THE DOMINICAN FATHERS who will conduct the renewal program, Frs. Mike Champlin and Carson Champlin, will live in the Adult Center during the two weeks of the program and be available for counseling in the Adult Center office in the afternoon. Both fathers are experienced preachers and spiritual directors. Fr. Mike is a social psychologist and taught in the Dominican Seminary in Chicago. He also taught on the high school and college level, and was a therapist in a mental hospital in Georgia. Fr. Carson has been a missionary and teacher in Nigeria, Africa for 10 years and was a retreat master for both European and native clergy. Fr. Carson joined the Dominican Team in the spring of 1972. We welcome both of the Fathers to St. Angela Parish.

COMMUNAL PENANCE SERVICE. The Sacrament of Penance will be administered at the evening Mass on Tuesday, April 10 beginning at 7:15 pm. This will be a communal Penance Service as part of the Spiritual Renewal Program. Individual private confessions will be heard, but we will perform a common penance together to acknowledge our sinfulness as a community. An explanation of some of the aspects of the sacrament will be given at this time. A number of priests will be hearing confessions so it should not take too long. In order to perform our penance as a community we ask that you be prepared to remain for the entire ceremony.

COMMUNAL ANOINTING OF THE SICK SERVICE. The bishops of the world have recently published a new liturgical rite in which the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is administered within the context of the celebration of Mass. This is an attempt to reemphasize the fact, lost so long in our tradition, that this is a sacrament, the primary intention of which, is to bring about healing. St. James in his letter, tells us to anoint the sick person and pray for him so that he might be healed and return to the worshipping community. The renewal session on Friday, April 13, will be held in the church and will begin at 7:15 pm. We encourage everyone to attend this Mass and pray for those in the parish who are sick.

