Jesus - a Man for Men

He loved his Father with his whole heart and soul and strength, in darkness and in light, with childlike trust and immovable courage. And in this he showed us what it is to be a man: not just one possessed of body and spirit, but one who lets body and spirit freely be possessed by the love of the Father.

To be a man is to have a center of life, a kingdom and a Father to turn to in absolute trust, Jesus' "good news" was that we have a Father who knows our needs and fulfills them with infinitely more graciousness and faithfulness than he shows in the painting of flowers and the feeding of sparrows. Life is a gift. God's glory is a living man who appreciates and makes use of the gift.

Jesus is a totally free man: that is, he is ready for the truth of every situation and open to the needs of other men. He is not enslaved by selfishness or outside pressure --social, political, economic or religious. He awaits the Father's direction on how to respond with love in each situation; an outcast crying for community, leaderless sheep needing a shepherd, an adulteress needing dignity, religious leaders needing a rebuke, 12 fainthearted men needing conviction.

He is free enough to be seen at the table of rich Pharisees as well as in the noisy places where "sinners" gathered. He is free enough to speak simply. He is free enough to be angry. He could express his frustration: "How long will I be with you?" He was free enough to tell his followers plainly that he would suffer and die, and so would they. He did not water down his teaching in the face of mass desertions. When he judged that his hour had come, he walked into the midst of his enemies.

Jesus was free; he was courageous; he was simply devoted to his Father.

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

IN SUNDAY'S GOSPEL, JOHN WRITES so that we may have Faith. He includes the Thomas incident so that we may have faith purified by doubt. Faith purified by doubt goes against much that we have been taught. We have been taught that Faith is something to hang on to, and never question. But our times are filled with questions and doubts. One response would be to hide from these doubts behind a wall of dogmas. Just never question anything. Another response would be to see faith as a never-ending search for God in the midst of life. We must grow in the conviction that there are answers that He Himself has revealed. We will have doubts, but they do not challenge our faith. They remind us of the inadequacy of our concepts. Thomas' hesitation was good, because it helps us to come to terms with our own hesitations. "Blessed are those who do not see, and who believe."

A RECORD NUMBER OF PARISHIONERS attended the Masses on Easter Sunday. It was truly delightful to see the happy faces and the spirited participation at the Masses. The key, perhaps, was a personal desire on the part of all to celebrate the fact of Christ's Resurrection. 

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

IN SUNDAY'S GOSPEL, THE WORD OF GOD reflects on the Human Pilgrimage. St. Luke tells the story of the journey to Emmaus, when two disciples, about to give up the adventure of faith, discover that they are not alone. Today, we are on a pilgrimage through life. His mission will be fulfilled at the end of the world, when all evil powers have been overcome. We now share in the victory of Jesus Christ. He promises that we, too, shall have a glorified body. However, we must join ourselves to him during life.

PENTECOST

THE FEAST OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. This is the Feast of firea fired-up people! And the Holy Spirit, who is God's best gift to men! What does it mean to say a man has the Spirit? We know what "high-spirited" means; is the "Holy Spirit" anything like this? Does the gift of God have anything to do with vitality and staying power? Is he full of enthusiasm; does he jump up and down? No, he does not always jump. Yes, he should be enthusiastic! The Son of God has sent the Holy Spirit, which is a life-giving principle. Life is many things, and it is certainly a communication of energy, love and desire. The inspired person adds something to our human experiences. The Holy Spirit does just this to us.

ABOUT CONFESSION. The rules and regulations for confession have not changed. It is interesting to read the documents of Vatican II, and note the insistence on the Sacrament. The Decree of Ministry and Life of Priests says: "In the spirit of Christ, the priests should train the faithful to submit their sins with contrite heart to the Church in the sacrament of Penance. Thus, mindful of the Lord's words: Repent, for the kingdom of God is at hand, the people will draw ever closer to Him each day." Frequent confession is necessary for two kinds of people - those who are trying to overcome the habit of sin, and those who are trying to grow in sanctity - and you fit into one class or the other.

EVERY CATHOLIC WHO HAS THE AGE OF REASON is obliged by church law to make his Easter Duty. This means the reception of Holy Communion during the Easter Season. The Easter Season will come to a close on Trinity Sunday, May 28th. If there are sick persons at home please call any of the parish priests for Holy Communion at home.

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

THE PATIENCE OF GOD. How many things occupy our minds and hearts - friends, vacation, business, family, finances, parties, health, swimming, boating. All normal "loves", yet, the wisdom of the Old Testament cries forth "there is no god besides you who have the care of all". The patience of God is amazing. He quietly watches as we nourish the "weeds" of lesser loves, and often stunt the growth of "good seed". For many Christians it is only in times of personal crises that the inadequacy of merely human supports come through. Paul reminds the Romans and us, "it is the Spirit" who "helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how to pray and we ought". We are thankful that our brother Jesus is a loving and patient God.

VISITING MISSIONARY - Fr. Joseph Koebel will visit at St. Angela's and speak at all the Masses on July 29 & 30. His appeal will be for the Nepomucenum, a seminary in Rome for educating Czechoslovakians. These young men at the present time are forced after ordination to work in parishes outside their homeland - the government behind the iron curtain does not allow them to return to their own country to work as priests. The Nepomucenum is presently educating 22 Czechoslavakian students and several from missionary countries around the world. The second collection will be for renovation and operation expenses of this seminary in Rome.

OFFERING OUR GIFTS TO GOD. Immediately following the first collection at the weekend Masses, all parishioners are asked to unite in offering their gifts of sacrifice and love to Almighty God. Symbolically the gifts of bread and wine are brought in procession to the altar at the Offertory of the Mass. Families are being requested to offer their services for the Offertory procession.
