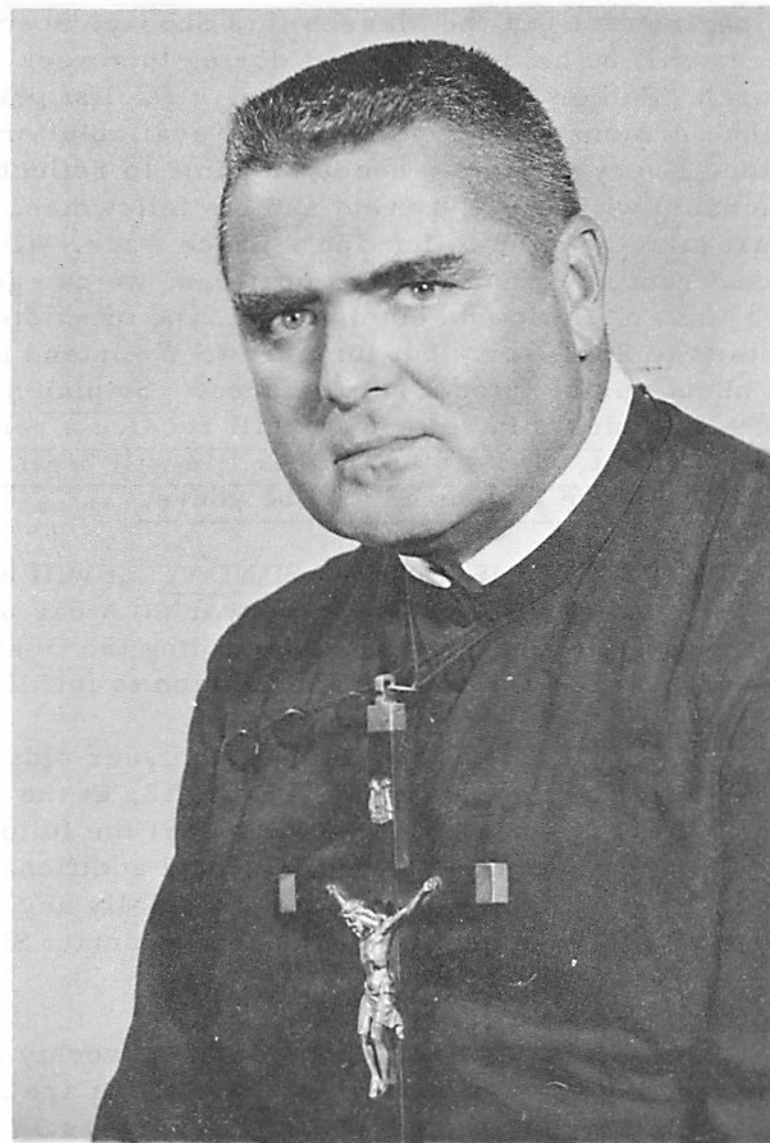

## TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19, IS MISSION DAY. On this day the entire Catholic world will pray and offer sacrifices for the poor in the mission lands. Your sincere prayers are asked for our Missionaries that they might have the strength to carry on the work of spreading Christ's love throughout the world. Your sacrifice is also asked in the form of a substantial offering - your annual money gift. This will assist in providing the hospitals, schools and churches for the mission territories of the world. A SECOND COLLECTION WILL BE TAKED ON SUNDAY.

PRE-SCHOOL OF RELIGION for 4 & 5 year olds begins this Sunday, Oct. 19, during the 9:45 am Mass. Children of these ages are certainly of age to benefit from these classes. Let our program reinforce your Christian training being given in your home.

