TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

Religious Education Program

Elementary Students

Grades 1-4 begin their religion program on Sunday, October 1, at 8:30 am. A Mass for these students will be held at 9:45 am in classrooms 205, 206 & 207. Children dismissed at 10:30.

Grades 5-8 begin on Sunday, October 8, at 8:30 am. Mass at 9:45 and dismissal at 10:30 as for the primary grades.

Pre-school (ages 4 & 5). A religion program for pre-school children will begin on October 15, at 8:30 am. The pre-school program will be open to all children ages 4 & 5.

The program for all children, pre-school and elementary grades will be conducted on alternate Sundays, e.g., primary grades (1-4), October 1, 15, 29, etc.; middle grades (5-8), October 8, 22, Nov. 5, etc. Elementary children not already registered may register on the morning of October 1 or 8.

High School of Religion Classes begin on Monday, October 2, from 7 to 8 pm, in the annex, and will meet every Monday. This program is for students, grades 9 to 12, attending Public or Private School. Registrations on October 2nd, before classes.

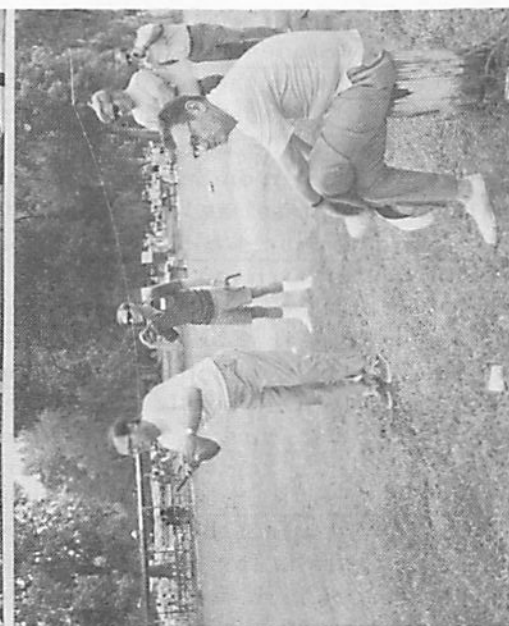

TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

THE LORD'S VINEYARD. The Word of God today centers around the metaphor of the vineyard - God's vineyard, ourselves and our world. It is a story of violence and neglect, but the Word and the signs of the Eucharist offer us a way back to confidence, and to the hope that our lives will be fruitful.

