EASTER SUNDAY

FIRST SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

"IF YOU FORGIVE MEN'S SINS, their sins are forgiven". The forgiveness of sins was the first among the benefits of the Redemption. Christ realizes our weakness and sinfulness. And so He devised a way whereby sins might be forgiven. We confess them to the priest. We admit to Christ that we are wrong. We earnestly make the effort to improve. And our sins are forgiven by Him. We can live life as sons of God. We become children of light. We walk with God and He abides in us. To say that Christ cannot delegate His priests to act in His Name, is to deny His Power and make ineffective His death on the Cross!