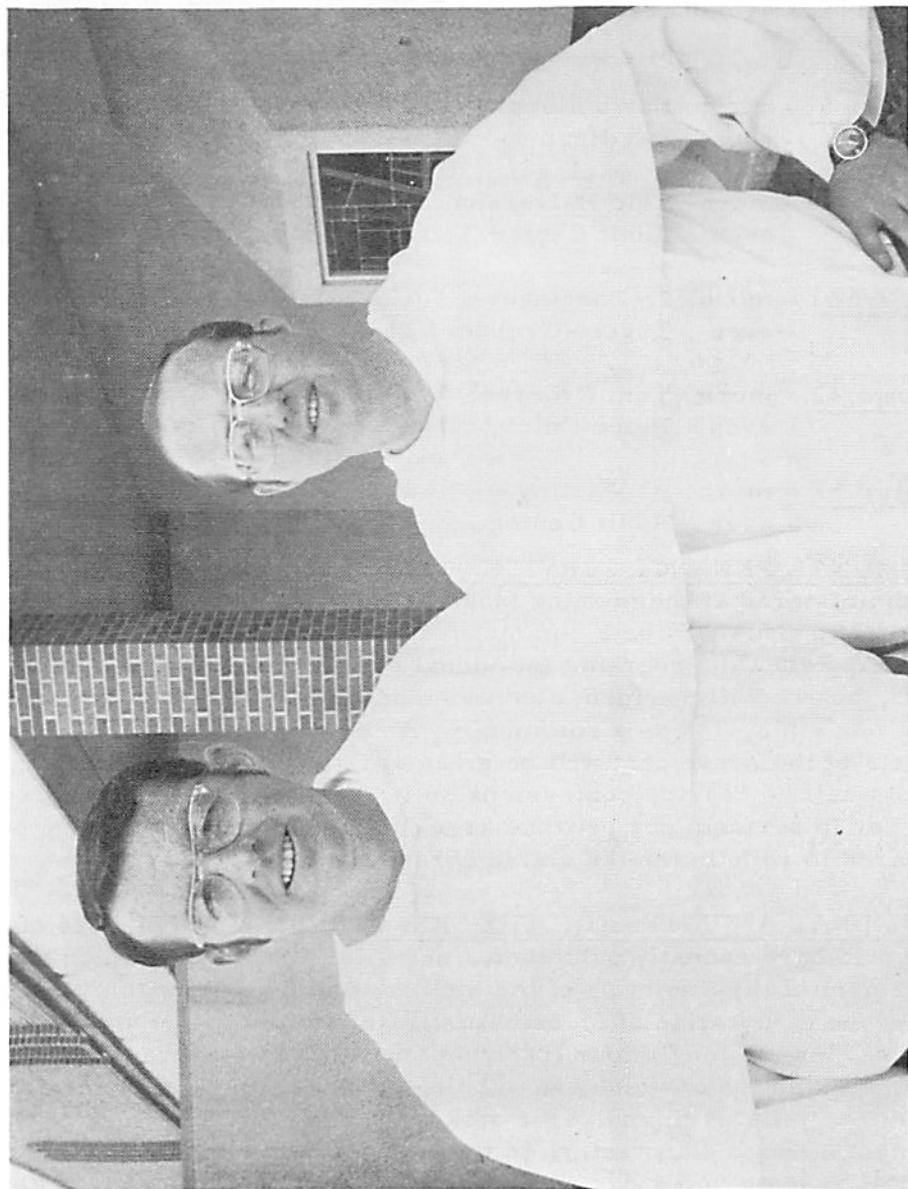

ANointing OF THE SICK. "If any of you is sick, he should send for the priests of the church and they should anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord and pray over him. The prayer of faith will save the sick man and the Lord will raise him up again; and if he has committed any sins he will be forgiven" So said St. James in his epistle. The Second Vatican Council, in the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, said, "Extreme Unction, which may also and more fittingly be called Anointing of the Sick, is not a sacrament for only those who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as any one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the appropriate time for him to receive this sacrament has arrived." With this thought in mind and with frustration about the current practice and theology surrounding the sacrament of the sick, in connection with our Spiritual Renewal Program, we will have a Communal Anointing of the Sick Service on Friday, April 13th, to be held in the church beginning at 7:15 pm. We encourage all parishioners to attend and pray for those in the parish who are sick.

BLESSING OF THE PALMS will take place at 5:15 pm on Saturday, April 14th, outside the church doors, with procession into Church. All are asked to congregate outside the church, receive a palm and join in the procession into church. This solemn ceremony initiates for us Holy Week, a time for serious reflection on the passion and death of Our Lord. You will notice the Holy Week schedule of services in this issue. Please keep for easy reference near phone.

WHITE FLOWERS are needed for Holy Thursday and Easter Sunday. Bring or have sent on Holy Thursday and Holy Saturday mornings. Many easter lillies have been ordered and monetary offerings will be appreciated. Your contribution may be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the collection basket or sent to the rectory.

CONGRATULATIONS to all our parishioners who attended the Renewal programs. We pray that the lessons learned may carry over into our daily lives. Our sincere thanks to the Dominicans, Fr. Mike and Fr. Carson, who gave us such an inspiring two weeks.

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

LOVE. When we listen to God's message, the Holy Spirit comes upon us in a special way. "God is love", not as though any kind of love were God. For love means sacrifice. Love for others is the Christian commandment. The great scandal to the world is that so often Christians are no more loving than unbelievers. Wouldn't the whole world be Christian by now if we had consistently lived up to Christ's command? In the Eucharist we accept not only God's great gift, but each other, too. Sharing in the same "Bread", we become one with the same Christ. This should produce love.

THURSDAY, MAY 31st, IS ASCENSION THURSDAY, a holyday of obligation. Attendance at Holy Mass is required just as on a Sunday. The Mass schedule is: Vigil Mass on Wednesday, at 5:30 pm. Masses on Thursday at 7:00, 8:30, 9:45, 12 noon, 6:00 and 7:15 pm.

Father was born on December 5, 1935 in New Orleans and attended Mater Dolorosa Elementary and Jesuit High Schools. He entered St. Joseph Seminary in 1954 and was ordained in 1962 after studies at Notre Dame Seminary majoring in Philosophy and minoring in History and at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, concentrating on Dogma. Father furthered his studies for teacher certification at Xavier University and Catholic University of America and received certification for secondary Latin and Social Studies. After attending Tulane University and majoring in School Administration he received his Master of Education with certification in administration and supervision. Father has served as assistant at St. Theresa Child of Jesus Church from 1962-70 and served at St. John Prep as Vice-Rector, Principal and Rector-Principal from 1964-71. Currently he is Coordinator of Permanent Diaconate for the Archdiocese and is Pro-Synodal Judge for the Matrimonial Tribunal. Father is on the Personnel Committee of the Archdiocese and is President of St. Joseph College Seminary Alumni.

