TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

THE LIVING ROSARY, WITH LIGHTED CANDLES will be recited in our school yard on **THURSDAY, OCT. 14**, from 7:30 to 8:00 pm. Some children of the parish will dramatize the Joyful Mysteries of the rosary. The Scripture Rosary will be recited with members of the CYO participating. This is an annual activity of the Block Couple System. Block Couples are urged to encourage their families to attend. Come out and pray for world peace. In case of inclement weather, the entire program will be conducted in the church. Plan to attend.

THIS SUNDAY'S GOSPEL INDICATES HOW WE SHOULD pray to God. It is contained in the parable of the ten lepers. It gives the dispositions for fruitful prayer; compunction ("Jesus, Master, have pity on us"), perseverance (when they were told to show themselves to the priests, they did), and gratitude (one of them threw himself down at the feet of Jesus in gratitude). Prayer must have the same qualities as these. Otherwise, Shakespeare will ring true again: "My words fly up, my thoughts remain below. Words, without thoughts, never to heaven go".

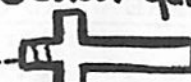

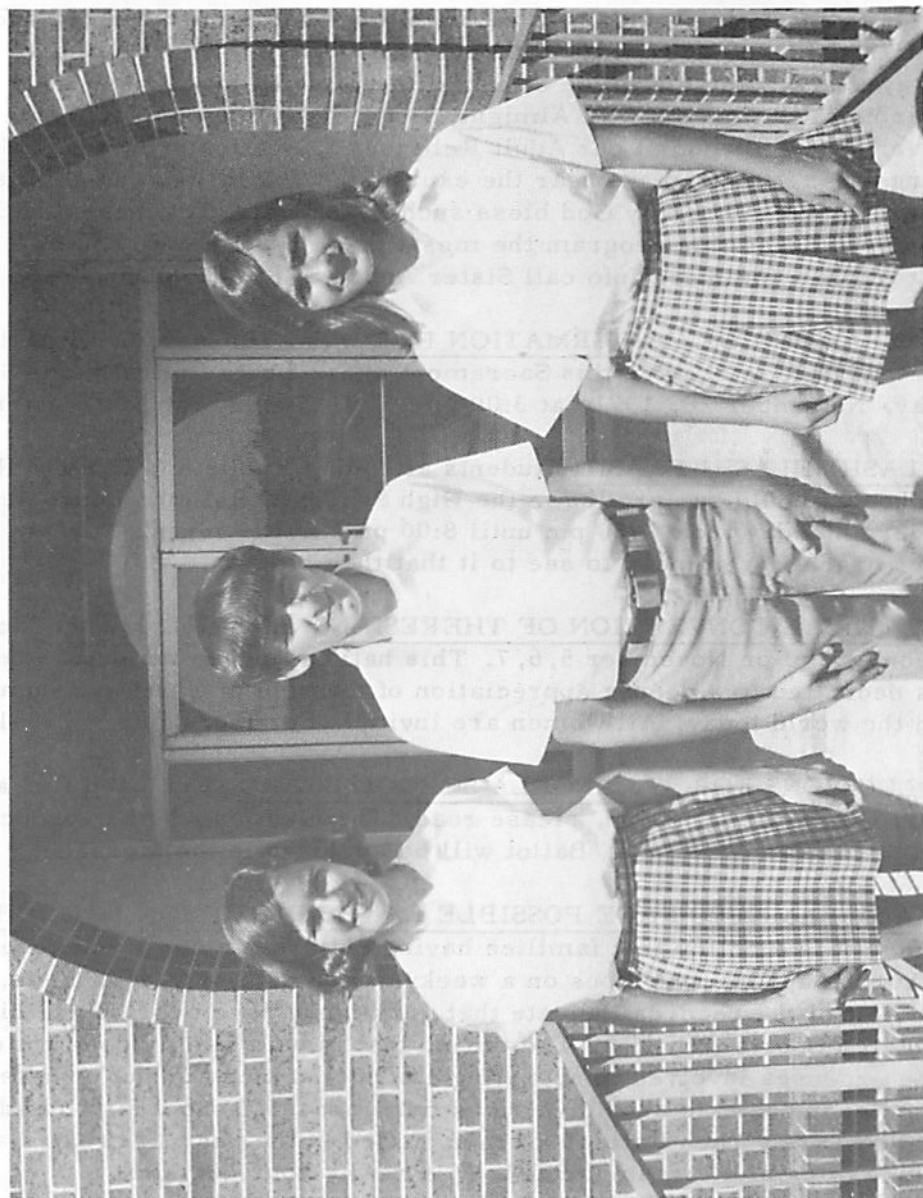

ST. ANGELA PROVIDES RELIGIOUS TRAINING for the 980 pupils who are enrolled in our parochial school. From our Public & Private Schools, there are 310 elementary children registered for weekly classes on Tuesdays, from 4:15 to 5:15 pm. The High School of Religion with classes every Monday night from 7:00 until 8:00 pm has an enrollment of 65 boys & girls. There are still many from the High School group who are still missing these classes.

