EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

"ON THE PARISH LEVEL OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH there should be Councils of priests, religious and laity which assist the apostolic work in the field of making the gospel known and men holy, and in the field of charitable and social endeavor". (Decree Apostolate of Laity, Vat. II) The Parish Council is a structured way for priests, religious and laity to participate in the administration of the parish and to give them an organized way of sharing in the teaching, sanctifying, and governing of the "People of God." These tasks were once thought to be the exclusive province of the pastor and the priests of the parish.

THE PARISH COUNCIL does not in any way destroy the identity of parish organizations. On the contrary, they are enhanced by having an opportunity for greater vision and purpose. The ideas and constructive criticism of each membership can have definite influence on the entire parish. By coordination and communication, each representative segment of the parish can sustain man's growing consciousness of the fact that he is part of a living community - that of being with others and for others.

I EXHORT YOU TO READ the enclosed proposed Constitution very carefully, study it diligently, and vote accordingly. Two ballots are being sent. In the event you have another adult in the family, notify the rectory for an additional ballot. Parishioners of 18 years of age may vote.

PRAY SINCERELY that the Holy Spirit will guide our parish to not only constantly keep before itself its primary purposes but also to put forth generously the energies required to accomplish them. Obviously, every parishioner has a definite role and responsibility. Can I count on you to accept yours?
