



SECOND SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

GOD'S CALL. Today's readings are the story of vocations, the call by which a man is invited to serve God - the call of prophets like Samuel, of apostles like Andrew & Simon, and people like all of us to commitments of love and service. We look for the guidelines of the gospel in choosing life's occupations, and we find it in simple words like: Love your neighbor. Serve his needs. Formerly it was common to equate the word "vocation" with priest, nun, brother - and we called it a "religious vocation". But then we rediscovered the truth that everyone's vocation, all life, should be religious. By that we mean that all life should be reverenced and directed to the end of service and praise. It should be acknowledged as a gift, a sign of the giver and a pledge of continued existence. All life should be reverenced - we do not mean merely the awe at the sight of the Grand Canyon, but the respect for the unborn, the aged, the other color or race, for any human being because he bears, not the mark of Cain, but the image of God.

PARISH REVIEW OF 1972. Each year the Pastor sends to the Archdiocesan Chancery a "status animarum" (state of souls) report which reviews the spiritual ministry of the parish in the previous year.

Each Sunday about 3900 persons worshipped in our church. About 1900 of these regularly receive Holy Communion on Sundays and holydays. Including the number who attend Mass on weekdays and special services, the number of communicants at all Masses and services in 1972 totaled a record 162,500.

Thirty-five couples were united in Matrimony, most of them at Nuptial Masses. Twenty-seven of the couples were both Catholic, while 8 were of mixed religions. The number of baptisms (here and in most churches of the country) decreased in 1972; 100 infants and 5 adults were baptised at St. Angela. Burials in the year totaled 43, nearly all of them at a Requium Mass. One-hundred forty-five of our young parishioners were in the Confirmation Class of the past year.

The report on parish finances will be provided in the brochure and letter being mailed to all parishioners on January 15. The annual financial report for the fiscal year 1972-73 will be published in July.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY will be observed from January 18-25. In these times of renewal we need to emphasize the importance of our common commitment to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and to seek his guidance both as individuals and as the Corporate Body of Christ in these days of great change.



FOURTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

FEAST OF ST. ANGELA is now celebrated on January 27th. On Friday, January 26, the students of St. Angela Merici School will participate in a special Mass in honor of St. Angela at 8:30 am. All parishioners are invited to attend Mass on Saturday, January 27, in honor of St. Angela Merici who founded the Ursuline Community. St. Angela was an Italian girl who dedicated her life to the task of christian education. She named her community after the patroness of Catholic education, St. Ursula. The Ursuline Nuns arrived in the city of New Orleans in 1727. Over 200 years later in September 1965, they began their teaching apostolate in the parish that was named for their foundress, St. Angela Merici.

GIVE YOUR SHARE. Laymen from St. Angela spoke at all Masses on Sunday, January 21, explaining the financial status of our parish and projecting parish needs in the coming years. We were all asked to reconsider each year our efforts to return to God some of his gifts to us and our loved ones. Our parish financial team recommends the following: 1) In the coming year parishioners are asked, if possible, to increase their contribution by about 6% 2) Families are asked to budget the Conscientious Offertory Giving contribution with insurance payment, house and car notes, etc., 3) Make church contribution by check on a monthly basis, 4) Support all special parish fund raising activities, e.g. Parish Fair, 5) Pray daily for and support the total church apostolate. Put cards of intent in basket at Sunday Mass or drop off at rectory.

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL PROGRAM. For the discussions to be held in the parish during Lent we need 20 homes for the sessions. The success of the program depends on you. Contact rectory for dates.

SPECIAL NOTICE - In the past few months the parishioners of St. Angela have had to foot bills amounting to hundred of dollars to replace and repair items at the church and school which have been broken or stolen - windows, doors, lavatory fixtures, choral books, railing on the ramp, etc. The key to the mission and poor boxes has been stolen and the boxes looted. Intercom speakers costing over \$100 have been taken from annex classrooms. In addition, vandals have torn down and damaged beyond repair the fence nearest Vets. Hwy. Replacement of the fence is costing the parish over \$300. 



EIGHTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

CONFIRMATION will be administered to our 8th graders on Monday, April 2. A special meeting for the parents of these confirmands will be held on Monday, March 19, at 8:00 pm in the church. Parents of the students in St. Angela Merici School, the Religious Education Classes and those who attend private schools should make every effort to attend.

ANNUAL REGINA MATRUM AWARD. Each year on the day after Mother's Day (May 14 this year) the Archdiocesan Office of Education makes a presentation to the Christian Mother of the Year, the "Regina Matrum" (Queen of Mothers). Nominations are normally presented by the various organizations of a parish - parish council, ladies' organization, parents' club, etc. The nomination form requests information about the person's activity at a parish, interparochial and diocesan level, as well as contributions to the civic community. Parishioners may recommend persons for nomination by submitting the name and a brief summary of the accomplishments of the person. This information should be forwarded to the rectory, along with the name and phone number of the person who is submitting the nomination. It will then be presented to the parish organizations for their consideration. Deadline for receipt of nomination form in the Office of Education is March 26th, in the parish Sunday, March 4th.



FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

LENTEN PENANCE. The traditional forms of Lenten Penance - namely, fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and abstinence on the Fridays of Lent - have been preserved by the Bishops of the United States as the recommended expression of corporate penance for the Faithful. While the observance of this community penance is not to be considered as binding under pain of sin, it follows that those who choose not to fulfill the recommended Lenten observances are conscience-bound to adopt other penitential forms in the light of the Church's clear teaching that by Divine Law all are bound to do penance.

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL PROGRAM. The time is drawing near. We hope that everyone is planning to participate and have marked their calendars for March 31 through April 13. Two Dominican priests will be here during these two weeks to preach at Sunday Masses and at the 8:30 daily Masses and possibly our evening Lenten Masses. Also, sessions will be conducted in homes through out the parish, Monday - Friday in the morning and evening. The basic topics for the sessions will be 1) What is Faith? 2) Who is this person Jesus? 3) How can we establish a deeper personal and community relationship with Him?
