GOD'S PEACE. We are to rejoice and glory even in the cross of Christ. In baptism we are created anew. Our names are inscribed in heaven, and this gives us cause to rejoice. The reign of God is at hand. But it is not yet fully actualized. Our inscription in heaven is dependent on our being joined to Christ in crucifixion. In the Eucharist we constantly give thanks for being called. Yet, the only true thanksgiving involves serious commitment.

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR


GOD'S COMMAND is in our hearts. It means loving God wholly and loving our neighbor as our self. This involves conversion, returning to the Lord with whole hearts. The Good Samaritan parable is most relevant. For the test of love of God is love of neighbor -- not necessarily our friendly neighbors or those of our own kind. In the Eucharist we profess our love for God. As we go away into the world, we must carry this into real love of others.

LECTORS.
