The Eucharist is an epiphany, yet shrouded in much the same mystery as confronted the wise men. They saw Christ in the mystery of faith which we proclaim at Mass.

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

HUNGER FOR BREAD is this week's theme. Many persons today are physically hungry. Certainly the solution to starvation and malnutrition requires increased production and improved distribution of food. But it also requires "a concerted act of solidarity" by the nations and peoples of the world. (Synod of Bishops, 1974. Statement on Human Rights and Reconciliation). Our sharing in the Eucharist inspires us to such solidarity, as well as to actions which express it; for sincere celebration of the Eucharist "must lead to various works of charity and mutual help." (Vatican Council Decree on the Ministry and Life of Priests, 6).

PARISH DAY OF ADORATION OF BLESSED SACRAMENT. Each day during Lent various churches will sponsor an all-day adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in conjunction with the International Eucharistic Congress to be held in Philadelphia in August. 
