ADULT INQUIRY CLASSES. 

THIRD SUNDAY OF YEAR

C.O.G. CAMPAIGN. As was stated in the financial talk by members of our Parish Council last Sunday, to continue to operate the parish on a sound financial basis and accomplish proposed plans for the year, we will need approximately a 12% increase in envelope contributions. To accomplish this we ask all to conscientiously review their envelope contributions, keeping in mind the needs of the Church. To those who are not using envelopes, we suggest a conscientious effort to remedy this situation. Information on the C.O.G. Campaign will be mailed to all families this week. We ask that you read the material. Please fill out the Card of Intent and return in the collection basket or by mail to the rectory, as soon as possible. Indicate clearly what your offering will be on a weekly or monthly basis - this will indicate the type of envelope that will be mailed to you.



SEVENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR

LENTEN SERMON SERIES. The picture of Fr. J. Emile Pfister, S.J. is on our cover today. Father will be the featured speaker for our Lenten Sermon Series each Tuesday night at 7:30 pm during Lent. Father Pfister is a native of New Orleans and received his elementary education at Holy Name of Jesus School. He attended Jesuit High School. In 1955, Fr. Pfister began his theological studies in Europe, at College St. Augustin, Enghien, Belgium and continued at the Jesuit House of Studies, Chantilly, France. During these years he also pursued summer courses and travelled in France, Belgium, Germany, Switzerland and Spain. On June 18, 1958, he was ordained to the priesthood and completed his final year of theological studies at St. Louis University of Divinity (S. T. L., Licentiate Sacred Theology, magna cum laude, 1960). In 1962, Father was granted a leave of absence from Loyola to begin his beinnium for his Doctorate in Sacred Theology at the Pontifical Facutly of Theology of Woodstock College, Maryland. On May 28, 1964 he was awarded the S. T. D. (Doctorate in Sacred Theology) summa cum laude. Father Pfister is a noted theologian and lecturer in the United States.





To the Clergy, Religious and Laity of the Archdiocese of New Orleans

My dear people of God:

The essence of our Christian faith is hope, or confidence, in the mercy and power of God. Lent is the pre-eminent opportunity for us to renew our hope in God. Conversion or repentance means turning to God.

This concept of hope and trust in God is not only the message of Christ. but also that of the old Testament. The prophets appealed to the people, as did John the Baptist, to repent so that they would be open to the mercy and power of God. The prophet Joel proclaimed this message when he said, "Even now, says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart, with fasting, and weeping and mourning; rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the Lord, your God. For gracious and merciful is he, slow to anger, rich in kindness and relenting in punishment."

Our difficulties prove dramatically that we are in a time of spiritual crisis -- the kidnappings by extremist groups, the crime that renders us fearful even in our neighborhoods, the pre-occupation with the power of the devil as seen in the morbid fascination with "The Exercist,"

Our crisis -- personal and national -- can be overcome by our return to God, by becoming the "very holiness of God" as St. Paul stated. By identifying ourselves with Christ, we can conquer every evil and make death the portal of heaven.

We identify ourselves with Christ by our charity, by making His love the pattern of our life. By this means, every trial and frustration becomes another source of joy and triumph. The great Christian artist, Mestrovic, who suffered many tragedies stated. "Learn the secret of love and you will discover the secret of death and believe in life eternal."

The Lent of this Holy Year should stir us to seek all the joy and hope that come from living with God. Living with God means being generous in attending Mass frequently, performing works of penance and contributing to works of charity as the HORIZONS fund and other worthy causes. This hope will give us the freedom from the cares and evils that beset us.

By your observance of Lent may God keep holding you in His hands and thus may we all be joined in Him, now and in eternity.

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

AMERICAN CATHOLIC OVERSEAS AID FUND will be taken up in all the churches of the Archdiocese this Sunday.