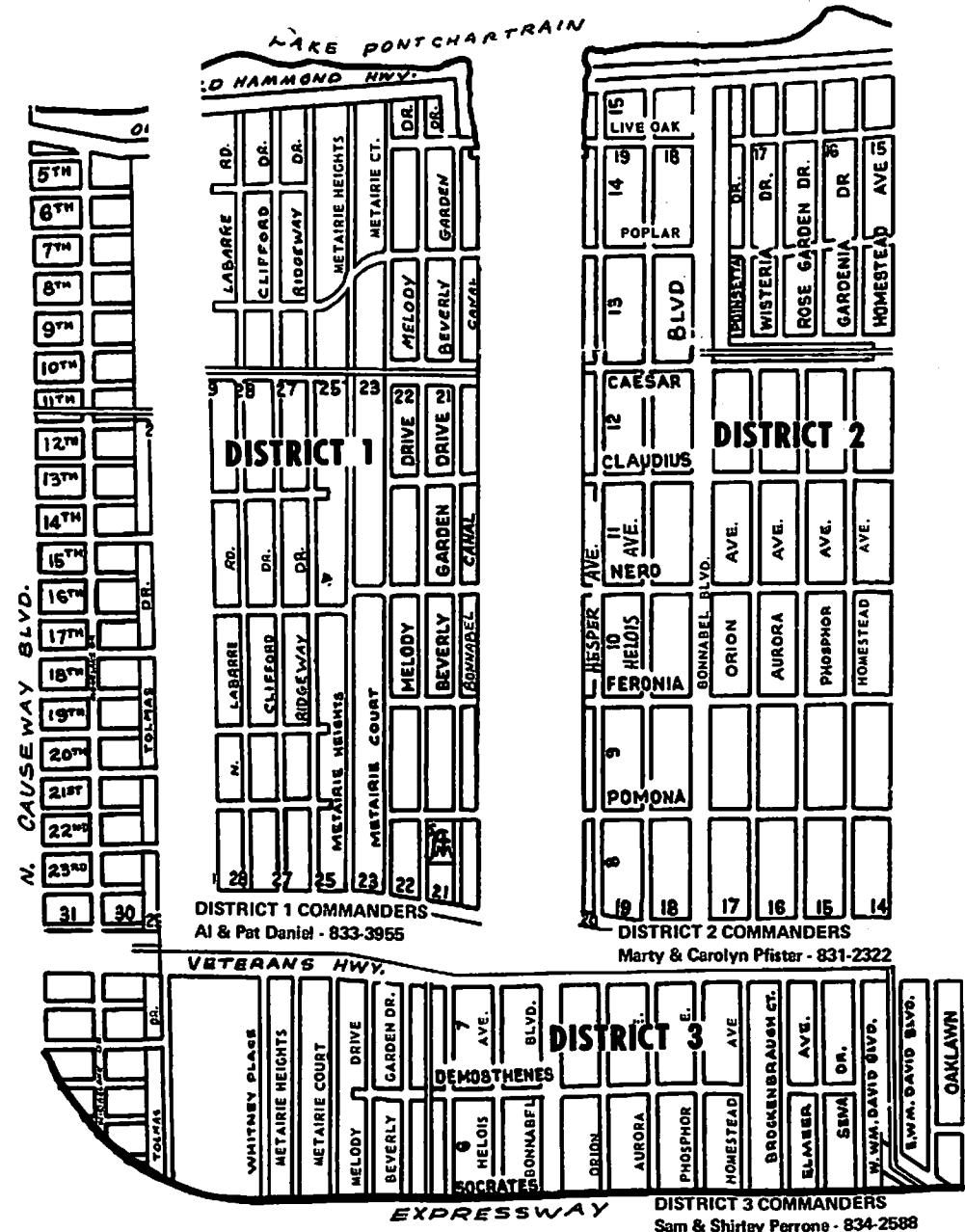

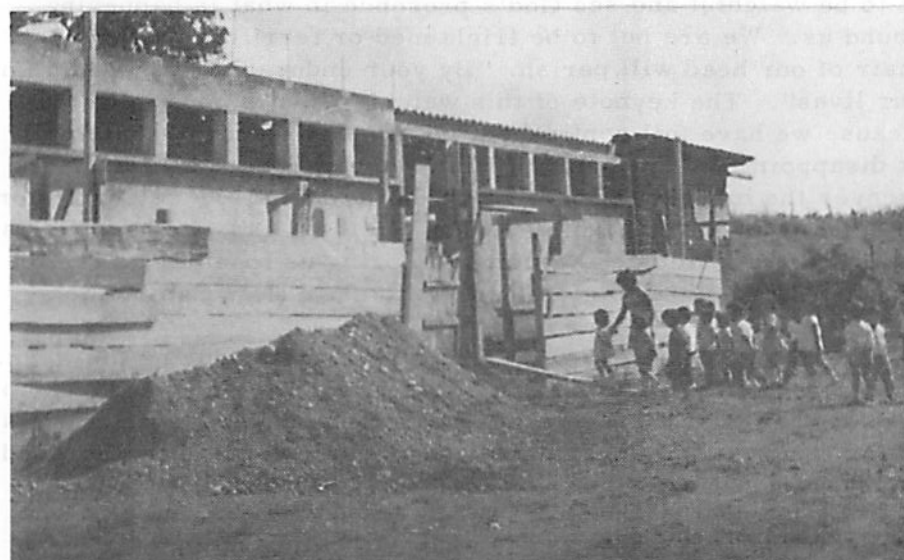

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

