SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

PARISH HIGH SCHOOL OF RELIGION: Our opening night last Monday revealed that 65 students registered for the classes. There are still many students who have not yet registered. We are relying on the good will of all families involved to send their children to class on Monday night from 7 to 8 pm, in our school building. All students 7th thru 12th grades, attending a Public or Private High school are expected to attend. Parents have a serious moral obligation, binding under sin, to send their child.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL OF RELIGION for all children attending a Public school or Private school, will start on Saturday, October 2nd, from 9 am to 10:30 am, in our school building. Parents should accompany their child for registration. Please bring child's Baptismal certificate. Registration fee for books will be three dollars for each child. Children who do not enroll now will be ineligible for Communion and Confirmation later on in the school year. There will be no last minute registration when Communion and Confirmation dates are announced. Likewise, any child who does not continue religious instructions after First Communion will be held back for Confirmation.

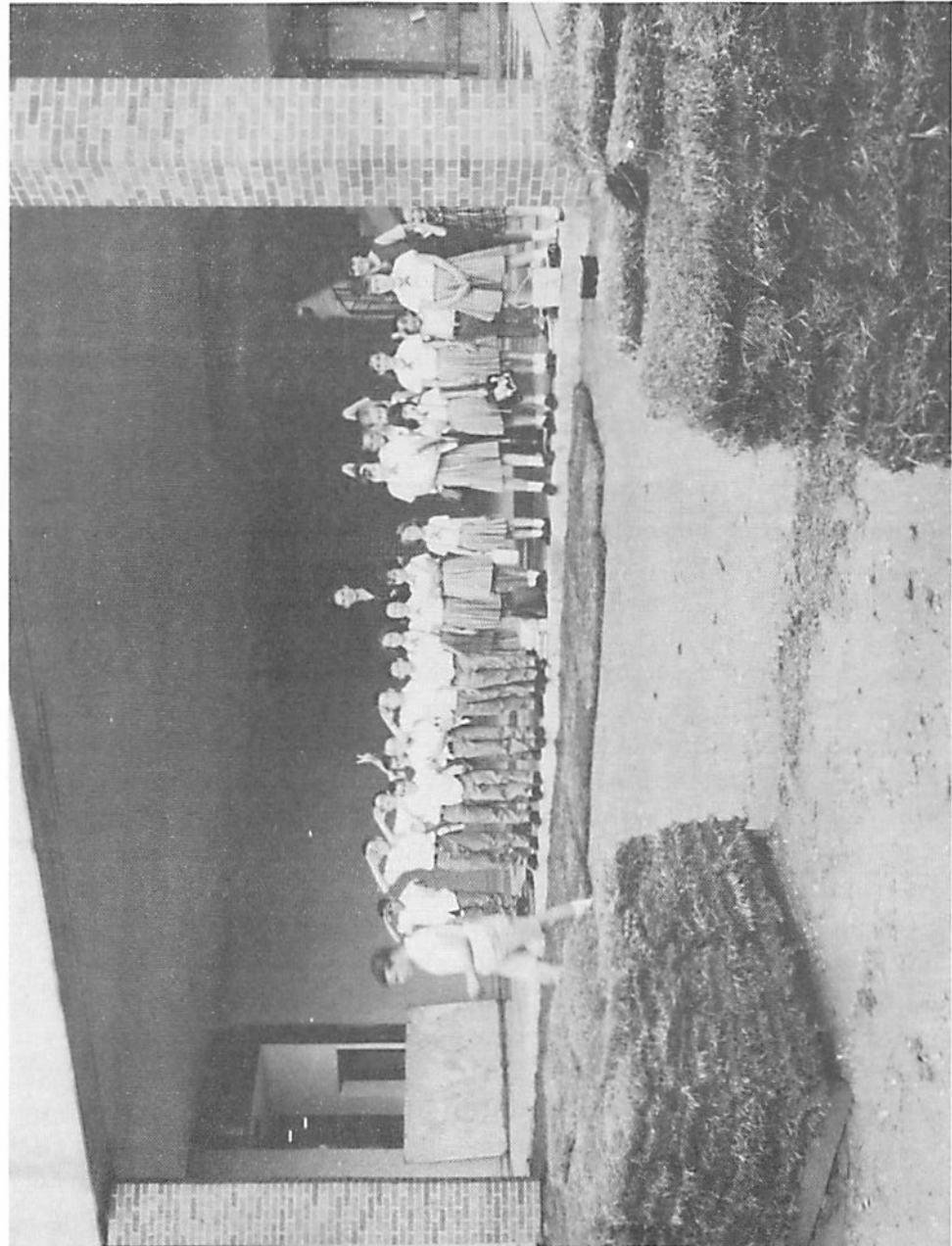

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

EFFECTIVE SUNDAY, OCTOBER 17th, we open the doors of our new church. Even though the church will not be completely furnished and ready in every detail, it will be sufficiently functional to have Sunday Masses. The Rectory Chapel will continue to be used for confessions, Sunday Baptisms and weekday Masses. In our church, chairs will be used until our pews are ready. If you notice various items missing, rest assured that they will be delivered and installed at a later date. The formal dedication of the church will take place only when all furnishings are in place.

IT WAS DECIDED to open our church because of the tremendous need for more space. Since June 1, 1964, when our parish was founded, we have used the facilities of Mr. & Mrs. Marion Leon, 706 Phosphor Ave. This family has asked absolutely no remuneration for their hall. St. Angela Parish will always owe them a debt of gratitude! God in His own inimitable way will certainly bless them! And so this Sunday will be the last Sunday at Leon's.

A PARISH CENSUS WILL BE TAKEN BY THE MEN OF THE PARISH. Attached to this Message is a census form. Each family is asked to fill it out completely and seal it in a plain envelope. Beginning on Sunday, a church worker will call on your home to pick up the envelope. Please do not mail the census back to the rectory. Hold until a worker calls on you. Our workers will visit every family within the boundaries of our parish. Families who are Catholic and are not registered in the parish will be given a census card to fill out. This will be the first activity of our newly formed block system. The block system means that every block in the parish will have a "block couple" through whom most parish organizations will operate.