WELCOME TO FATHER GERALD A. DOUGLASS. Most of the parishioners know Father from his year of service as a deacon here last year. Father Douglass was born on July 25, 1947 in New Orleans, the youngest of four boys. After attending St. Rita Elementary School and DeLaSalle High, he graduated from St. Joseph Seminary with a BA in English. On March 25, 1972 he was ordained a deacon and in May of last year he graduated from Notre Dame with a Master of Divinity Degree. On May 12th of this year Father was ordained a priest and begins his first priestly duties here at St. Angela. God's blessings to him.

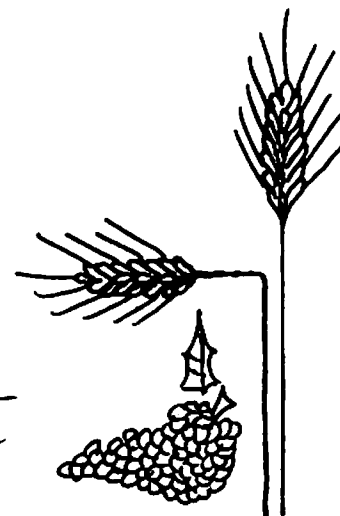

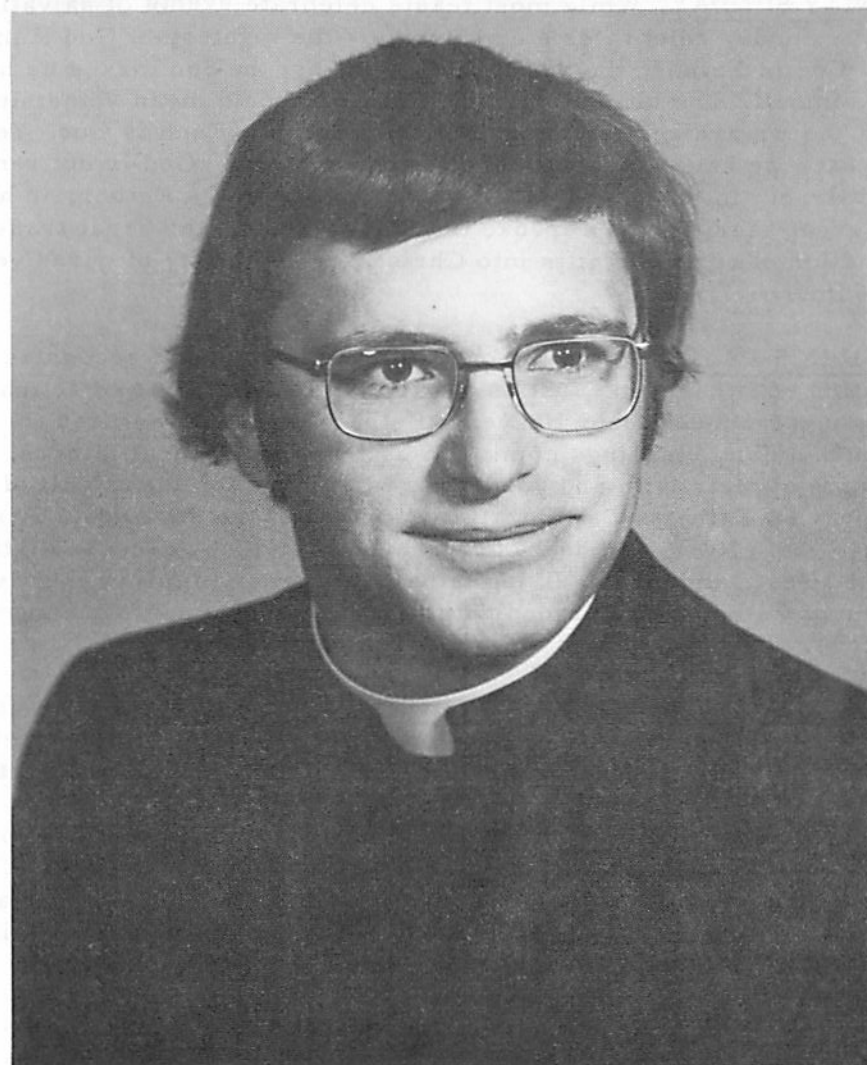
