

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

WHOEVER KEEPS HIS WORD, TRULY HAS THE LOVE of God within him. Every Catholic, who is worthy of what this title means, is committed to a way of life as explained and lived by Jesus Christ. Such a way of life affects us in everything we do and say - at work, at home. It involves an attitude of mind. It keeps us in realistic touch with the true values about us. It often means taking ourselves less seriously, while those about us take on a greater importance. Yes, Christianity has to be lived and actually tested. It might well be that Christianity has not failed us but rather we have failed Christianity!

ST. ANGELA'S ADOPTS A MISSIONARY PARISH in Saltillo, Mexico (near Monterey, Mexico). In the diocese of Saltillo there are 750,000 Catholics with only 65 priests in the diocese. The parish we are adopting is staffed by two American priests from Mississippi. Recently Father Jerry visited the priests there and arranged for assistance from us. What we hope to do is to provide funds on a monthly basis for the hiring of a nurse to lend medical aid and also to hire a lay cathechist to widen the cathechetical program. These services can be obtained for \$150 per month. The offering box in the wall of the church near Beverly Garden and annex entrance to church will be designated as "Mission Offerings". The box will be easily identifiable this Sunday. With a token offering from all, this great work of helping others can be accomplished!

A ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CLOTHING BOX has been placed under the over-hang of the church near Bev. Gdn. Dr. and Pomona Sts. Besides clothing, if you wish to donate furniture, TV sets, stoves, radios, beds, dishes, bedding, glassware, bric-abrac or what have you, a St. Vincent de Paul truck will gladly pick up such articles at your home. The Society operates stores in the city thereby providing jobs for some and tremendous bargains for the needy. The operation is non-profit.


