

MISSION SUNDAY. Today is the 50th Anniversary of Mission Sunday. Remember the needy in mission lands, that through your prayers and sacrifices the Mission Church may serve the spiritual and physical needs of our brothers and sisters around the world. Special envelopes for the second collection this Sunday have been mailed to all parishioners. We ask for your usual generosity in this collection.

PAINTING OF CHURCH BEGINS. Painting of the entire interior of the church will begin this week and last for about a month. During the painting and replastering work certain areas will be restricted during weekdays. However all services will continue as usual. The entire church will be available for all weekends and holydays. This will be the first painting of the church since its construction in 1965. Leakage and falling plaster were badly in need of attention. As soon as the painting project is complete the carpeting will be given a very thorough cleaning. Both projects should be completed by early December. We ask you to be patient with the inconvenience during these weeks. Cost of both projects (\$6300) will be taken from our deposited funds with the Archdiocese, not from our current operating budget.



LITURGY READINGS. Because Our Lord speaks in the language and imagery of apocalyptic, which is by its nature highly imaginative and symbolic, his words are not to be pressed for actual details of the end. What biblical faith does assert, however, is that human history lies under God's power, within the scope of his redemptive plan, and that one day it will be brought to an end so that the final phase of his Kingdom can succeed it. God's kingdom cannot be brought in by human effort. Our role is to prepare to receive it by accepting His graces in all events of our lives and to strive for those aspects of His Kingdom realizable now justice, peace, love. "Christ has died. Christ is risen, Christ will come again." The Eucharist stands as a perfect expression of our faith: it points back to the historical events of Christ's death and resurrection and forward to his return.







FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

LITURGY READINGS. When the Son of David comes, he'll put everything right. That's what the Lord can do in our own hearts, and will. Be alert and watch for him because he's really on his way. Advent is a time to wake up and notice the signs. Aren't there startling signs right around us? Virtue and justice struggling with the powers of evil even today? Perhaps we're not noticing, though the earth is skaking right under our feet. Today we're gathered together to find Christ. He makes himself present right here so that we may be strenghtened and may show him to others.

THE ADVENT WREATH. Never heard of an Advent wreath? It's a way of joining family prayer with the symbolism of the Church. Advent reminds us that there is still much darkness in the world. It is a darkness made up of sin, ignorance, hate and pride. To remind Christians of the growing power of Christ, the LIGHT, the Church has long made and used Advent wreaths. The wreath without beginning and end signifies eternity; the greens, life and growth; the four candles, three purple and one pink, represent the ages sitting in darkness and the shadow of death, each candle adding more light until on Christmas the light from the wreath sets off, as it were, the blaze of light on the tree of life, the Christmas tree, for the time is fulfilled. Where should you use your Advent wreath? In the room where Father, Mother and children work, play, read and pray together.



SECOND SUNDAY IN ADVENT

THE JESSE TREE. It looks very much like a Christmas Tree but it's not. The Jesse Tree is a special tree set up during Advent. It is the "Family Tree" of Jesus, and a reminder of the people who waited thousands of years for the coming of the Messiah, God's appointed Savior. It represents the genealogy of Christ beginning with Jesse, the father of King David. The idea for the Jesse Tree was taken from the prophet Isaiah: " a shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots a bud shall blossom". Each symbol on the tree reminds us of someone in the Old Testament. This tree has special meaning for us as we go through this Advent time of staying awake, alert, and preparing for the "coming of Jesus". It must have been difficult for our spiritual ancestors to wait, watch and hope for so many years. Yet their patience was rewarded far beyond their hope. So we too will be rewarded if we wait with hope in the midst of today's discouragement.
