





QUINQUAGESIMA SUNDAY

My dear Parishioners,

The Holy Season of Lent is now upon us again. It is well that you reflect seriously on the many opportunities that are yours for the taking to improve your relationship with Almighty God. During Lent you must choose your own type of penance and sacrifices! The Church has removed all fasting and abstinence on a compulsory basis. This does not mean that you are without real obligation. It simply means that you should do things pleasing to God because you really want to! Out of your own free will and out of love for God, you are encouraged to observe Lent in a prayerful and penitential spirit.

As your pastor, who is concerned about your spiritual welfare, may I suggest some practices that will in a way bring you closer to God during Lent?

- 1. Attend daily Mass and receive Holy Communion.
- 2. Fast and abstain on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent.
- 3. Be more kind and considerate to your neighbor, esp. the ones who really grate on your nerves.
- 4. Spend at least five minutes a day (all alone) speaking to God about yourself just how do you stand in His sight (this could be very revealing).
- 5. And whatever you decide to do during Lent, do it because you really want to. Without this generosity, it might be better to do nothing and pray for a better disposition later on. At least be honest with yourself!

I truly wish that every member of your family read this short letter. Good parents will question their children about their Lenten resolutions.

Dear Parishioners:

Last Sunday I announced the St. Angela's Expansion Program in conjunction with the current U.C.E.F. Drive. Our goal is to get \$75,000.00 in pledges. Of this amount \$27,500.00 will be used towards our UCEF obligation. As announced by the Archbishop, fifty percent of this (\$13,750.00) will be applied to our parish debt. But why a goal of \$75,000.00?

I have received permission to construct a permanent type building immediately if we can finance it now. This building will take care of our school needs, through the eighth grade, until we are in a better financial position to add the third floor to our school-church building. If we do not make this goal of \$75,000.00, permission has been denied by the Archdiocesan Building Commission to add any more classrooms for September.

As you know, all 20 classrooms in our school are present being utilized. In other words, if we do not make the St. Angela's Expansion Program a success, we will be forced to platoon our school in September, 1967.

This new building will be permanent and will be used for parish meeting and socials and actually only temporarily serve as classroom facilities.

I know this involves a great sacrifice for every family. This tremendous step forward is being taken only because of your generous and progressive spirit in the past. Though our parish will be only three years old this coming June 1st, your vote of confidence now makes the St.Angela's Expansion Program a mandate!

We need man power! A general meeting of all men in the parish will be held on TUESDAY, MARCH 28th, AT 8:00 p.m. in our school building. Men, circle your calendar now! You will hear more and see the plans for this new facility in subsequent Messages.

Pray for the success of this undertaking.






