



GOD'S WORD IN THE LITURGY. The Scripture theme today is that of sowing and good soil. God's word, his grace is like the rain of fertility. All creation is awaiting the revelation of the children of God, the full redemption of resurrection. God's word and grace come first. It is ours not to cause them but to receive them. Sinfulness and the futility of stony hardness of heart can obstruct. Our role as Christians is to receive, not to block. In the Eucharist we receive both word and sacrament. Our "Amen" is a pledge not to stymie the grace of God, but to accept the fertile rain of grace.

WE WELCOME FATHER JOHN NGHI TO ST. ANGELA PARISH.

Archbishop Hannan has assigned Father in residence at St. Angela. Father is a Vietnamese priest from the Diocese of Xuan-Loc, ordained in March 1971. He studied theology in Rome at the Propaganda Fidei College and taught in a minor seminary at Saigon before going to Rome for studies. After ordination his Bishop sent him to Fordham University in New York where he has been studying for 4 years and where he is a candidate for a doctorate in Sociology.






