the job. More workers are needed to make the task less difficult. Our quota for this campaign is \$20,000. Thus far we have pledged totaling \$10,589. On Sunday, with the cooperation of families yet to be contacted we hope to go over the top. For the convenience of those who will not be home, our workers will set up booths in the warehouse next to Leon's after all the Masses on Sunday. It is hoped that every family can see its way clear to give a minimum of \$40 over a period of eight months.

TIMELY REMARKS: Archbishop Hallinan of Atlanta recently made the following remarks concerning the changes in the Liturgy. We quote: "Adaptation is essential if the church is going to meet the new needs and challenge of the modern world. Those who oppose change do not realize that they are serving not the church, but their own tastes. Gently but firmly and constantly, all must be reminded that these changes are the law and spirit of the 20th century catholicism. It is folly for Catholics to keep voting for the 19th century. We are close to the 21st."

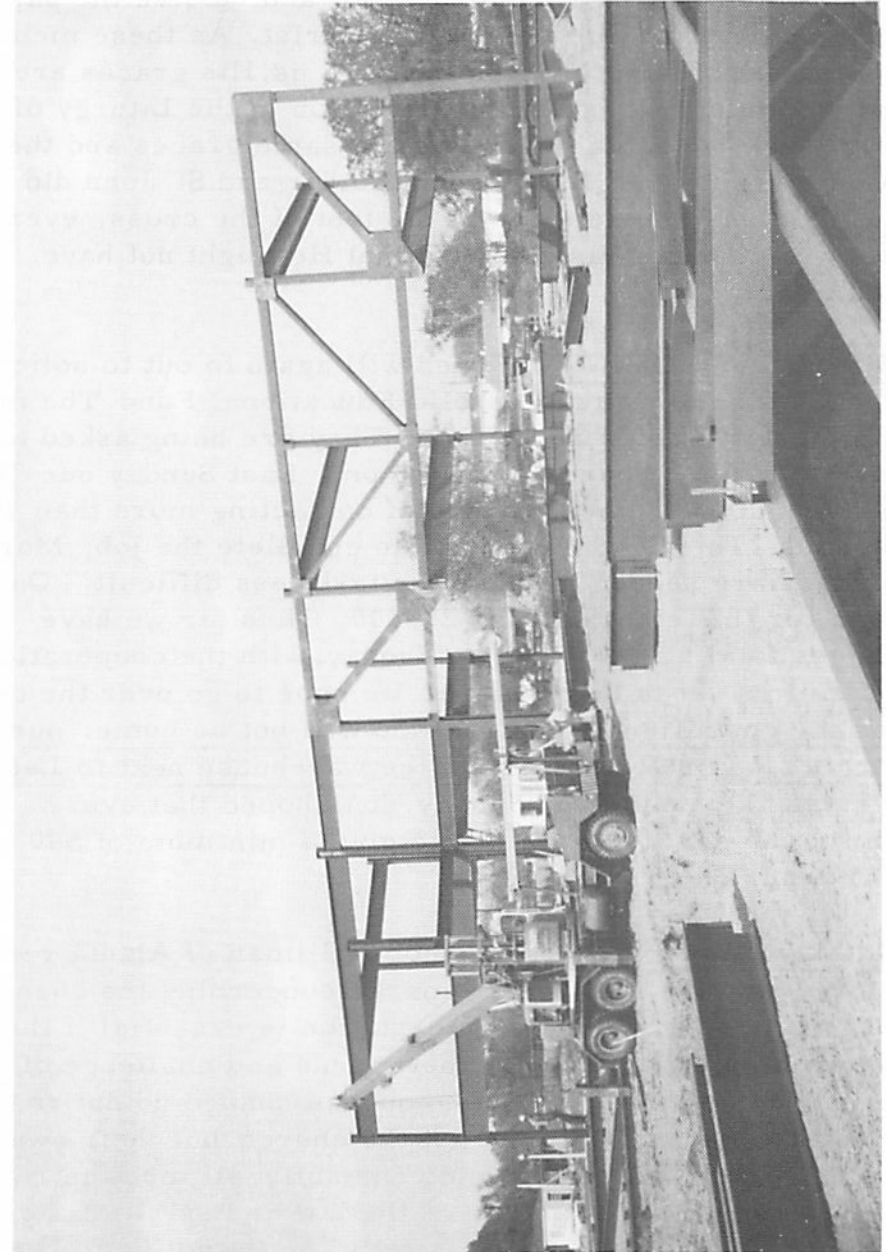

PALM SUNDAY

PALM SUNDAY ushers in Holy Week. This is the time of year when we re-live, through the liturgical services, the Passion and death of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Every Christian should with spiritual fervor enter into thoughtful consideration of his eternal salvation. This coming week is a time to slow down the wheels of fast worldly and materialistic movement. The great truths of our faith will be expressed during this week. Be dedicated followers of Our Lord and participate in the services each day during Holy Week.

PLEASE NOTIFY THE RECTORY of all persons who are sick or aged. Holy Communion will be brought to the homes on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of Holy Week.

