CORPUS CHRISTI

LITURGICAL READINGS FOR CORPUS CHRISTI. Melchisedek, the priest, offers bread and wine in thanksgiving for victory (first reading). Jesus offers bread and wine as his priestly sacrifice (second reading). Jesus takes bread and blesses it and gives it to his apostles to distribute to the hungry crowd (gospel). We share in the priesthood of Jesus as the apostles did, by calling people together in the Eucharist, by sharing in the memorial meal and by continuing his work. In the Mass we proclaim the death of the Lord. We renew for ourselves the sacrifice of Jesus who gave us his body and blood. We continue the work of Jesus when we break bread and give thanks.


