TRANSFIGURATION





NINETEENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

THE LORD PASSES BY. In the first reading of today's Mass, Elijah is told by God to leave the cave and to go "stand on the mountain.... the Lord will be passing by." Elijah looks for Him in the rocksplitting wind, in the earthquake, in the searing fire --- but the Lord is not in any of these. Finally, Elijah hears a tiny whispering sound. He covers his face --- and Elijah found the Lord in the almost inaudible murmur of the gentle breeze. In this penetrating reading we are warned to distrust all our concepts about God --- for God passes by in the most unexpected and quiet ways. Each morning in a moment of prayerful reflection, we might well ask, "Where will I find God today?".

TWENTIETH SUNDAY OF YEAR

FOREIGNERS LOOK FOR "WITNESS". Isiah writes that God gives foreigners the gift of a new heart that makes them chosen sons of God. Jesus likewise extends the original promise to the Jews to include everyone who resolves to do what pleases God and to seek after truth. An example is given when a foreign woman from Canaan pleads with Jesus to save her child. The woman is representative of all those outside the Church today. It is not through the apostles, or the visible Church, they represent, that the woman finds salvation. We are the Church today; we are the people who sit down at the banquet, who gather easily in the Savior's presence. And it is possible that our own faith, or lack of it, and our own life-style keep others away. As a community of faith and as individuals we should often reflect if we are giving witness, or "non-witness".

PARISH SCHOOL BOARD. At the beginning of the 1971-72 school year a copy of the Constitution of the St. Angela Merici Parish School Board was mailed to all parishioners. The new board held its first meeting on November 16, 1971. The board consists of three ex-officio and non-voting members - the pastor, principal and assistant principal - and six lay persons, of whom three are elected and three appointed for a period of three years. Members for this year include Bob Maher, pres.; Ann Branley, vice-pres.; Joyce Palermo, secty.; Tony Hymel, treas.; Gerry Mialaret and Don Ranna.

The first meeting of the School Board for the 1972-73 school year is scheduled for this Monday, August 21st at 7:30 pm in the Adult Center. Topics scheduled for discussion include: 1. 





TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

MY WAYS ARE NOT YOUR WAYS. In our first reading from Isaiah the prophet presents several of the paradoxes that are so much a part of the Christian life. God is far away, yet very near. Man is helpless, yet bound to act decisively for what he needs. God's ways are as high as the heavens, yet they must become the normal pattern of action for man. In Paul's letter to the Philippians, the Apostle to the Gentiles poses a question that comes to the mind of every Christian from time to time: Is it better to live or die? He responds to death without apprehension: "to die is gain". He speaks of life without fear: "Life means fruitful labor for me". As with Paul, a man's reaction to life and death says something about the degree of faith he possesses.
