TWENTIETH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

WATCH OVER YOUR CONDUCT; do not act like fools; do not be thoughtless; do not get drunk. This is the admonition we hear from the Word of God in Sunday's Sacred Liturgy. At Mass on Sunday, you will be urged by the Word of God in the Epistle (not at the insistence of your priests) to "express yourselves in psalms, hymns and inspired songs singing and praising the Lord with all your heart". As we begin the New Year of 1968, may I take this opportunity to personally greet you and your family with best wishes for a year filled with plentiful graces and blessings from Almighty God. Father Jerry and Father Hoppe share in these sentiments.

The year of 1967 was a good one for St. Angela's Parish. Our parish now numbers close to 2000 Catholic families, with some 100 families moving into our community during the past year. Each Sunday, some 4000 parishioners attend Mass to keep the Lord's Day holy and blessed. Not only did Mass attendance increase, but also the number of parishioners receiving Holy Communion. And this truly indicates the spiritual growth of a parish. Hopefully the spirit of Christian Charity among parishioners has been stepped up by our Block System. The successful Thanksgiving Day gifts to the poor will bear this out.

There has been physical growth also. Our new annex building was constructed during the summer months when many said it couldn't be done. You came through for the financing. Our parish, last fiscal year, was number "one" throughout the Archdiocese in total receipts forwarded to the "Central Finance". Our school has 946 children, Kindergarten thru the Seventh Grade. The addition to the rectory was made by the men of the parish, with donations from here and there, with no increase in the parish's debt. Our debt is now \$700,000.00 but the total output of funds to construct and furnish our parish is in excess of \$1,200,000.00. So you have been generous during the three and one-half years since our parish was founded.

Any thinking person knows that these accomplishments cannot be realized by just one or several persons. So these are all to the credit of you the parishioners. Some of you have truly been sleeping, but I am consoled by the fact that a person cannot always sleep. Happy New Year.


