SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

MORE CHANGES IN THE MASS: As you have already read the Canon of the Mass will be in English. This will come when we receive the English translation somewhere around December. In order that the liturgical renewal may be more closely realized and make further progress, the following changes will go into effect on June 29th:

- 1) The priest will genuflect only:
 - a) when he goes to and come away from the altar.
 - b) after the elevation of the host and the chalice.
 - c) after the doxology at the end of the Canon.
 - d) at the Communion before he elevates the host.
 - e) when hosts have been placed in the tabernacle.

All other genuflecions are omitted.

- 2) The priest kisses the altar only at the beginning of the Mass. All other kisses of the altar are omitted.
- 3) The priest makes only one sign of the cross over the offerings at the beginning of the Canon.

All other signs of the cross are omitted.

- 4) At Communion, the priest takes the big host, holds
 It up and says, "Beholds the Lamb of God..." then he
 receives the host and drinks from the chalice and he
 then distributes Communion to all in the usual way.
- 5) At the end of the Mass, the blessing is given before the dismissal. In other words, the priest gives his blessing and then says, "The Mass is ended. Go in peace".

There are other changes in the Mass, but this only for the priest and you will not notice them. One must always remember that the Mass has not changed, merely some of the outwards signs have changed. And this is to make the Mass more easy to follow and to understand.


