ACTION REQUESTED. Despite abortionists' propaganda that abortion is a private matter, the anti-life movement has long been financed by federal funds often funneled through foundations such as the Rockefeller Foundation. There is now pending in the U.S. Senate another bill which would provide \$141,000,000 to Planned Parenthood and Planned Parenthood International. This money, as it now stands, can be used to further the pro-abortion movement. Please write Sen. Russell Long and Sen. J. Bennet Johnson (U.S. Senate, Washington, D.C. 20515) as soon as possible asking that they support the abortion prohibition amendment that will be added to Senate Bill 2335, Section 104 by Senator Helm. This amendment would have the effect of curtailing the use of this money so that it cannot be used to promote abortion worldwide. WRITE TODAY.

THIRTIETH SUNDAY OF YEAR

GOD'S PEOPLE RESTORED AND HEALED. The Lord will deliver us, even if we are a mere remnant. He has given us a Priest forever, taken from among us, but his own Son. If we pray like the blind man, with trust, our prayer will be answered. Through Jesus we can call God our Father. Our consequent attitude will be that of trusting children, never deeply afraid but always sure of his help, regardless of how hopeless things sometimes appear. In the Eucharist more than elsewhere we experience Christ's presence as our Priest. If we ask him, he will open our eyes to the consoling reality of that presence.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 1st, IS ALL SAINTS DAY, a holy day of obligation. On this day we honor all persons who presently enjoy the happiness of heaven. The Mass schedule will be: on Wednesday, Vigil Mass at 5:30 pm; on Thursday Masses will be at 7:00, 8:30, 9:45, 12 noon, 6:00 and 7:15 pm. No classes for St. Angela School students.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 2nd, IS ALL SOULS DAY. On this day we pray for all persons who have died and are saved but have not yet entered into the happiness of heaven. Just as we can help one another here on earth, so also the deceased. This we do by our prayers and good works. The Mass schedule on this day will be: 6:30 and 8:30 am and 7:15 pm.

ENVELOPES ATTACHED to this Parish Message are for your use to enroll your deceased loved ones for Masses on All Souls Day and for Masses offered throughout the year.

NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH TO REMEMBER THE DECEASED.

This can best be done by praying for their souls and calling to mind their good qualities (to be imitated) or bad qualities (to be avoided). All parishioners are asked to remain in Church after the Masses every Sunday during November to spend a few minutes of silent prayer for deceased loved ones.

ADULT CONFIRMATION will be administered at St. Louis Cathedral on Sunday, December 9th, at 3:00 pm. Anyone who has reached their fourteenth birthday may be presented as a candidate. For further information contact the rectory as soon as possible.

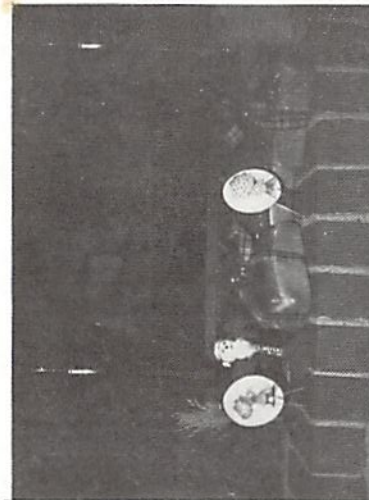
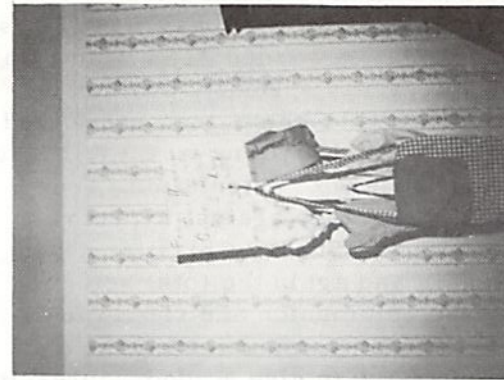
