EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

POPE PAUL VI appeals to the entire Catholic world to recite the daily rosary for world peace during the month of October. Every person as he reads this will admit that he is interested in a cease-fire in Viet-Nam and the establishment of true peace. One of the methods to accomplish this is to pray sincerely for world peace. October 4th has been designated by Pope Paul as "World Day of Prayer for Peace". Bishop Caillouet will offer a Mass on this date at the Shrine of Our Lady of Prompt Succor at 5:30 pm. The St. Angela Merici Parish observance will be on the same day at 8:30 am, with Mass and special prayers. EVERY DAY DURING OCTOBER the rosary and the prayer to st. Joseph will be recited after the 8:30 am. Come to Mass every day and pray for world peace. ALL BLOCK COUPLES are encouraged to hold a

block rosary in their block each week and promote the daily rosary in every home for world peace. (Remember the war years when our churches were packed as our 11 million Americans donned the Service Uniform.) TOWARDS THE END OF OCTOBER a special Mass for all service men and women in the Armed Forces will be offered at St. Angela's. TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

ST. ANGELA MERICI PARISH BLOCK COUPLE PROGRAM

Our parish is organized on a block system with one couple designated as the block couple who is responsible for aiding the parochial priests in the fullfillment of bringing the love of Christ and neighbor to the other couples of the block. Then the specific blocks are grouped in areas with area coordinating couples assigned to work between the priests and the block couples. These couples are truly an extension of the priest into their particular environment. The couples accomplish this "extended priesthood" first of all by their own example. They have been selected by the priests because they have been recommended by other couples as having the qualifications necessary - their love of God and their neighbor.

Through their leadership, they guide the couples of the block in their joint loving of God and neighbor. This can and will take many different forms of action in each specific area as decided upon by the couples themselves, in conjunction with the Pastor, and as dictated by the needs of a particular area.

They can take the form of keeping the Pastor informed of times when he is specifically needed, such as an illness, death, a spiritual difficulty, or any other situation that the couple may determine may be of concern for the priest; welcoming new couples into the parish; bringing the liturgy into each home according to the season, or at the approaching reception of a particular sacrament; serving as a dissemination system for information of immediate importance to all parishioners; and keeping the parish census up to date. These are but a few of the many practical applications of the works of the block couples in helping to make our parish become more united and one.

The direct result of this participation of the block couples in the bringing of Christ into each family of the parish is an increase of their love of God and their love of neighbor, the fullfillment of Christ's mandate, and the attainment of heaven. 

FIRST SUNDAY IN ADVENT

We begin the new church year. We prepare for the coming of Christ on Christmas night. This is a time for extra prayers and penance. As Catholics, we of all people, should set the pace by praerful preparation for Christmas. 