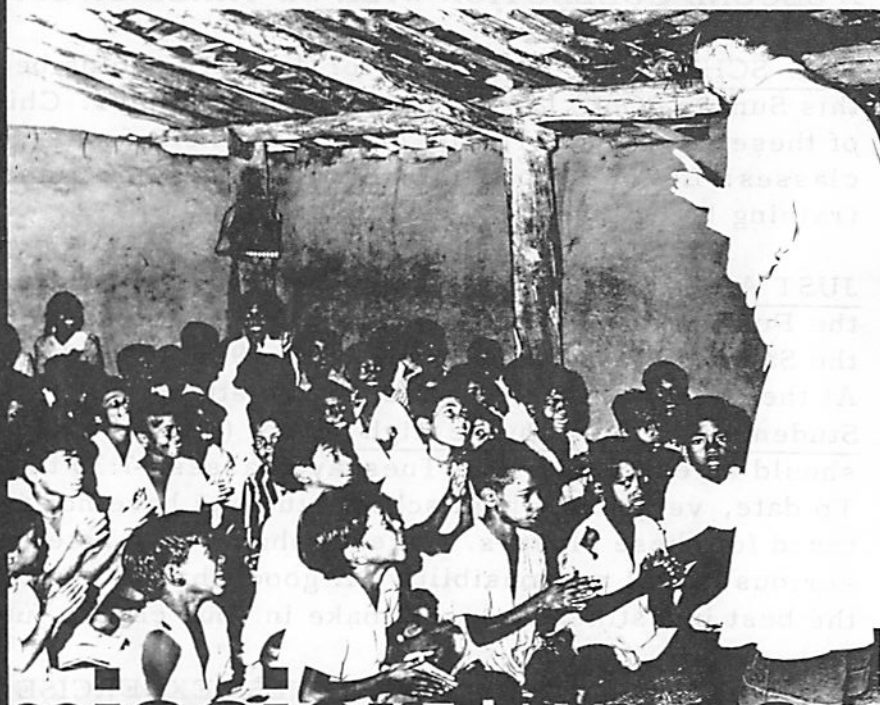

### FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

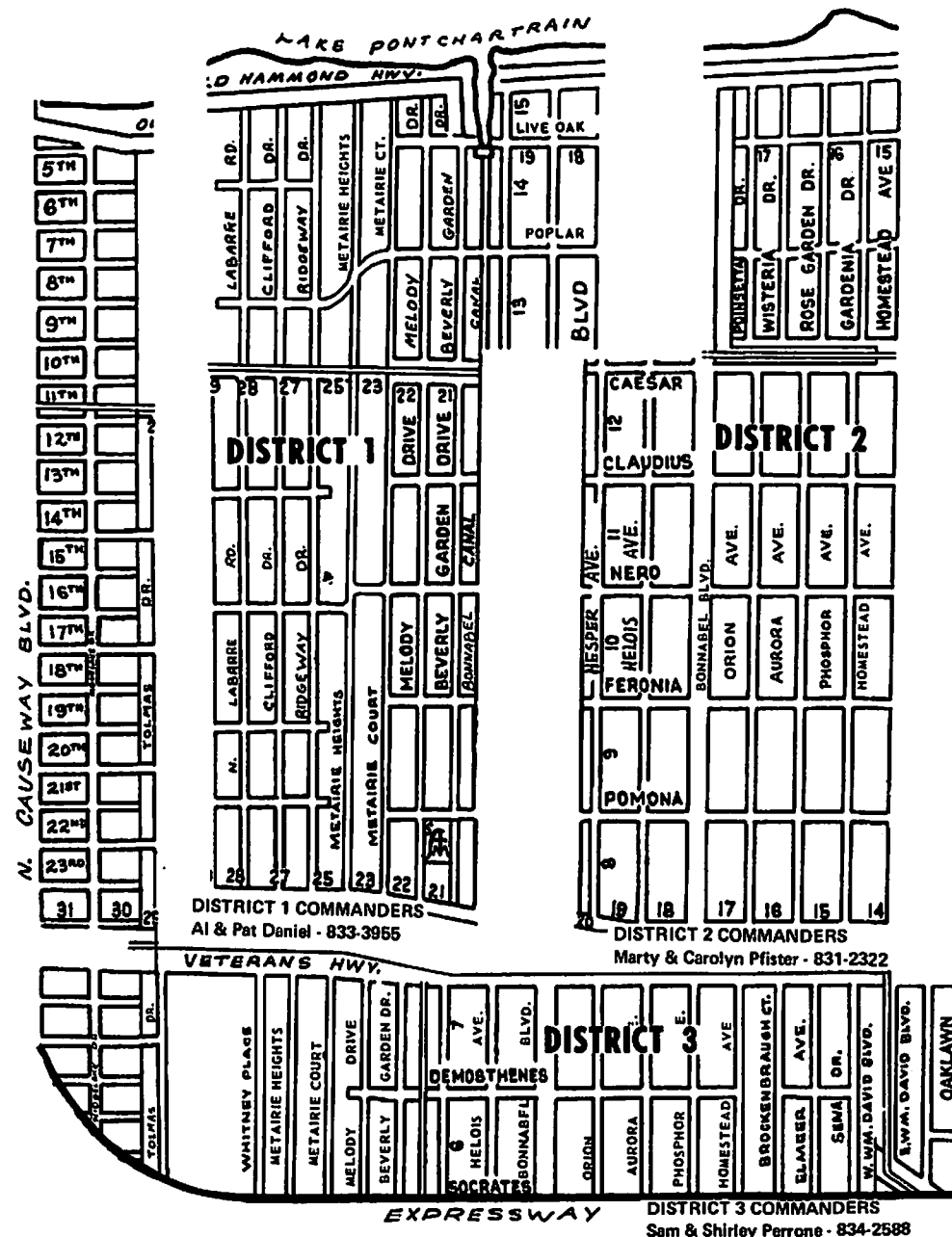