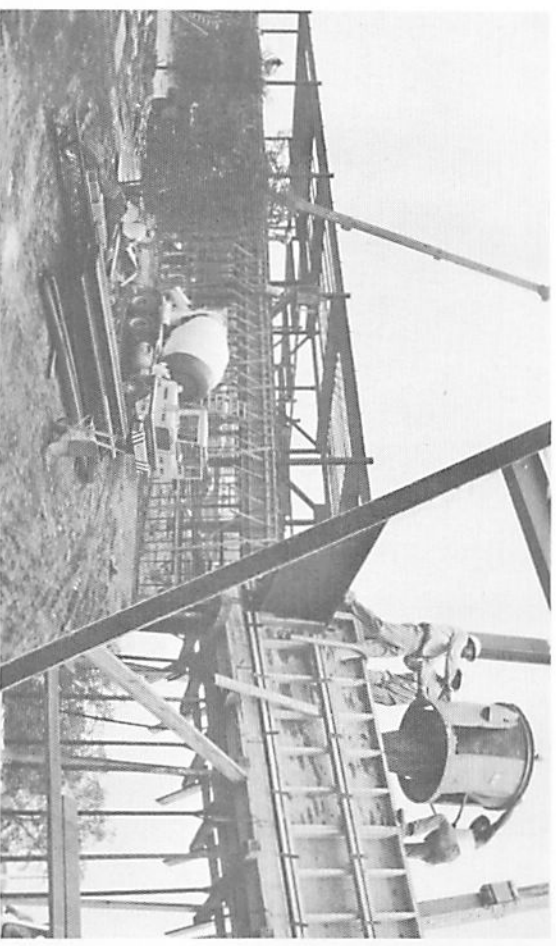

THIRD SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

SUNDAY IS MOTHER'S DAY. One of the greatest blessings for a woman is to be a mother. Herein she cooperates with Almighty God in the beautiful and mysterious forming of