PALM SUNDAY

SUNDAY IS PALM SUNDAY. The blessing of the Palms will take place at 9:30 a.m. near the annex building with procession into the Church. This officially begins Holy Week. During Holy Week you can relive and more deeply appreciate what Jesus Christ did for each one of us. Every parishioner should receive the Sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion during the week. Please note the many opportunities to attend services during the week. Please save for reference.

FLOWERS WILL BE NEEDED FOR HOLY THURSDAY AND EASTER SUNDAY. Easter lilies or white flowers may be brought to the Church on Holy Thursday morning and on Holy Saturday morning.

ON HOLY THURSDAY (at 7:30 pm) AND GOOD FRIDAY (at 3:00 pm) the nursery will be open for the convenience of parents. However, please bring child on time.

THE FIRST MASS in what is now the Archdiocese of New Orleans was offered on March 3, 1699. The place was a spot on the bank of the Mississippi River near Mardi Gras Bayou in Plaquemines Parish. This and other historic events will be recalled in a pageant preceding the Field Mass in Tad Gormly Stadium (City Park) on Sunday, April 28, at 4:00 pm d.s.t. These ceremonies are in keeping with the 250th anniversary of New Orleans and the 175th anniversary of the Archdiocese of New Orleans. New Orleans is the second oldest diocese in the United States (Baltimore is the oldest).

