PASSION SUNDAY. This week we relive the passion of Christ, starting with the procession of palms. As we listen to Luke's account of Christ's suffering and death, we recall that he did this out of obedience and love for us. St. Paul tells us to be more than listeners: our attitude must be the same as that of Christ. We accept our human situation, even death, and will be joined with Christ in both death and resurrection. In the Mass, Christ's passion and death are renewed. As he gave himself for us, we must be willing to give ourselves in return. In communion we accept him and all that this means.

OUR LENTEN SERMON SERIES concludes on Tuesday at 7:30 pm in Church with the topic "The Christian in the Modern World - Marriage and Family". Following the services in church, there will be an informal discussion of the topic at the Adult Education Center. We urge all of our parishioners to attend. 

SEMINARY COLLECTION. We want to express our thanks to the parishioners for the generous response to the Easter collection. We well exceeded our quota as you can see from the collection report on the opi osite page. The excess revenue will remain in our parish operational fund. Please continue to pray for the success of our seminary programs, our seminarians and for an increase of vocations.

THE PARISH COUNCIL met during Holy Week. Among the motions passed was 1) the granting to the School Board \$6,000 to help cover the cost of the teacher pay raises, 2) permission for SALA to consider using their funds to convert rooms 103 & 104 into meeting and/or reception rooms by the addition of kitchen facilities and refurbishing of the extra rooms. Sr. Mary Ellen thanked SALA for handling the school "Lost & Found" and for hosting the lovely reception for the confirmands and their families. Fr. Favalora said the response to the Lenten services was most gratifying.

TWELFTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

FOLLOW JESUS DAY BY DAY, is the theme for this Sunday's liturgy. Zechariah foretells that "they shall look on the one they have pierced." Jesus foretells that he will endure much, even death, and challenges us to self-denial and the cross. This time of the year we think of the Sacred Heart - symbol of Jesus crucified and self-giving. He was pierced for us; our response should be comparable. Christ's offering in the Eucharist is total. To be a Christian means to be linked with Him, on the cross as well as in His resurrection.
