EPIPHANY

EPIPHANY means manifestation - the day when Jesus was manifested to all nations. Not just the chosen people, but all of us are called. The Wise Men stand in place of us all. The Wise Men came great distances, with hardships, sometimes losing their way. If we are to find Jesus we must expect sacrifices, struggles, searching to be part of the price. The Eucharist involves giving. As the Wise Men brought gifts, symbols of their adoration, we offer gifts as symbols of ourselves. These gifts are transformed.

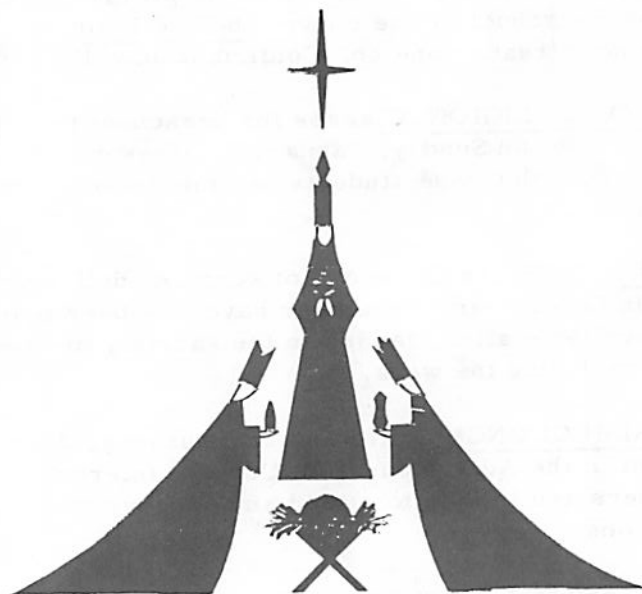

**ADULT INQUIRY CLASSES.** St. Angela Merici Parish will conduct an Adult Inquiry Program, the purpose of which would be to offer an opportunity for non-Catholics to inquire and learn about the Catholic Faith. An 8-week course of classes, combined with guidance, will be offered by a faculty of priests, religious, seminarians and adults covering the fundamental beliefs and teachings of our faith. All classes will be held on Monday evenings, beginning January 20th, from 8 to 10 pm in the Adult Education Center, concluding in Holy Week with the Sacrament of Baptism being administered at Easter. Since this is an Inquiry Program for non-Catholics, all those who participate would not necessarily be expected to receive Baptism. More information will be forth coming. Anyone interested in the program, please call the rectory for reservations.

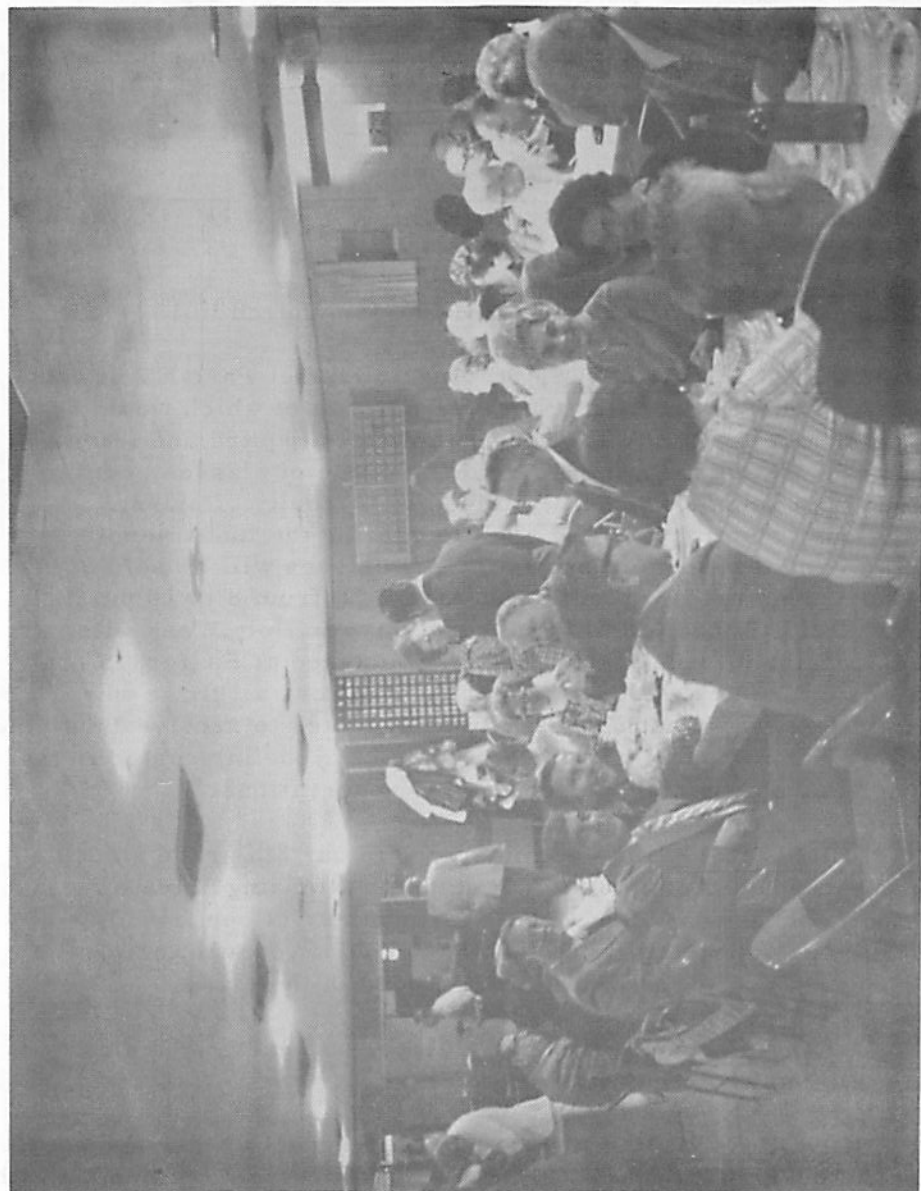

## SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**JESUS, SERVANT TO A HOLY PEOPLE.** John the Baptist, last and greatest of the prophets, saw and identified Christ as the Lamb of God, the Chosen One of God. Isaiah foresaw Him as the Light of the nations. The lamb is a symbol of gentleness and often used as sacrifice. Christ, though strong, was gentle and told us to learn of him precisely in those terms. Paul reminds us that we are called to be holy, in imitation of Christ. In the Mass we recall that Christ is the Lamb of God. It is through sacrifice and gentleness that sin is taken away. Communion is our pledge of the desire to be Christlike.

### THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

GOD'S KINGDOM. The land of Zabulon and Neftali was once worth little. Isaiah foretold and Christ fulfilled the prophecy of its transformation. In Galilee Christ called the first apostles to be fishers of men. Paul notices splits and divisions among the early Christians and warns that Christ must not be divided. Even when we disagree, we must not be split apart. Christianity means one, undivided Body of Christ. We are called to be apostles, and in the Eucharist we accept our calling. True, our tasks in the work of Christ are varied. But variety and diversity must not really divide us.