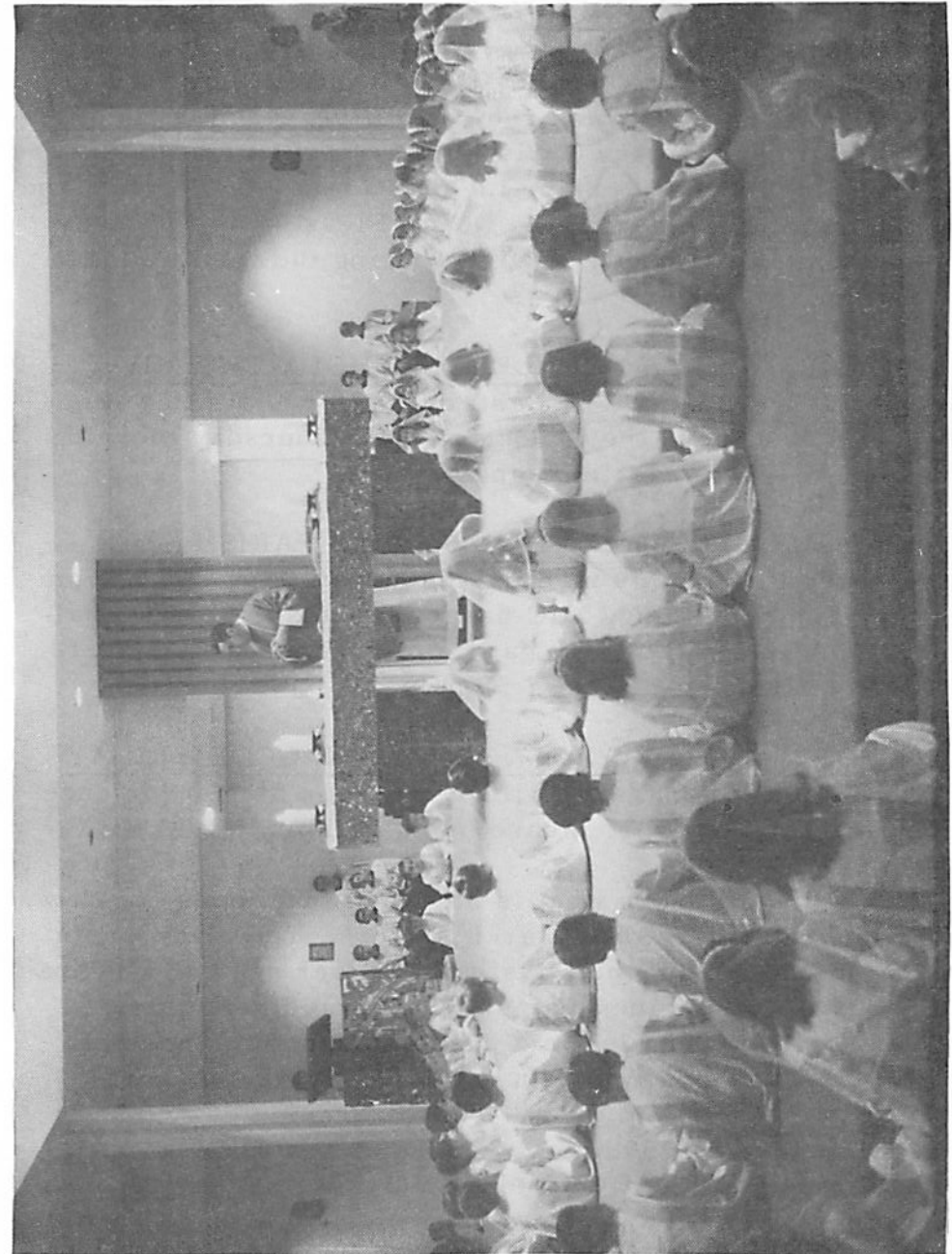

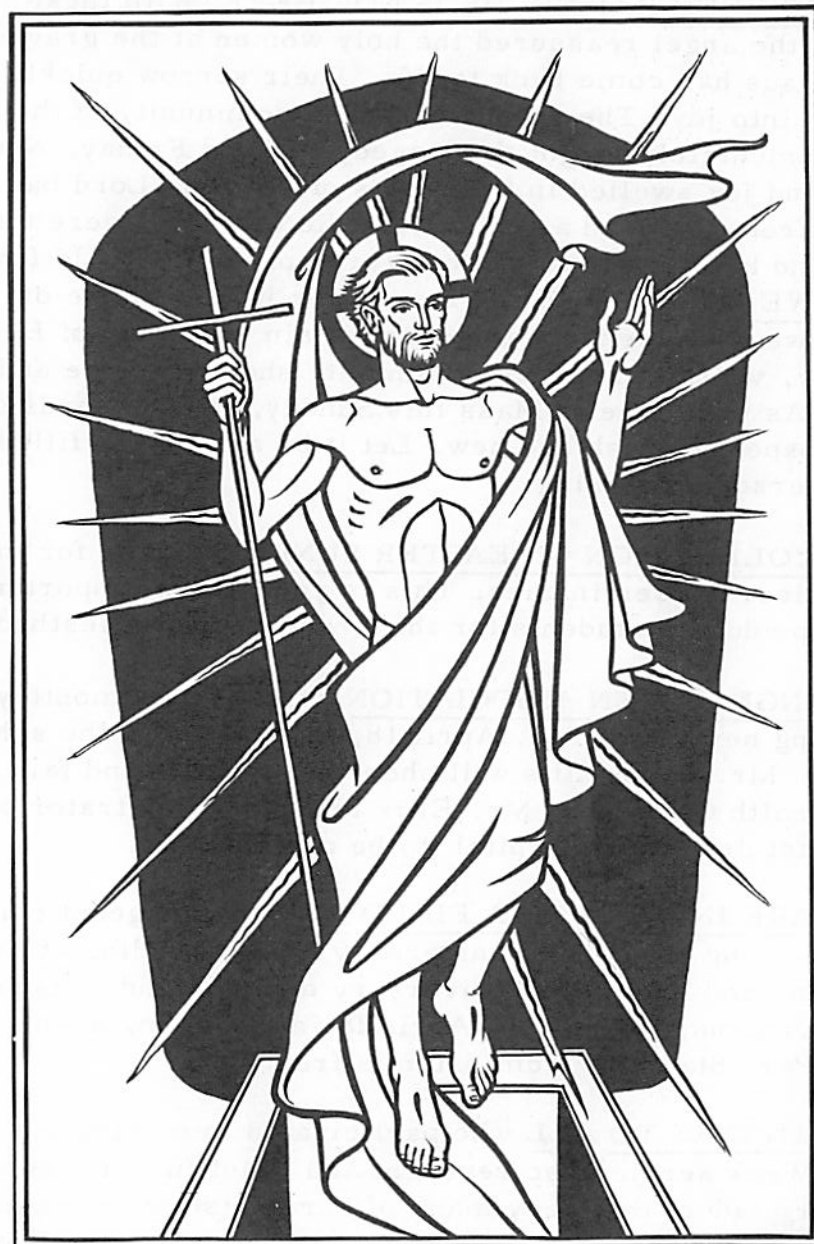

FIRST SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

ON APRIL 25, 1793 (175 YEARS AGO) Pope Pius VI issued the decree of erection of the diocese of Louisiana and the Two Floridas. The first bishop was Don Luis Penalver y Cardenas, a native of Havana. New Orleans became an Archdiocese on July 19, 1850 and its fourth bishop, Antoine Blanc, became first Archbishop. Archbishop Philip M. Hannan, the eleventh metropolitan, will be the chief concelebrant of the Mass of thanksgiving on Sunday, April 28th, at City Park Stadium. He will have as concelebrants two auxiliary bishops and fifteen priests representing the diocesan and religious clergy who have served this area for nearly 250 years. All are invited to the Mass and to the pageant which will precede it at 4:00 p. m. Holy Communion will be distributed at the Mass.

