

FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

IT'S A SUNDAY MORNING. From a restful sleep he awakens. Last night he decided to go to the 9:45 morning Mass and now the clock reads 10:00 am. "I can get to Leon's easily by 11 am.". He enters the church with a missal in his hand fifteen minutes before Mass time. "Lord, I love you and thank you for another opportunity to worship you again", he murmurs as he genuflects before the Real Presence of Christ in the tabernacle. "Lord this past week has been rather a rough one, so many things happened, I almost forgot all about you. Please forgive me...help me this week... here I am again this morning to offer You to my Father in heaven with my fellow parishioners... you know this Mass is really crowded this morning... how do they get this many in... here comes the commentator. 

SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Imagine, that small wafer of bread and the wine in the chalice will be changed into the Body and Blood of Jesus. God loves us so much that He sends His Son into the world to be in our midst. LOSS OF LIVES, HUMAN MISERY, TOTAL CONFUSION were the effects of the worse hurricane that crippled our city in decades. "Betsy" was vicious in the pain that it afflicted. The flood victims are especially in distress. Such a storm, though terrible and devastating, brought out two great qualities among our people. First, the complete willingness on the part of all to be of service to their neighbor. Secondly the gratitude on the part of all that it could have been worse.

THESE TWO EXPRESSIONS were most apparent on the part of the more than 600 persons who sought refuge in our school. There was orderliness and charity prevailed. Our nuns did a marvelous job not only in our school the night of the storm but also in a shelter center for the aftermath flood victims. All agencies of our civil parishes worked untiringly and without sleep. The National Guard is still on duty doing its share.

ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, from 9 am to 1 pm, there will be open house at our new school for all to walk thru and visit. There will be no ceremony as such, only an opportunity for all to visit and see. So after Mass on Sunday, take a drive over with the family.


