

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS tell of God extending his teaching through the prophets. Prophets are called not so much to foretell as to proclaim. When Christ sent out the disciples to prophesy, he told them not to be attached to things. God's blessings, as Paul proclaims, are spiritual belssings. If, as Paul reminds us, we are also chosen, we have responsibilities to be prophets - proclaiming the mysteries and values of Christ to a world with unchristian priorities, lights "contrary to your own". In the Eucharist we share again and again in Christ and his blood in which "we have been redeemed and our sins forgiven". Communion thus becomes a daily challenge.

FATHER ROBERT COOPER has been assigned in residence at St. Angela by Archbishop Hannan. His appointment is effective July 6th. Father Cooper was ordained in 1971, served as associate at St. Philip Neri and St. Frances Cabrini. He now becomes a full-time professor on the faculty of St. John Vianney Prep. We welcome him to St. Angela and look forward to his assistance for week-end liturgies. We wish him well in his new assignment.

FATHER JOHN NGHI - our present priest in residence will be leaving St. Angela later in the summer to take up residence with three other Vietnamese priests nearer to their work among the Vietnamese settlements. We have been fortunate to have Father with us. We will inform you later about the specific time of his moving.







SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE MIRACLE OF ELISHA is the foreshadowing of Christ's greater miracle of feeding. This, in turn, foreshadows the fuller miracle of the life of grace, transforming us into "a life worthy of the calling we have received." Paul explains what this calling implies: we are to be humble, patient, bearing with one another lovingly. This must extend to those close to us, but our love can never fail to do something for others far away. In the Eucharist above all we are fed. Our food there is Christ, the miracle worker. We ask Him to transform our lives, multiplying our qualities a hundred fold.

Parishioners are now invited to park in this area for Sunday Masses in order to alleviate the parking problem on both sides of Pomona and Melody Drive.