SUNDAY IS THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING. The Kingdom of Christ must be rooted within the heart of man. 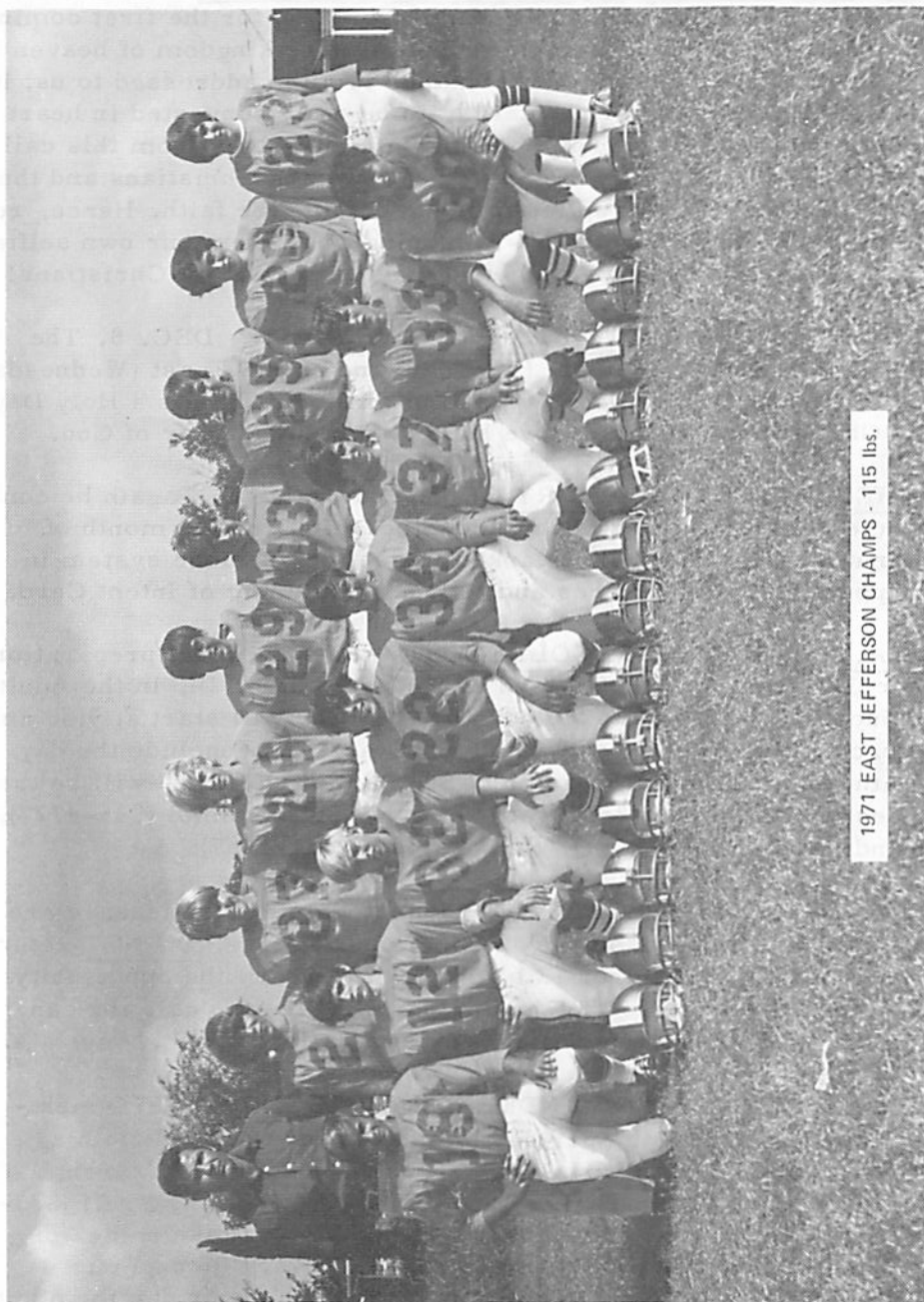