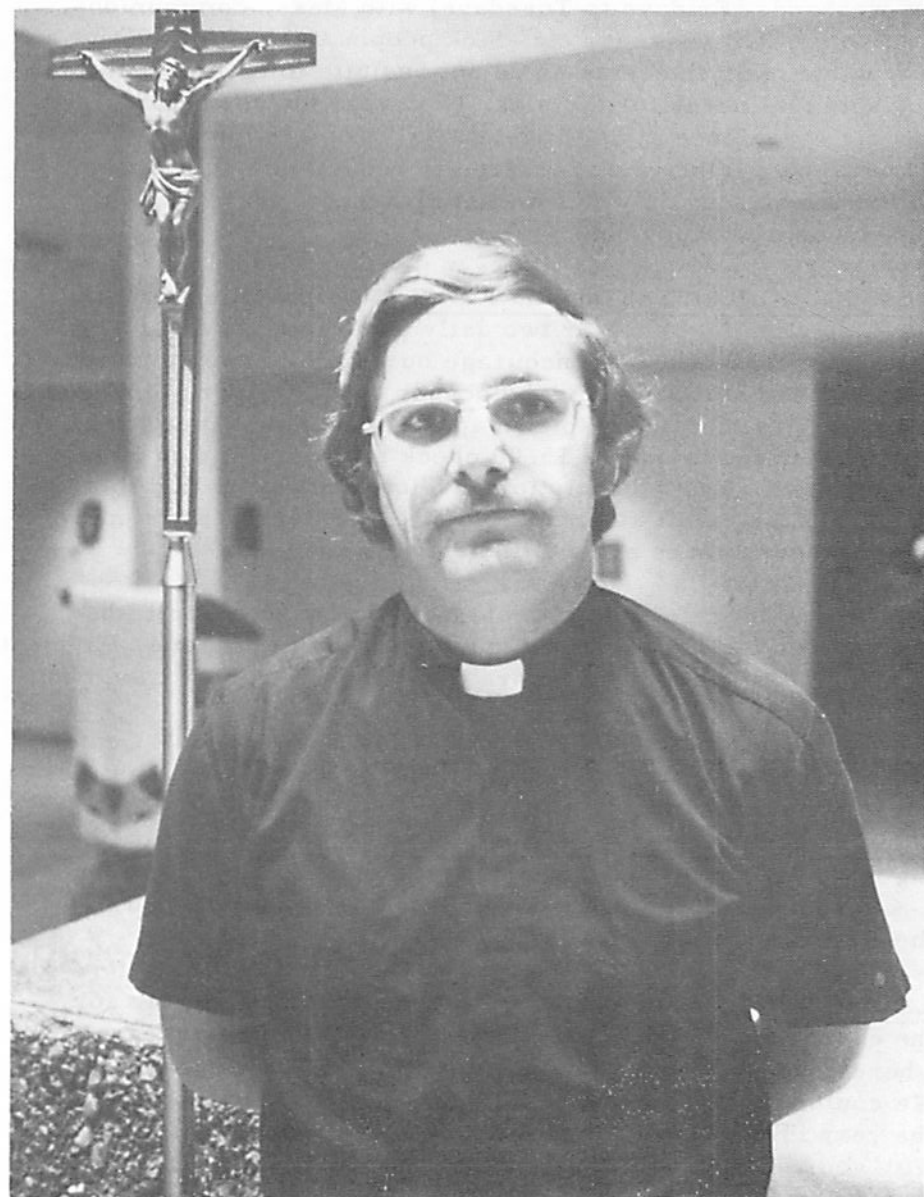

TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

MISSION SUNDAY, a special day for our parish, is this Sunday, October 22. We will share with all Catholics around the world in the Church's annual appeal for our 135,000 missionaries serving the most deprived people of this earth. Catholic missionaries are serving the poor of America, Africa, Latin America, Asia and the South Seas. One of the missions that St. Angela Parish helps directly is in Esquipulas, Guatemala (see our cover feature).

RENEWAL PROGRAM SCHEDULED. Fr. Jerry Cleator, O.P. has informed us that a Dominican team of priests will be in St. Angela Parish from March 31 to April 13 to conduct a sacred scripture renewal program. The priests will preach at all the Sunday liturgies in church and then go into homes of the parish to preach, discuss the New Testament and pray with the people - one session each morning and one each evening Monday through Friday. The homes of 20 different parishioners are needed for meetings. Let us know if you are interested in volunteering your home. Only coffee and possibly a few cookies to be served. 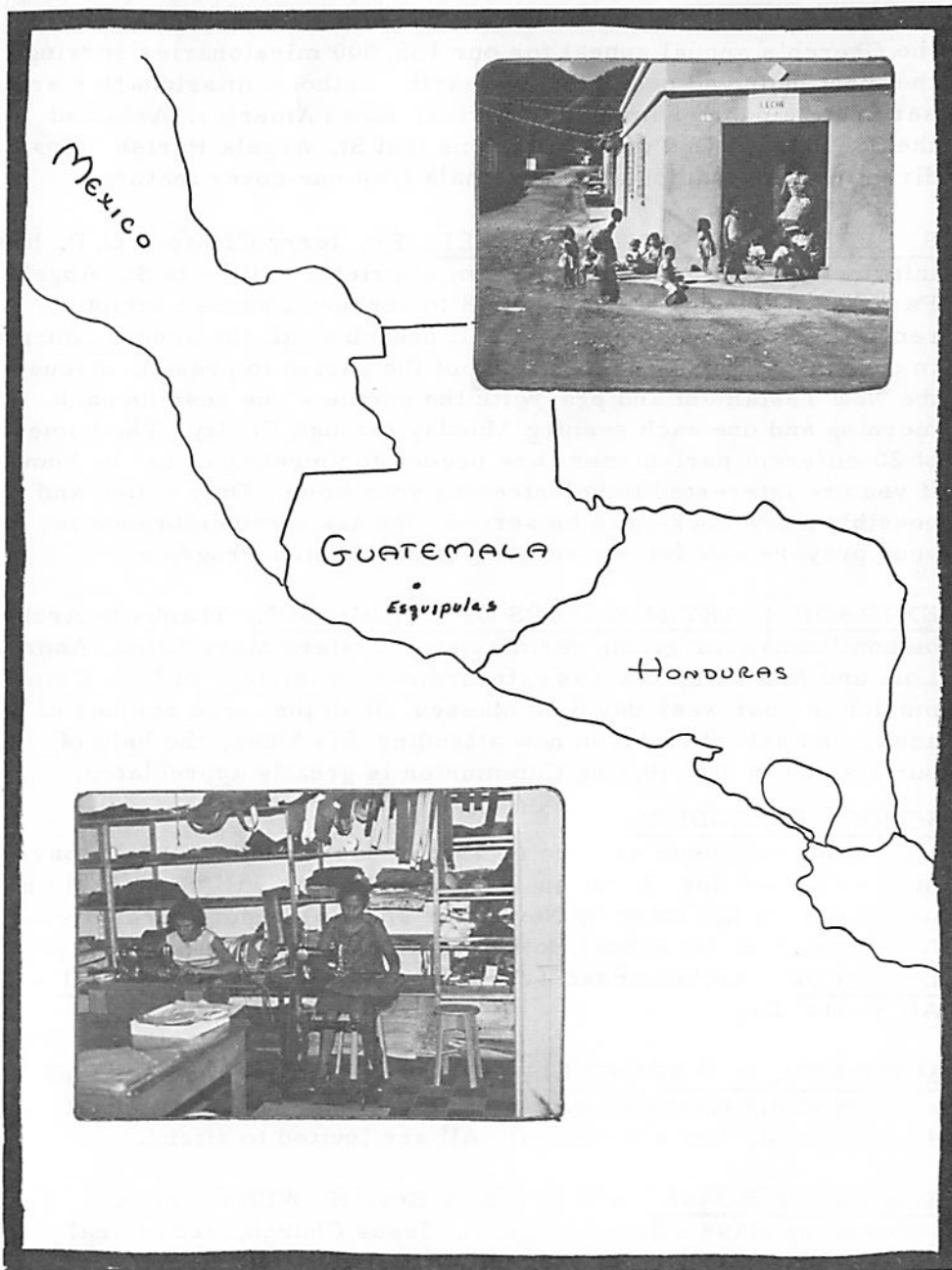

