



### SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

WE COMMUNICATE WITH GOD BY PRAYER. Through it we open ourselves to Him, find out His will and obtain the strength to live as we should. We can never know God or ourselves unless we pray. Daily prayers are as necessary as daily food. And like food, sometimes it is enjoyable, at other times it is not. It is more enjoyable for some than for others. But it is necessary for all. The more we prepare for prayer, the more pleasurable it will be (just like food). We prepare for prayer by reading and reflection, especially the Bible. 