SECOND SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

SUNDAY, APRIL 28TH, marks the official observance by the Archdiocese of the 250th anniversary of the founding of New Orleans and the 175th of the establishment of our Archdiocese. This dual observance will be marked by a pageant and a concelebrated Mass at 4:00 pm in City Park Stadium. An attendance of at least 25,000 persons is anticipated for the Mass of Thanksgiving. Printed programs will be distributed at the stadium. They will contain the outline of the pageant and also the prayers of the Mass; hence, you need not bring your missal. Holy Communion will be distributed at stations in the stadium stands. Provision is being made for at least 10,000 communicants. Parishioners are urged to attend; the entire function should conclude around 6:00 pm.

MAY DAY CROWNING OF THE BLESSED MOTHER will take place on Sunday, May 5th, at 3:00 p.m. At the ceremony all children will be given a special blessing and also a medal of Our Lady. Mark your calendar now.

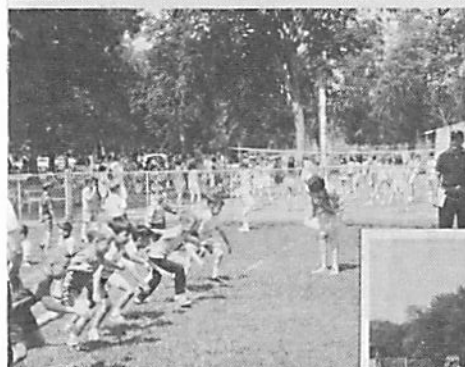

DOES YOUR HOME HAVE A BIBLE? And this is not the real question. Rather, do you read the Bible you have? Too often the Bible assumes only a prominent place in the home but not as a usable item, like for example the TV set. It's an ideal family practice to read the Bible every day. Why not try this: every Saturday gather the family together and read aloud the Epistle and the Gospel for the Sunday's Mass. Discuss the readings among yourselves and decide what God is trying to tell you. It would be most interesting! For example in the Epistle of this Sunday's Mass, St. James talks about the control of the tongue in conversation. "There is the case of the man whose tongue is not controlled. He imagines that he is devout, but this is self-deception. That man's worship is pointless." Very powerful! By reading the Bible many self defined ideas about religion can be corrected!!!!

On Sunday, May 26th, St. Angela Merici Parish is privileged to welcome the Rev. Joel Delgado, a priest from the diocese of Tulancingo, Pachuca, Hidalgo, Mexico. Fr. Delgado will explain the workings of the Church in his Mexican diocese. The population of the diocese is 600,000 in an area of 4,000 square miles. More than 100,000 are Indians with urgent needs. 9 parishes cannot be reached by road. Each priest provides religious coverage for 12,000 Catholics scattered in 10 to 20 villages and hamlets with distances of up to 6 hours apart and differences of altitude up to 3,000 feet.

The Bishop of Tulancingo has established a diocesan center for social advancement. At this center, courses in agriculture, horticulture, animal husbandry, sewing, first aid, etc. are offered for men and women. The monthly charge for room and board and education is \$ 8.00 per person. The diocese assumes the deficit of the Center.

This is our opportunity once again as last year to learn more about the missionary work of the Church. Also, you will be asked to assist financially in accordance with your usual spirit of generosity at the second collection on Sunday.