PROTECTING OUR CHILDREN. Too many children have been injured recently on the streets of our parish. Parents are asked to give serious attention to training the children in practice of safety when playing and bicycle riding. Take time for teaching these tips:

TIPS FOR SAFER USE OF STREETS

1. Observe and obey directions of police officers.
2. Keep from between parked cars.
3. Wear white after dark.
4. Be extra alert in bad weather.
5. Cross only at corners.
6. Look all ways before crossing.
7. Watch for turning cars.
8. Walk on left facing traffic.

TIPS FOR SAFE BICYCLE DRIVING

1. Signal for turns and stops.
2. Obey all traffic signs, signals and rules.
3. Yield the right of way to pedestrians.
4. Drive solo - only one on a bicycle.
5. Keep feet on the pedals at all times.
6. Keep both hands on the handlebars, except when signaling.
7. Drive with traffic in single file - close to the right-hand side of the roadway and watch for opening car doors.
8. Keep your bicycle in good repair.
9. Equip your bicycle with headlight, reflector and horn or bell.
10. Always walk bicycle across busy intersections.
11. Drive carefully, especially on wet or slippery streets.
12. Keep safe following distance - never hitch onto other moving vehicles.

THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY OF YEAR

THE PHARISEES AND JESUS. Today's gospel is the well-known criticism of the "Pharisees", synonymous with outward show or hypocrisy. The actual Pharisees of Jesus' time included many good men who did not deserve this rebuke, men like Nicodemus, Joseph of Arimathea, and the rabbis Hillel and Gamaliel. The gospel is really a rebuke of hypocrisy anywhere and a call to become great by a life of service. The pharisees did, though, many good deeds, but it was not so much a deed of healing as it was one of judgment, a task of upholding the law. They were experts in distinguishing right from wrong and exhorted the Jewish people to the right, but they knew not what to do with the wrong-doer. Jesus taught them the love of forgiveness, a love which welcomes the prodigal and refuses to dwell on old grievances and which places healing before judgment.

THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY OF YEAR

PREPARING FOR THE LORD. Christians should prepare for the coming of the Lord, as the five sensible bridesmaids prepared for the arrival of the groom. Sometimes we waste our time, live thoughtlessly or just take it easy. At other times we try to prepare for this coming by realizing that each of us must some day die - when and where and how we do not know. Although we must prepare for it, death is not an end, but the beginning of a new life. We can also prepare by doing all we can for the sick who are near to death.

CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT. On Sunday, Nov. 19, there will be a second collection to give assistance to the American Catholic Bishops in a nationwide effort to attack poverty at its roots - through education, development and allocation to self-help projects. A good local example is the Grandmarie Marketing Co-op in Sunset, La. Poor farmers, black and white, had been receiving a pittance for growing sweet potatoes. To crack their poverty cycle, they decided to pool their resources and start a cooperative. With assistance from the Southern Coop Development Fund, whose operating expenses are paid from a grant from the Human Development Campaign, they were able to begin. Prices are now competitive and from their sales, farmers can return a portion of their income to the co-op. Special envelopes will distributed after the Masses Sunday.

