PETER & PAUL, Apostles

STS. PETER and PAUL, the two apostles who gave their lives for Christ in Rome, are honored as pillars of the Church. Both were rescued by the Lord, both died for Him, both are now in glory with Him. For all his humanness, Peter is still the rock on which Christ built His Church. In venerating Peter's successor, we really venerate Christ, who has given him (if not omniscience) high, reassuring promises. Paul was poured "out like a libation". He shared in Christ's sacrifice, and now in his reward. To share in the Eucharist means to accept our part in the apostolate, which implies self-giving.

INDEPENDENCE DAY. As Americans we have special reasons to thank God for the blessings of freedom, enjoyed by relatively few members of the human family. Though a secular holiday, Independence Day should be a feast, not of gloating, but of humble thanksgiving. Freedom implies responsibility. If we are free to lead out lives as children of God, we are not free to shirk challenges and civic, social duties. If much has been given to us, much is expected in return.

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

PROPHETS are disturbing, hence never popular. Even Christ was not accepted in his own country. Paul, as Christ's follower gladly accepted the sufferings involved and even "gloried in his infirmities". All Christians are given a share in the gift of prophecy: to spread the word of God, according to their talents and vocation. This involves a measure of courage and willingness to accept some rejection. In the Eucharist we renew our commitment to God in Christ. Sharing in Christ's body and blood, we accept our responsibility as prophets - minor ones, to be sure, but courageous.

NEWS FROM ESQUIPULAS - "We have recently extended ourselves to work in a Pueblo where the Priest arrives only once a week; the smaller "aldeas" once a year. The "aldeas" or small villages are so scattered through the mountains that he is unable to get to them oftener. We are assisting him in extending himself to bring the "Word of God" to those people who are so eager to hear the message of the "Good News". We appreciate and depend so very much on your support. We ask your prayers for ourselves and the people of these villages of San Jacinto and Esquipulas. The school in Esquipulas is helping to share the Montessori Method of teaching, which is a way of enriching the education of the poor and "better off" with a school to care for 50 children (ages 2 1/2 and 6). Half of the children are not able to pay more than 25¢ a month. The other half pay \$5.00 a month which is a way the "better off" share in the responsibility." - -Do your share by regular contributions in our mission box in church. Please do not forget to pray daily for the missions and for the missionaries - especially for our adopted mission in Esquipulas.



SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

GOD AS OUR SHEPHERD is the theme of today's liturgy. There are those who would divide and scatter. In Christ is our peace, since he has compassion on those without a shepherd. We are sheep, but we are also called to aid the Good Shepherd. Our lives should aim at unity rather than division. The world badly needs the sort of Christian presence that will proclaim Christ's "good news of peace". In the Eucharist we are most closely linked with the Good Shepherd. He is both Lamb of God (our victim) and shepherd (our priest joining us to each other and to the Father), especially in the Mass.





TWENTIETH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

THE EUCHARIST continues to be the theme for the liturgy. The Old Testament invites us to eat of God's food and drink of his wine. Christ insists that we must eat of his flesh and drink of his blood. This way we live by his life as he lives by his Father's life. Christ did not water down his eucharistic promise, despite murmuring and quarreling among his hearers. The psalmist urges us to taste and see the goodness of the Lord. This means, as Paul reminds us, reflection and discernment, praising the Lord with all our hearts. In the Eucharist, most of all, we give thanks to God the Father in the name of Christ, "in psalms and hymns and inspired songs". Then in communion, we will "have life because of" Christ.

THE ARCHDIOCESAN "HORIZONS" PROGRAM FOR HOMES FOR THE AGED provides a golden opportunity for everyone to contribute towards the basic dignity of human life. In addition, it is literally "for all our tomorrows", since by the end of this century everyone who is now 38 years of age or older will be 65 or older. Even those of us who may now feel secure may one day look towards the "Horizons" homes for himself or for his family or his friends. Yet, even aside from the possible personal motive, is that "in deep respect for life, man best fulfills his role on earth". It is hoped that a substantial part of the \$4.4 million goal for the five homes involved will come from parish-wide solicitation. This will occur if every thoughtful parishioner will pledge as generously as he can and also, if possible, will assist in encouraging others to do so. Plans are now proceeding towards requests for pledges throughout this region on "Horizons Sunday", Sunday, September 9. Participants will be involved in perhaps the most meaningful mass movement to assist the elderly that this area has ever seen.

ST. ANGELA PARISH COUNCIL met last Tuesday for their regular meeting. Some of the topics discussed were the financial needs for the 1973-74 fiscal year, the hiring of a plant maintenance manager for the parish, the implementation of a religious program of instruction for prospective converts, a new baptism program and Horizons Homes for the Aged. Two motions were passed - first, acceptance of the report from the maintenance committee headed by Mr. Tom Osborne. The second motion requested that \$25,000 be allocated for plant repairs and maintenance for 1973-74 to be contingent upon being able to get the Archdiocese to reduce our parish debt payment.



TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY OF YEAR

HORIZONS. On this Labor Day week end it is appropriate to think of those many thousands of elderly persons who have worked hard all of their years but who now are no longer able to cope with life without the assistance of others. It is for people such as these that the Archdiocese of New Orleans is conducting its "Horizons" Program for Homes for the Aged. St. Angela Merici Parish will join with 101 other parishes throughout the New Orleans area in observing "Horizons Sunday" next week, on September 9. Each family which has not already made its subscription to the \$4.4 million campaign is asked to do so on that date. It is hoped that all will participate to the extend of their ability and a guideline of 1% of annual income has been suggested. Pledges are payable over a 12 month period, thus offering tax deductibility in two calendar years. Our parish goal is \$65,000. The "Horizons" Campaign is a shared responsibility of Catholic families and of businesses, foundations and individuals of all religions and races in the total community. "Advance Gifts" solicitation already has produced commitments considerably in excess of a half a million dollars. For countless numbers of years Christians have sought help for the elderly, especially those in need of such basic things as shelter, food, medical attention - and love. Now on "Horizons Sunday" thousands of volunteer workers in the parishes of the Archdiocese of New Orleans will respond to the words of John (XIII, 35): "By this all men will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."



JEALOUSY. Once again the scripture readings warn us against jealousy. Like Moses' disciples, Christ's own were jealous - not for God's glory but their own. James warns us against such love of wealth and power. Sometimes our tribal loyalties, even loyalty toward the Church, can be a mask for selfishness. This damages all human relations, not least the growth of ecumenism and international peace. Accepting Christ in the Eucharist is tantamount to surrenduring our egotism and egoism. Our eucharistic "Amen" is a pledge to put Christ at the center of our lives.
