#### FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

HUNGER FOR PEACE is our theme for this week's homily. In an era of tension and violence, the limits of human instruments for peace are all too evident. Christ is our peace, and Christ Himself in the Eucharist provides us with both our model and best hope for peace. For it is He "who made the two of us one by breaking down the barrier of hostility that kept us apart". (Eph 2:4). It is here, in the Eucharist, that "all education in the spirit of community must originate". (Vatican Council II, Decree on the Ministry and Life of Priests, 6).

SCHOOL BOARD CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT was passed at last meeting of the Board: "That article #5, Meetings, Sec. A, be amended to read, 'All meetings of the School Board shall be open to members of St. Angela Merici Parish and to parents of children attending St. Angela Merici School. Non-school board members have the right to address the board on topics under discussion with a time limitation of three minutes. An item shall be included on each agenda under new business whereby non-school board members would be allowed to address the board on other topics.'"

MASS REQUESTS for 1976 have been so numerous that we have now scheduled all except a very few for this year. If you should wish to have any Masses offered we suggest that you contact the rectory and we can arrange to have them offered by the priests in Guatemala who would be happy to receive the stipend and also be able to offer the Masses earlier than we can here.



#### SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

LITURGY READINGS. The spirit of Easter breathes through the early Christian community, "of one heart and one mind", for they had "come through water and blood" and were to "conquer the world." Jesus brought them peace and forgiveness. During Eastertide we recall our baptism - death and resurrection in Christ - and the other Easter sacrament, that of reconciliation and peace. Penance is a sort of renewal of baptism and is meant to give peace, not anxiety or fear. In the Eucharist we share in the same risen Christ. Sharing at the same table, we imply that we are willing to share our wealth with others, in the spirit of the first Christians.
