FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

GOD'S PEACE. We are to rejoice and glory even in the cross of Christ. In baptism we are created anew. Our names are inscribed in heaven, and this gives us cause to rejoice. The reign of God is at hand. But it is not yet fully actualized. Our inscription in heaven is dependent on our being joined to Christ in crucifixion. In the Eucharist we constantly give thanks for being called. Yet, the only true thanksgiving involves serious commitment.

SPECIAL MASS. On Thursday morning, July 11 from 9:30 a.m. - noon, special services where the healing ministry of Christ will be emphasized. Sr. Briege McKeana (sister of St Clare) will be present as speaker and offer special prayers for healing. Parishioners are invited to attend this service to pray especially that our loving Father heal our hearts and turn them more fully to Himself. This invitation is also being extended to members of Charismatic prayer groups in the area.

Sr. Briege will speak at 10 a.m. and concelebrated Mass will be at 10:30 a.m. Msgr. Henry Bezou and Father Harold Cohen will be concelebrants.

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

GOD'S COMMAND is in our hearts. It means loving God wholly and loving our neighbor as our self. This involves conversion, returning to the Lord with whole hearts. The Good Samaritan parable is most relevant. For the test of love of God is love of neighbor--not necessarily our friendly neighbors or those of our own kind. In the Eucharist we profess our love for God. As we go away into the world, we must carry this into real love of others.

LECTORS. On Tuesday, July 16 at 8pm, Adult Education Center, there will be an informal meeting of all present lectors and all other parishioners interested in serving as lectors at the Sunday liturgy. Those who already indicated a desire to assist with the readings are urged to attend this meeting. Therefore, unless we are advised that someone is admitted to non-catholic hospitals by relatives or friends we have no way of knowing that they are hospitalized. We will appreciate your charity in assisting us with this matter.
