

### SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS. One unifying thought in the readings for this Sunday's liturgy is the presence of the Lord. Abraham senses something special in the presence of the three visitors (first reading). Paul proclaims the mystery of the presence of Christ in us (second reading). Mary and Martha respond differently to the presence of Jesus in their home (gospel). As the believing Christian community we are aware of the presence of the Lord in our lives. This is our hope, the mystery that has been revealed to us, the mystery that we preach to others. When we gather at the Eucharist, we proclaim the presence of the Lord in the assembly, in his Holy Word, in the sacrament of his Body and Blood. We live in the presence of the Lord.



LITURGICAL READINGS. Because of God's kindness and mercy, and because of Abraham's prayer, God reduces the number of just men needed to save the city (first reading). God cancels the debt of sin and gives us new life in Christ (second reading). 



### TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

WISDOM is the gift of seeing things the way they really are. Left to ourselves, we barely understand nature, much less God. Only Christ can help us see all people as brothers and sisters, material things as temporary at best. For many, September means back to school, back to the struggle for knowledge. But knowledge of facts is useless without a perspective - a wide view of life that helps us think clearly about our relationships, our possessions, ourselves. Our weekly Eucharist helps us to put our lives in focus. We step back and take a look at all the things we do. Together, and in Christ, we sharpen our sense of values.








### C.C.D. UPDATE