new human life. Father and mother produce a new life that will be endless both on the face of the earth and in the eternity of the hereafter. And only to a mother is given the intimacy and mystical insight into the eyes of her child. 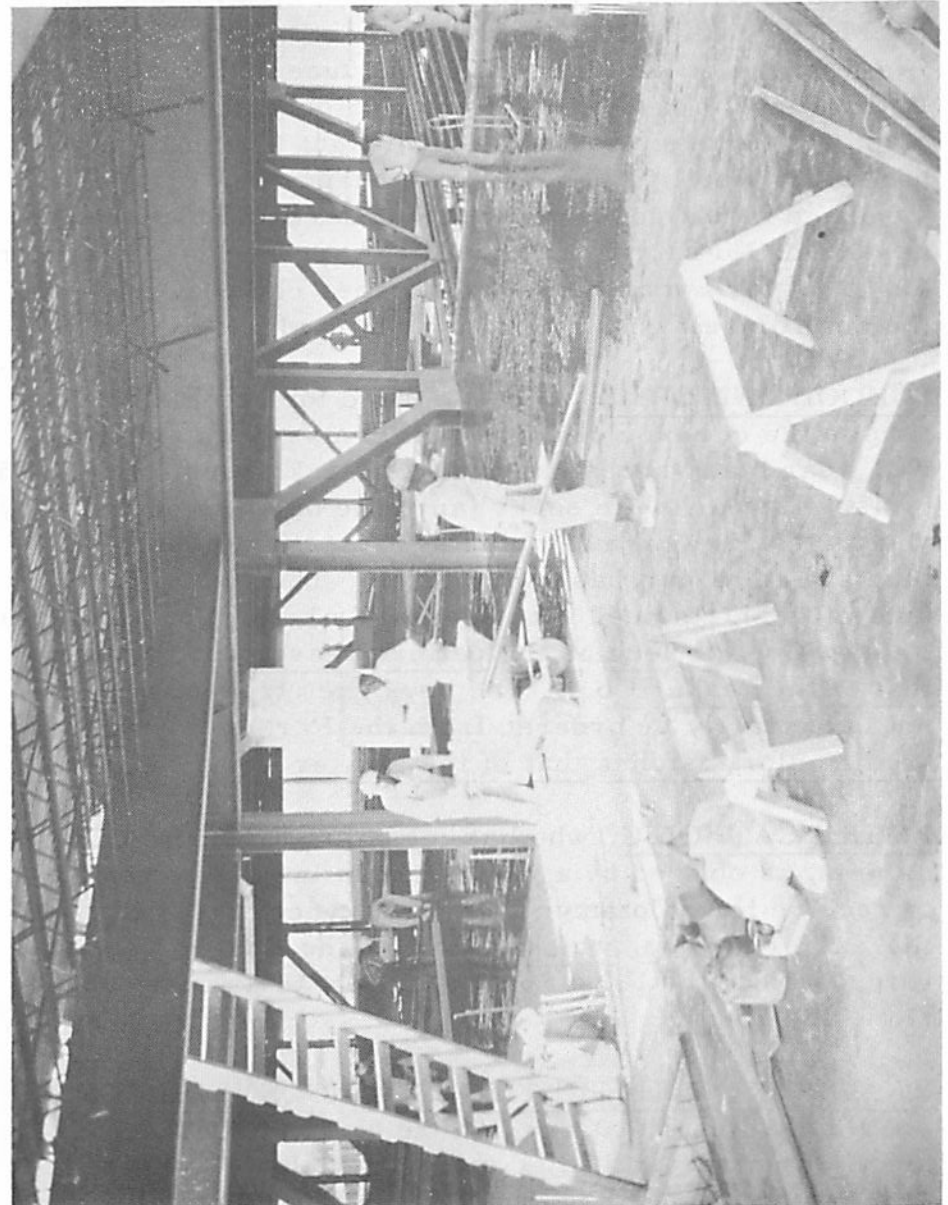

