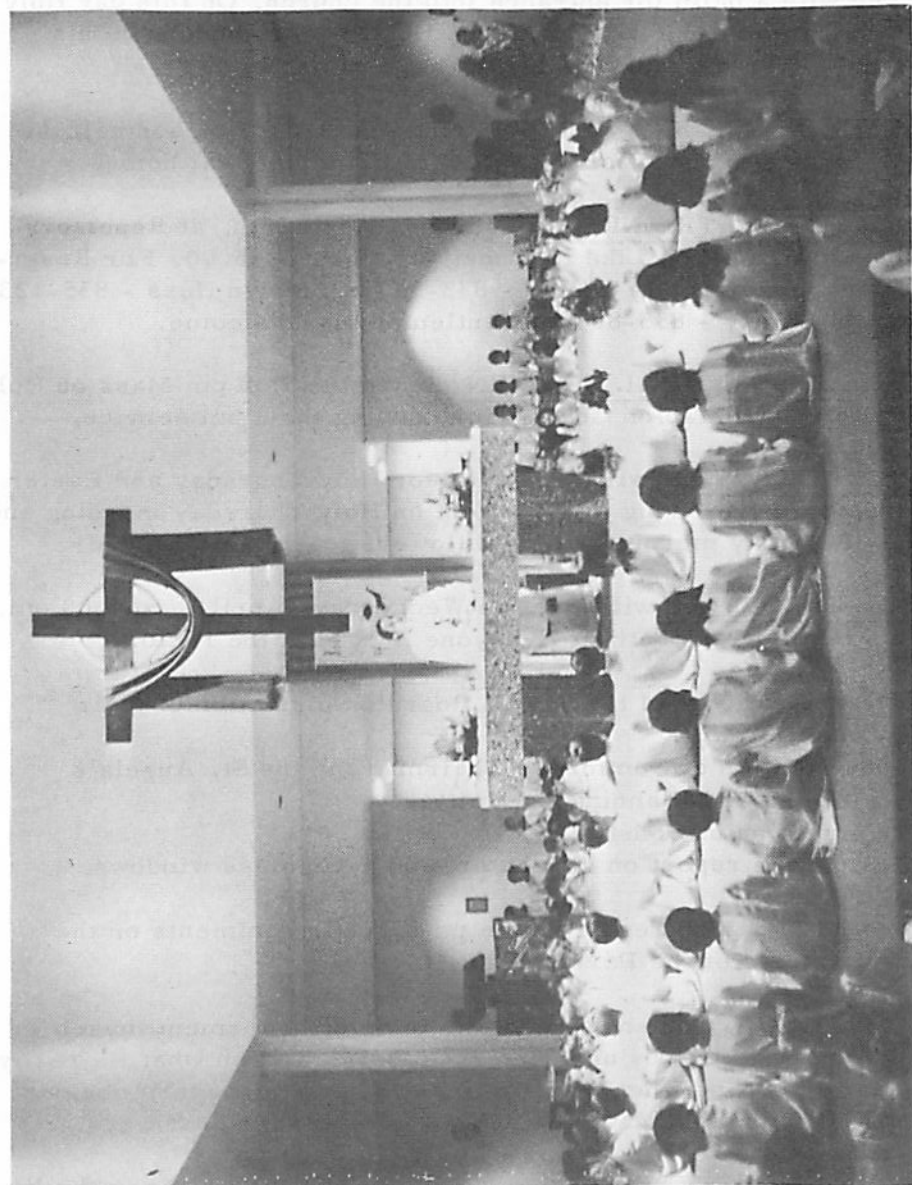

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

"BLEST ARE THEY WHO HAVE NOT SEEN and have believed". Faith is the basis of our life with God. Without it we cannot accept God's teaching, nor can we commit ourselves to live by them. Faith is like a telescope enabling us to see God's design in the smallest things. Faith is also like a powerful magnet that draws us to Him. But this faith, although a total gift from God, has to be nourished by repeated acts of faith. There must be our constant "yes" to God. 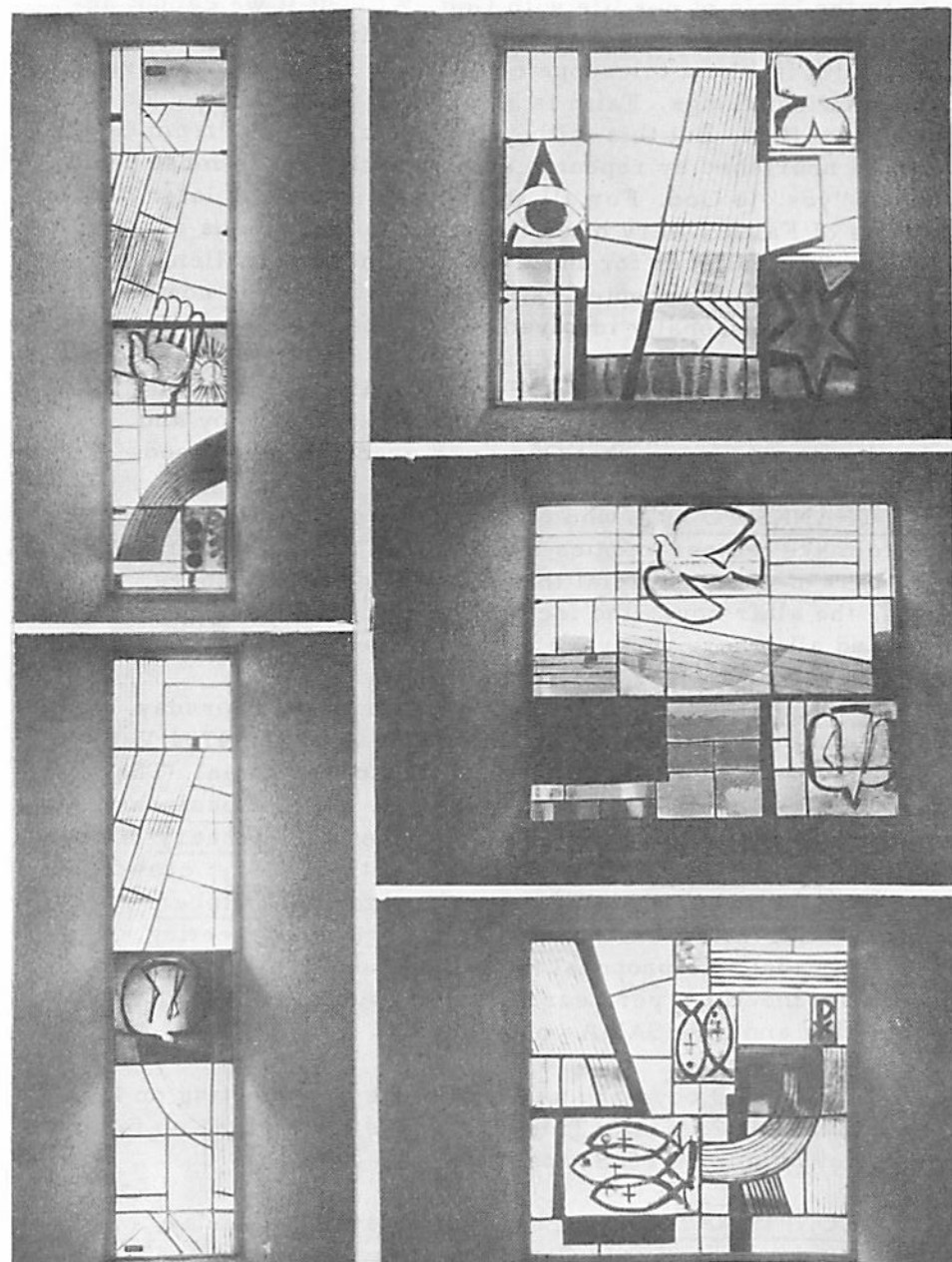

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

CHRIST'S RESURRECTION IS THE KEY TRUTH of our Christian faith. The first proclamation of the "good news", the pattern of the message that was to convert billions and change the world's history, stressed Christianity's basic and unique fact: Jesus Christ, who had been murdered, came alive from the grave by God's power and entered a perfect, glorified state. (Read Acts 2, 22-36). Jesus shares his victory with us, for we too have the power to rise and be glorified forever. We must take part in his death and glorification to attain eternal life with God. TRINITY SUNDAY

SUNDAY IS THE FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY. At all of the Masses this Sunday, we celebrate the Holy Mass in honor of the Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
