PAT ON THE BACK: We think the whole Parish should know why their priests are so proud of them. The spirit and cooperation with which the new liturgy has been accepted is most admirable. A few minor liturgical points would really make us A #1.

- 1. A clear, definite response to all the prayers from the opening Amen to the final Thanks be to God.
- 2. To stand after the 2nd Reading for the Alleluia.
- 3. To stand immediately after we have recited the prayer "May the Lord accept . . . " at the Offertory.
- 4. To sing with feeling and that something extra.
- 5. To remain in church until the priest leaves.

Again, these are secondary points but first-class people like us should fly first class.

SOME PEOPLE WONDER ABOUT PENANCE. Since it is no longer a sin to eat meat on Friday, they ask what can they you. Want a good suggestion? How about trying to love someone you may find, from a human standpoint, very difficult to love. This will make a better person out of you than abstaining from meat on Friday. And it will even make St. Angela parish a better place to live.





TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

HIGH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (grades 9 thru 12) will be held every Wednesday from 7:30 to 8:30 pm. Classes will start on Oct. 7th. No prior registration. Book fee of \$5.00 per student. Sister Alberta, Religious Education Coordinator for our Parish, and Sister Andre, Adult Education Supervisor for our Parish, will address the congregation at all of the Masses on Saturday & Sunday.