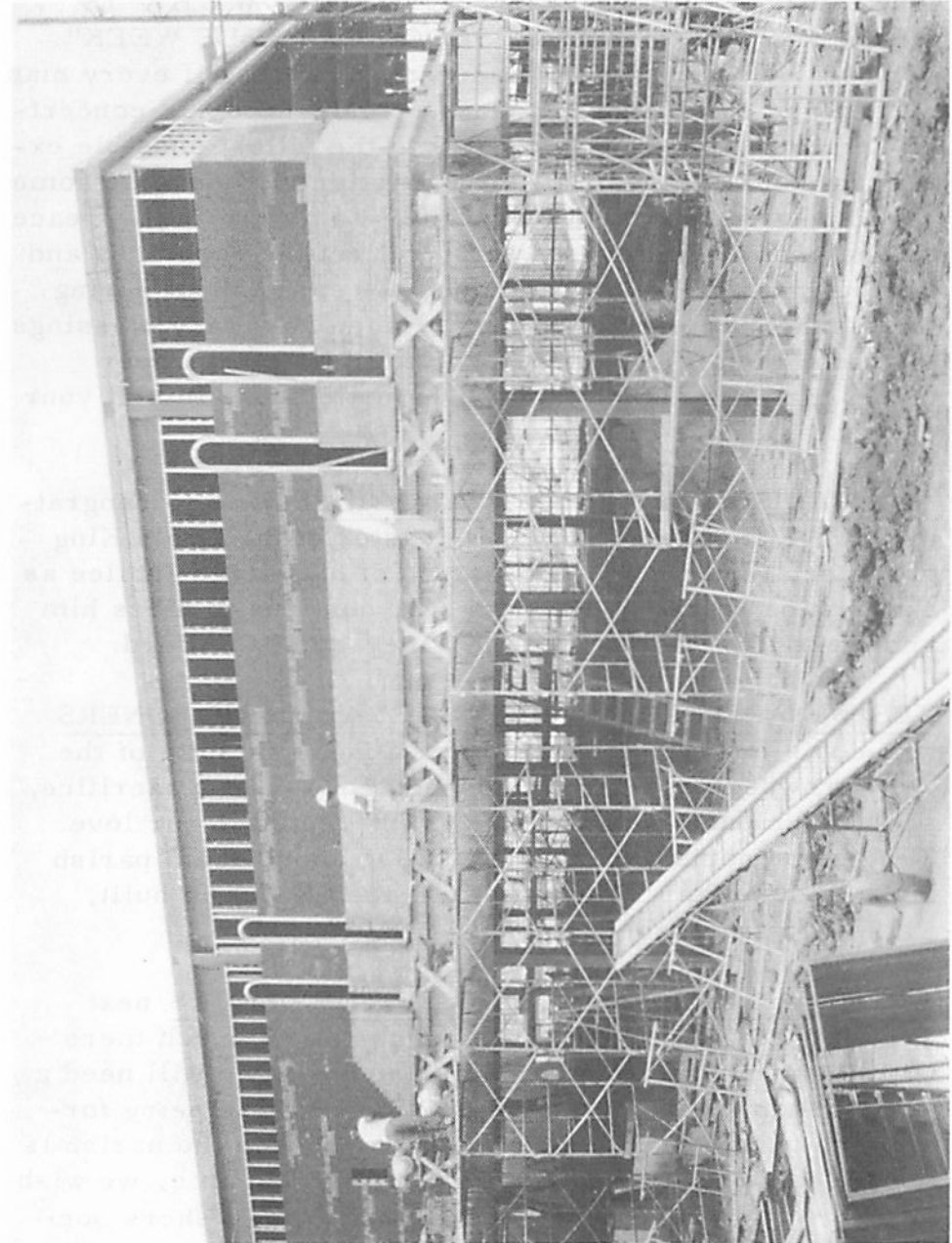

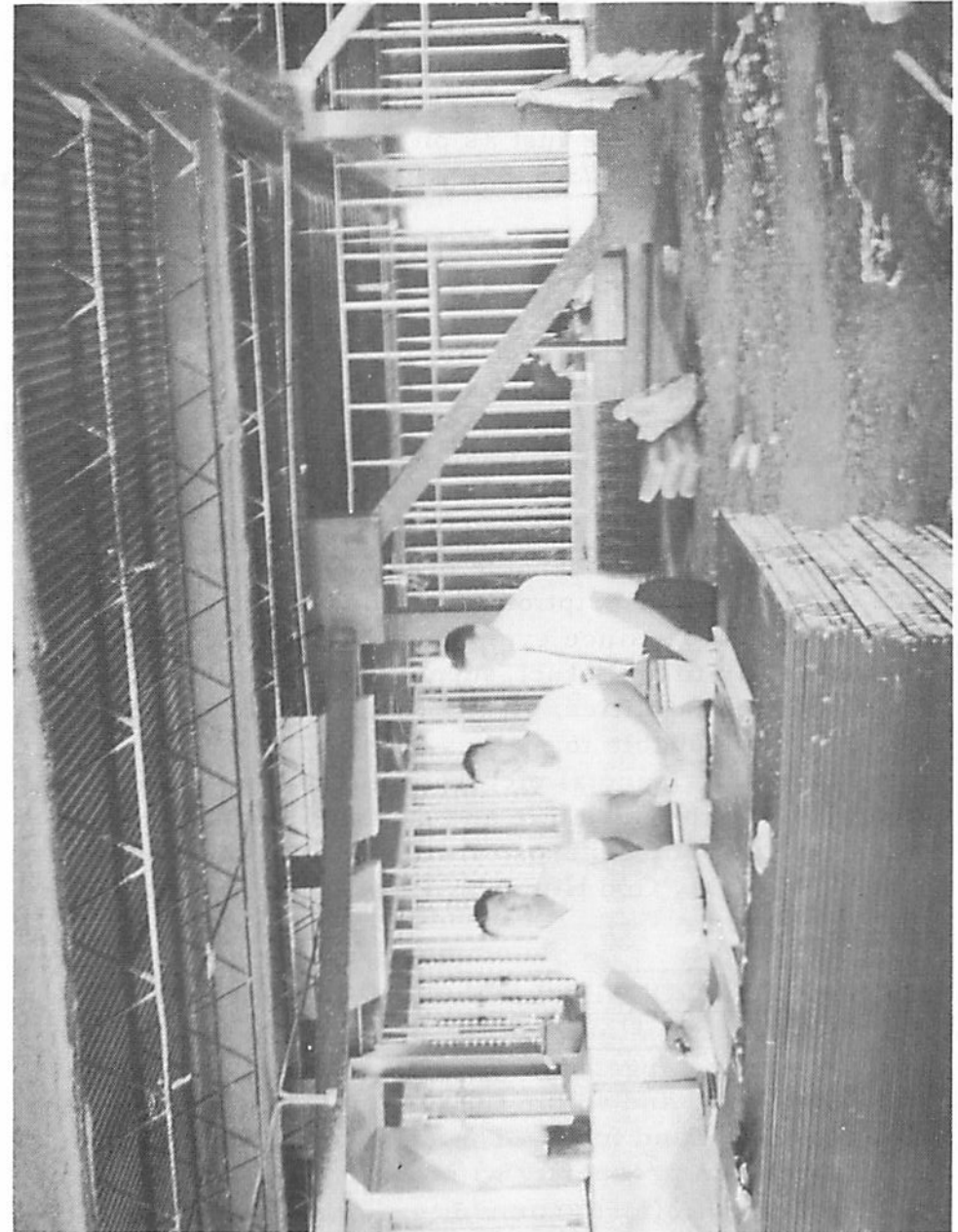

Enthusiasm, zeal, a willingness to sacrifice and to volunteer and work steadily and with momentum began to express themselves in many parishioners who were now determined to solidly establish in their midst a "City of God". With Church and school soon to be completed, our work has only begun. With the protection of St. Angela Merici, and Almighty God on our side, and evidence of fuller cooperation from more of our parishioners, we cannot fail!

ABOUT ST. ANGELA MERICI

In the sixteenth century, a young Italian girl by the name of Angela Merici dedicated her life to the task of Catholic education. In a vision to Angela it was made clear by God that she was to found a teaching order of nuns. She began her work in Brescia, Italy. God informed Angela that she was to wait before founding her convent. After 40 years of devoting her life to those in need, God's will was made known to her that the time was at hand. She immediately formed a teaching order of nuns and named them after their patroness of Christian education St. Ursula (hence the name Ursuline Nuns). In 1727, the Ursuline Nuns arrived in New Orleans as the first women's missionary group in the New World. In September 1965, the Ursuline Nuns will heed the spirit of St. Angela and staff our Parish school dedicated to their dauntless foundress.