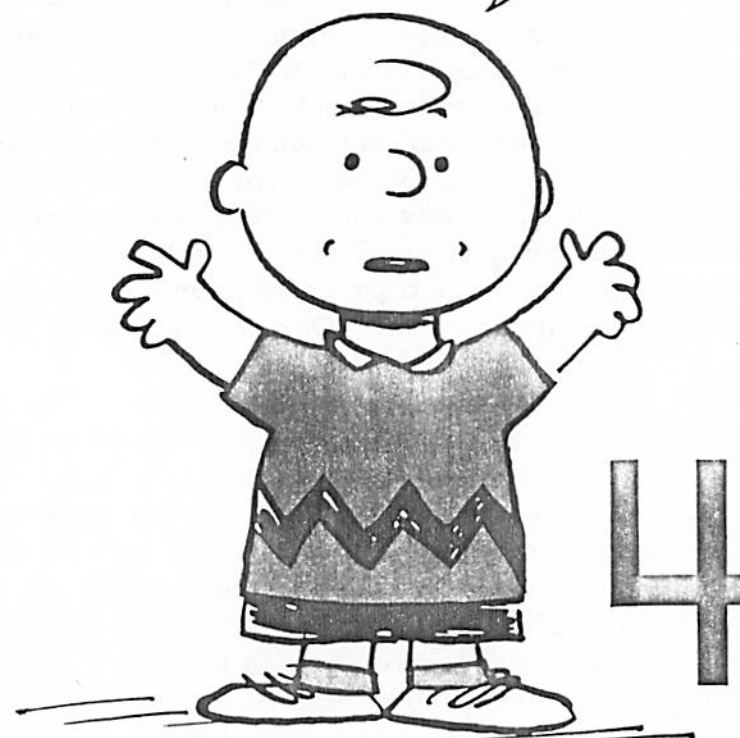

