



THIRTIETH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

PEOPLE SEARCH. In cooperation with the Greater New Orleans Federation of Churches, the Archdiocese of New Orleans is cooperating in conducting a "phone census" of some 400,000 homes this weekend, from Friday, October 25 through Sunday, October 27. It is an effort to reach out to the "unchurched" people of our area and bring them back to a personal relationship with God. St. Angela Parish is providing 50 volunteers for the calls. We ask that you cooperate with the census taker if you are called.



THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

RESURRECTION on the last day is the theme of this Sunday's liturgical readings. The book of Maccabees promised the resurrection to the seven heroic brothers who died for God's law. Christ reaffirms the teaching of the resurrection, and he himself rose first. Paul urges us to live our lives in this firm promise. The resurrection is, of course, mysterious and unacceptable to such cynics as the Saducees, who saw everything in crude categories. Scripture reminds us that we cannot yet grasp what it will mean. But we accept it as a central Christian truth and try to live even now in terms of the resurrection. "Christ has risen. Christ will come again", we proclaim during the Mass. For in every Eucharist we celebrate the risen Christ, and in communion he plants the seeds of resurrection.

NEW VESTMENTS. Our set of new vestments in all liturgical colors has been completed. The vestments were paid for with donations given throughout the year for church improvements. LATEST CHANGES IN MASS BOOKS

On December 1, 1974, the First Sunday of Advent, all dioceses of the United States will begin the newly approved Sacramentary of the Second Vatican Council. The Sacramentary is the book containing all the prayers to be used by the priest in the celebration of the Eucharist. This latest altar book is the first complete revision of the prayers of the Mass to be issued since the 1570 Roman Missal decreed by the Council of Trent; but it is in the tradition of the many revisions and additions of the prayers of the Eucharistic celebration dating back to the early years of the Roman Liturgy.

The 1974 Sacramentary is the most recent concrete result of the mandate of the bishops at Vatican II to revise the sacred liturgy in such a way "that devout and active participation by the faithful may be more easily accomplished" (Decree on the Sacred Liturgy, #50). Earlier revisions in the Mass put the language of the celebration into the vernacular, arranged for larger portions of the Bible to be read over a three-year period and added variety to the order of the Mass through choices among four Eucharistic Prayers, more Prefaces, and several penitential rites. The new Sacramentary completes this revision of the celebration of the Eucharist.

What will be most quickly and easily noticed by the congregation is the variety which the new <u>Sacramentary</u> allows. Until now, the priest could choose one of three penitential rites to begin the Eucharist; now, he has a choice among ten penitential rites. In place of this rite, on Sundays, the priest may substitute a renewal of Baptism and sprinkling of the people with holy water, a return to a revised form of the once familiar "Asperges" of solemn Mass.

The three short prayers of the Mass -- opening prayer, prayer over the gifts, and the prayer after communion -- have been rewritten, but they retain the simplicity and directness of the ancient Roman Liturgy.

In rewriting these prayers, the Church has retained the petitions which the older prayers asked of God, but has revised them to fit our modern expressions and concerns.

The number of Prefaces to the Eucharistic Prayer has been increased from twenty-two to eighty-four, offering more variety and adding prefaces suitable for special occasions, such as Independence Day and Thanksgiving Day.

The single, simple blessing of the people at the end of the Mass has been expanded to include a choice among twenty solemn blessings for Sundays, Weekdays, Feasts and Special Occasions.

Finally, the new <u>Sacramentary</u> encourages the priest to use his own words in inviting the congregation to pray: at the beginning of Mass, before the readings from Scripture, before the Preface and the Lord's Prayer, and at the end of the Mass.

Included within the new <u>Sacramentary</u> is the "Directory for Masses with Children" which allows variation and more explanation of the Mass suitable for young people. This is an attempt to allow the priest to explain the parts of the Mass to children and to adapt parts of the Mass to their capacity and ability to pray and worship.

A practical problem which comes from the richness and great variety afforded by this new altar book is that the publishers of missalettes are finding it impossible to include all the options offered. The bishops of the United States have been careful to insist that priests should not restrict their using the variety and options offered by this Sacramentary simply because not everything can be printed in the missalettes. This means that the congregation will have to listen to more and read less. However, the great richness, variety and beauty which the new book brings to the Liturgy will more than outweigh any inconvenience to the congregation and the celebrant.

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

FEAST OF IMMACULATE CONCEPTION. Also, pray for an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Adoration will close with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:15 pm.