ANNUAL THANKSGIVING CLOTHING DRIVE. To coincide with the Human Development Campaign, we will have the annual clothing drive from Nov. 19 - 26. Please bring clothing & bedding to the overhangs.

PRIMARY GRADES (1-4) MASS. The Las Vegas Party on the evening of November 11th in our classroom for Mass will put the religious education program students in the church for the 9:45 Mass on Sunday, Nov. 12. Children in grades 1 - 4 in both catholic and public schools of the parish are invited to join in the singing, offertory gifts and the entire Mass liturgy. High school and college students are invited to sing with the lead choir group. A part of the section of the church nearest the annex will be reserved for our primary grade children. Parents and other adults, join in singing, too!

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

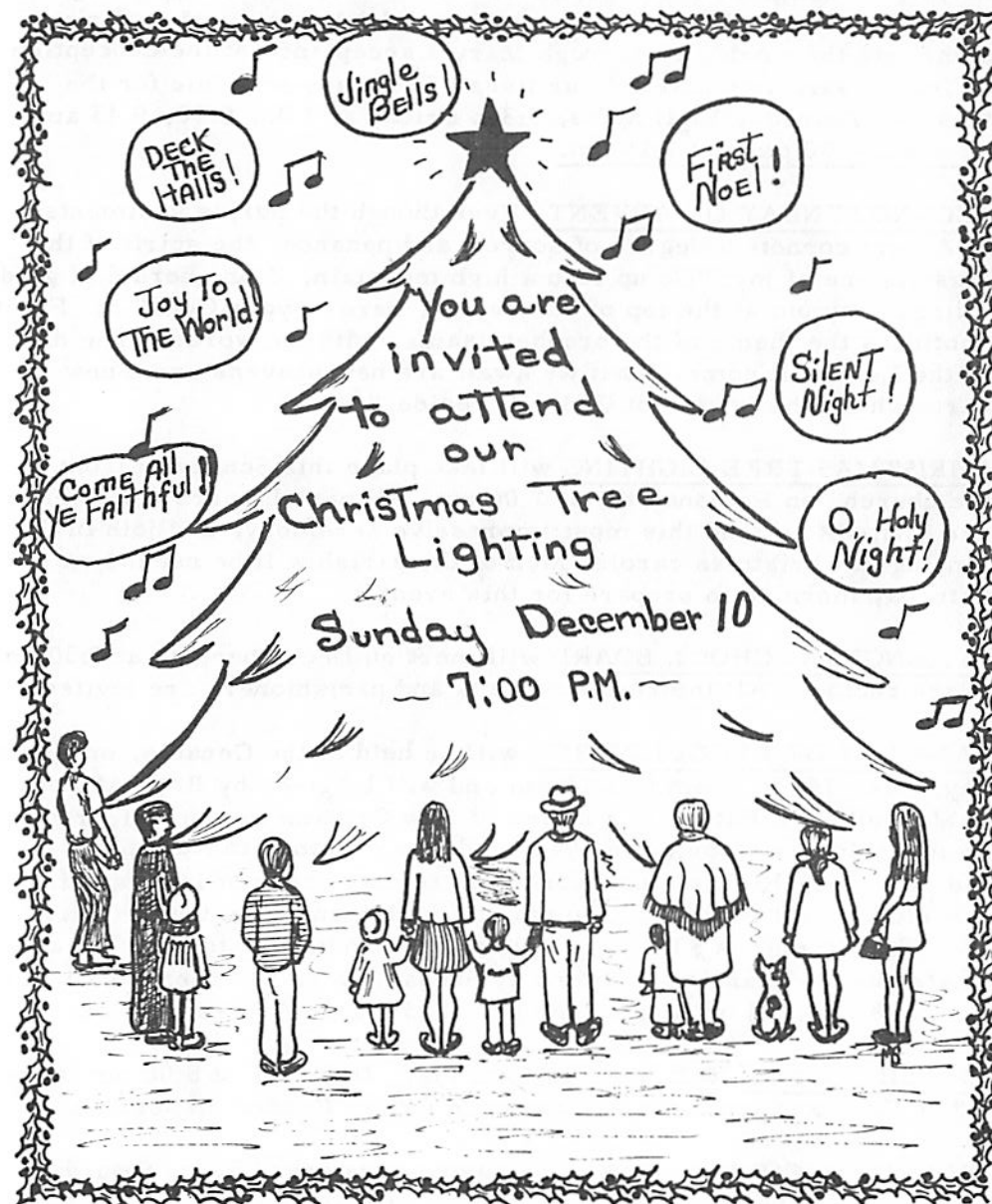