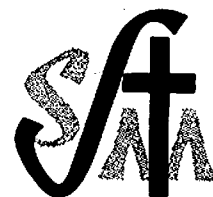

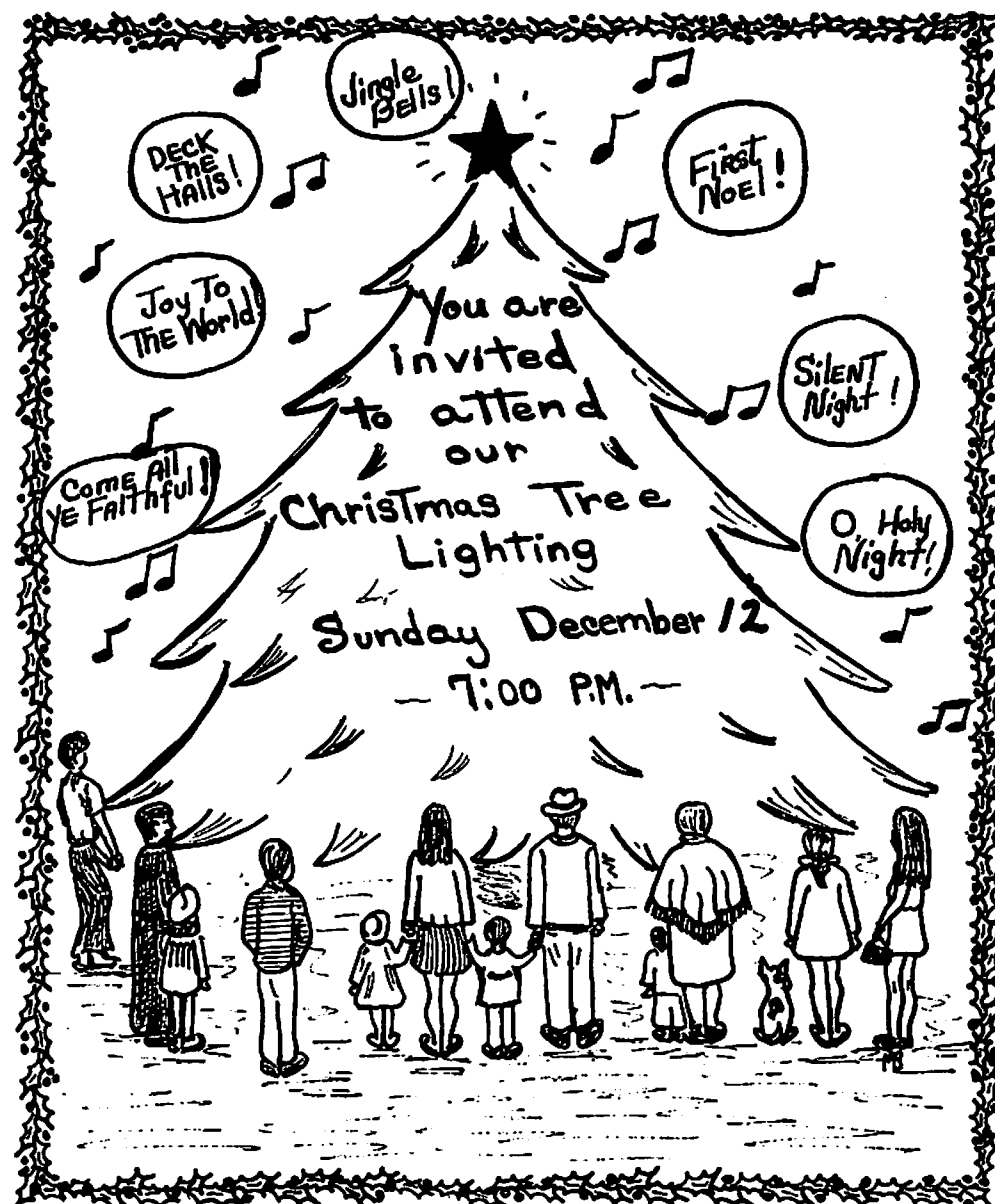

