THE EPIPHANY OF OUR LORD

NEW PREFACES AND CANONS of the Mass are now authorized for use throughout the United States. There are 8 new Prefaces and 3 new Eucharistic Prayers (canons). They are seasonal and will be used at various times during the Church Year. These new prayers are actually very ancient prayers that have been activated for use today. Since missal inserts are not yet available, it is recommended that parishioners listen intently to these vary beautiful prayers.

ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 19, all couples celebrating their Silver Wedding Anniversary during 1969, will be honored at the 5:30 pm Mass. Marriage vows will be renewed during the Mass and a buffet supper served after the Mass for the jubilarians and their immediate families.

INCREASED OFFERTORY GIVING (IOG). Every family will be asked to share a just portion of their blessings for the work of God and the Church. It would be well to honestly evaluate the amount contributed during the year 1968. It is desirable that one envelope be used jointly by husband and wife (even if different Masses are attended). As a family project, why not sit down and consider the entire "take home: earnings for 1968 and then arrive at what percentage has been contributed to the Church. Remember, you can't include tuition payments because actually the Church is subsidizing the operation of the school.





FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY

INCREASED OFFERTORY GIVING. Soon every family in St. Angela Parish will be asked to sign a "Card of Intent". The card will indicate how much each family will return to God on a weekly or monthly basis. This is something that should be carefully planned by every family. Do not simply jot down any figure; but truly consider your weekly or monthly take home pay. Give to God a definite share of your blessings, not just "left overs". While so many parishioners are doing their just share, others could certainly do better. A partial run down of contributions shows that 202 families give less than one dollar per week; 243 families give one dollar per week; 72 families give \$1.50 per week. A complete break down of offerings will be published later. The "Cards of Intent" will be mailed to every family by January 20th and should be returned to the rectory by January 26th. Your Pastor will speak at all of the Masses on Sunday, January 12th, to give his annual report to the parishioners.
