SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

INCREASED OFFERTORY GIVING. Soon every family in St. Angela Parish will be asked to sign a "Card of Intent". This is not a pledge but rather an honest effort at putting God and His Church in your weekly or monthly budget. Just as every family must budget and allocate their money towards the basic needs of the home – likewise, there exists a need in every family to share with God the blessings, which untimately have come from God. In the proper order, God should be placed first in every family budget. He should not be given the "left-overs". While many families have been doing their fair share by putting God in their budget, there are really too many families (when one considers the number of these families and their economic level) who obviously do not plan what return should be made to the Church. By serious effort on the part of all, this can be the "Year of the Five" for St. Angela's.

BE SURE TO LOOK AT THE CLARION for the Survey on Catholic Schools in the Archdiocese. All parishioners, ages 18 and up, will be asked to fill out the survey during the Masses on Sunday. Copies will be available during the Masses. This is a serious approach to the financial difficulties our schools are undergoing at the present time. In the final analysis, it will be you the Catholics who must come to grips with this crisis. Please be honest in your replies.

ST. ANGELA'S CHURCH has been chosen as the site for Ordinations to the Sub-Diaconate, on Saturday, January 16, at 10:30 am. Bishop Caillouet will be the ordaining Prelate. The Sub-Diaconate is a Major Order which a seminarian receives before becoming a priest. It is normally received one year before the Priesthood. We welcome Bishop Caillouet and the ordinands! May God bless the young men with perseverance and many fruitful years of service in their respective dioceses. Mr. Henry J. Broussard, who has been assisting us on the weekends, will be ordained Subdeacon.

AGAIN WE URGE PARENTS TO ADVISE their sons not to ride their motor-bikes and mini-bikes on the church property. This presents a safety problem for the many adults and children who use the church grounds facility. A word of caution now can prevent accidents.





THIRD SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY







SEVENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT STARTS ON ASH WEDNESDAY. This is the time of year to improve our relationship with Almighty God. We begin Lent by receiving the ashes to remind ourselves that we will one day die to the life of this world. After all the noise and frolic of Mardi Gras, the ashes immediately put us in the proper mood for Lent. But not in a somber mood. Rather, in a serious mood - seriously interested in growing spiritually. A sudden stop to all the totally absorbing concern about this or that parade. In the light of total living, the demand for this or that doubloon becomes less important. Yes, Ash Wednesday can be a time for growth. Spiritual growth, as for physical growth, depends on nourishment and care. For us, the greatest opportunity for growth is to be found by attending the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Here we find the ingredients in a most perfect way. We become more open persons - by admitting our faults and asking forgiveness. We hear God's Word, thereby transforming ourselves into better children of God. We receive Holy Communion - here Jesus nourishes us and unites us more closely with our fellowmen. It is rather difficult then to truly grow during Lent unless the Mass becomes more important to us.
