

SEPTUAGESIMA SUNDAY

"I GO TO MASS EVERY SUNDAY. I PUT MY MONEY IN THE COLLECTION. WHAT MORE DOES THE PRIEST WANT ME TO DO?" Familiar words aren't they? If you have never spoken them, perhaps your inner attitude has reflected them. Hundreds and hundreds of parishioners fit into the above category. In our own area we have seen the expansion of facilities both at Rummel and Chapelle High Schools from funds received during last year's campaign. 





FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT

NEW FASTING AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS:

1. The law of abstinence on all Friday remains the same except that it begins to bind from the age of 14 instead of 7 years of age. 2. The only fast days are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; fast days affect persons, ages 21 to 60.

3. Students in elementary, junior and senior high schools, who are 14 years or age or older, are dispensed during school hours from abstinence on all Fridays. This applies whether they provide their own lunch or eat in the cafeteria. This dispensation also applies to all school personnel (cafeteria workers, faculty members, etc) during school hours. This dispensation (#3) has been granted by Archbishop Hannan for the Archdiocese in order to ease cafeteria problems where some students are over the 14 year old age limit.

LENTEN SCHEDULE OF SERVICES: Daily Masses at 6:15 & 8:30 am. Evening Mass every Wednesday at 6 pm. Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 2 pm and 7:30 pm.

CHILDREN OF THE PARISH will receive their First Holy Communion on Sunday, March 20th, at the 8:30 am Mass. The children will wear First Communion gowns, that may be rented. Children from Public and Private schools, who are in the second grade and have received religious instructions, are eligible for their First Holy Communion. The parents with children in Private schools should come to our school on Saturday, February 26th, at 9:30 am with their child for measurement.





THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT

Dear Parishioners:

May I have just a minute or so of your time to acquaint you with the latest development of the organization of our parish into 16 geographic areas. Each area has an Area Couple with a Block Couple in each block of the parish. Our parish is comprised of some 256 blocks.

The entire purpose of this system is to vitalize the Christian living of the whole parish. It envisions a more personal and direct envolvement on the part of the majority of the parishioners. The block couples will act as liaisons between the priest of the parish and all the parishioners. Such aspects as greeting new families who move into the block and notifying the priests of persons who are sick, are some of the duties they would perform.

The priests of the parish have set aside every Monday and Thursday nights as likely days when they would be available to visit with the Block Couples and families on their block. Such a visit would be sponsored by the Block Couple for the priest to meet all the families and perhaps bless their homes, say the rosary, discuss some parochial affairs, or any similar type program that the Block Couple might think interesting and attractive. The Block Couples should contact their Area Coordinator for direction and advice.

With 1700 families in our parish, this type of organizational structure lends itself very nicely for a closely knitted family-oriented parish. All the area coordinators are responsible for their Block Couples. The Block Couples form the most important link in this set-up. The rise or fall of the block system will depend almost completely upon them.

Please pray for the success of this organization. It will mean that we the Family of God will get closer to Our Father in Heaven. Ask St. Angela to bless this plan.