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

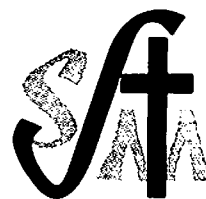

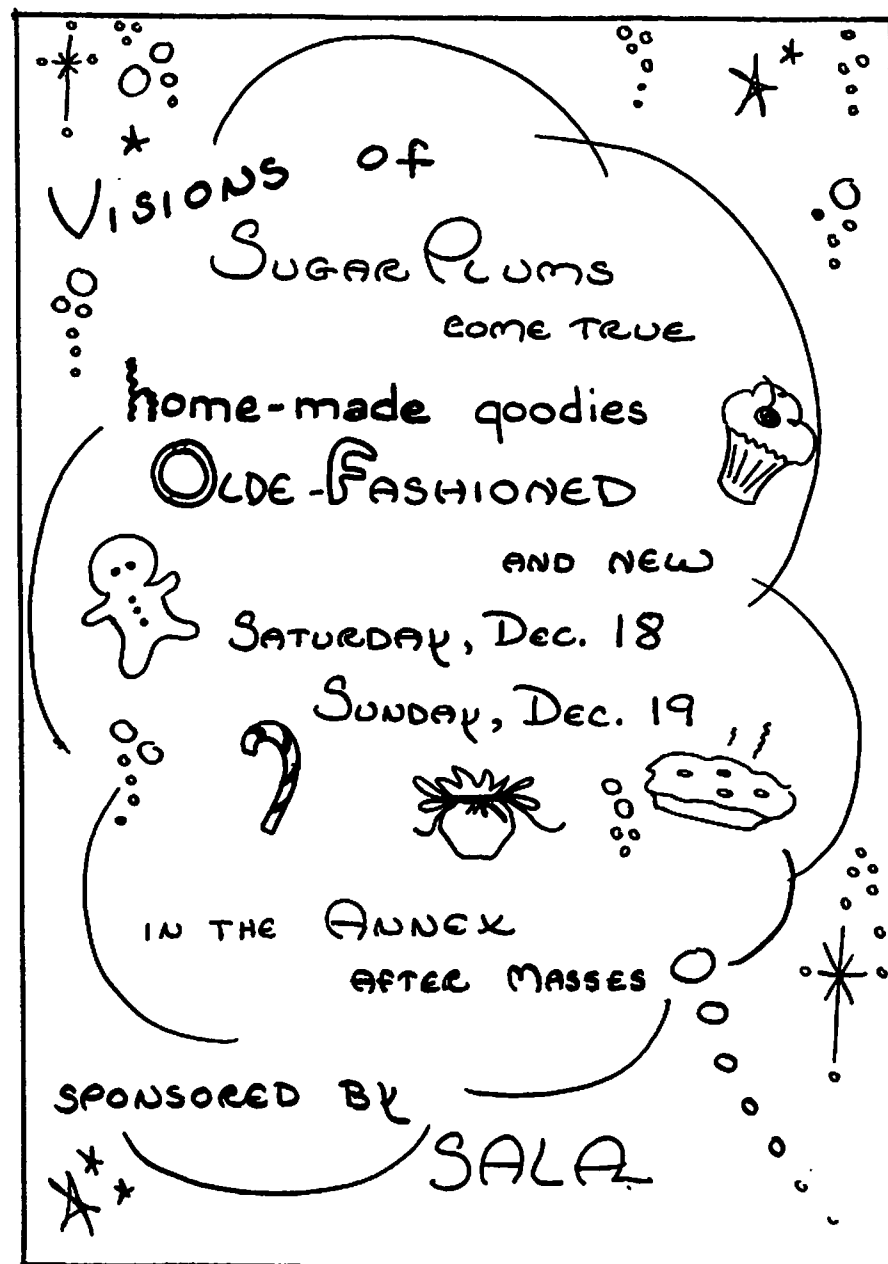

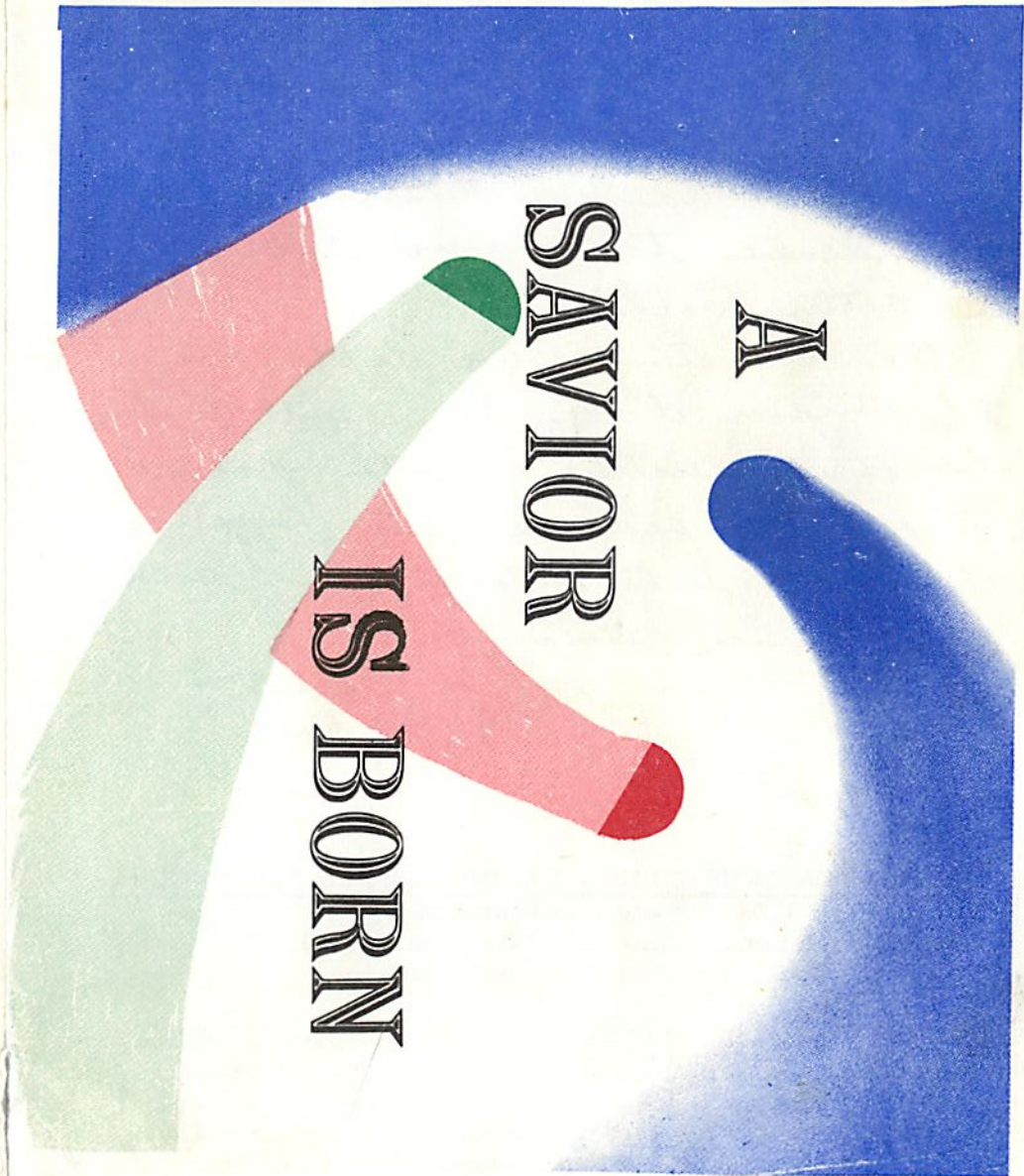