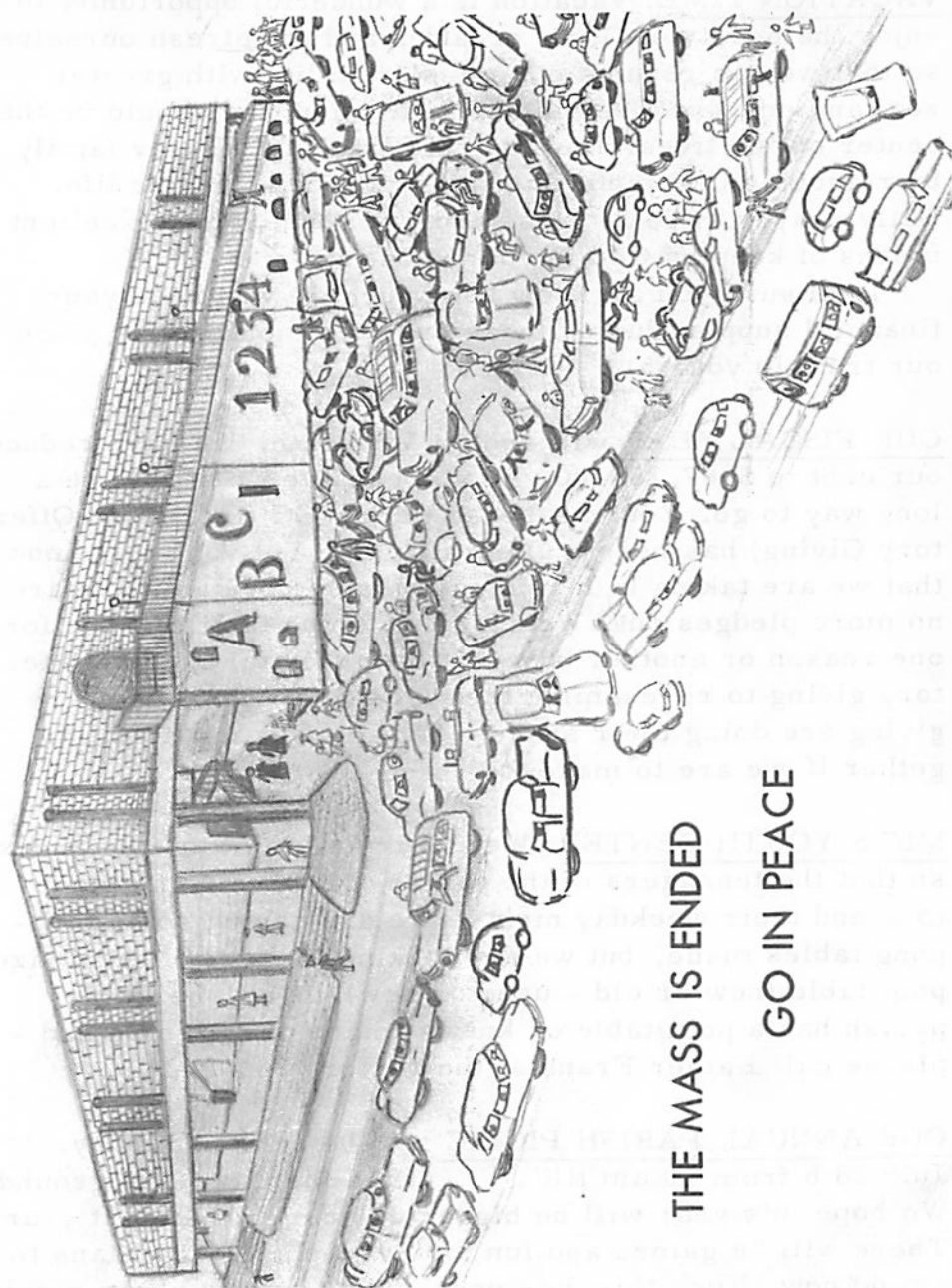

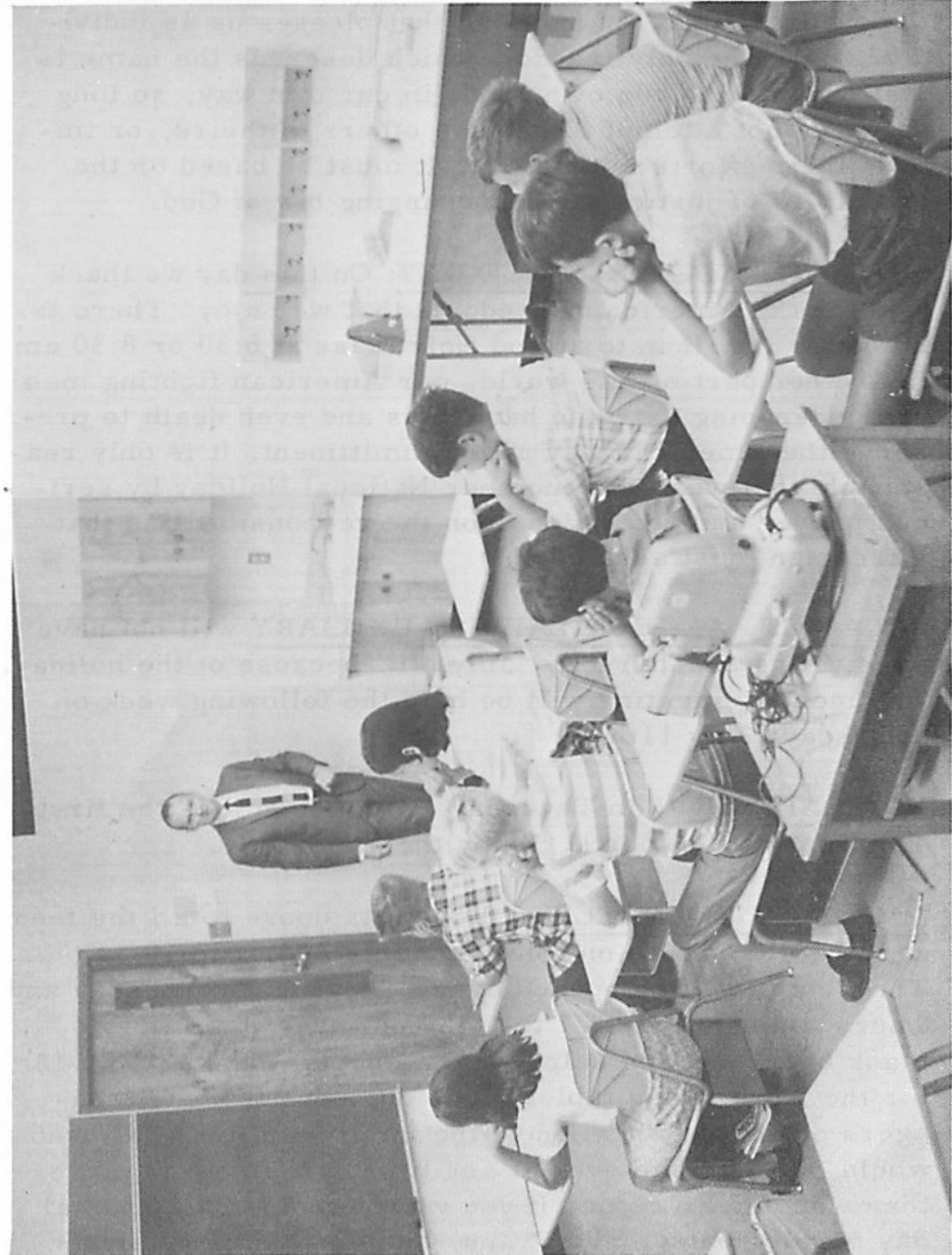
