### TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE RIGHT-TO-LIFE is celebrated every October. During this month the beauty, the greatness and the gift of life are emphasized. Sunday's homilies will develop this theme. Following all of the Masses, CYO members will sell 1978 calendars depecting the theme of LIFE.

COMMUNION IN THE HAND is not a novelty. It is a return to a traditional practice. The Last Supper was a ritual meal, following the customs of the time. The first Christians continued to celebrate the Eucharist as a sacred, sacrificial meal. Communion in the hand was the universal practice then. Not until the ninth century does it become, in scattered places, the "privilege" of clerics. Nor did the gradual changeover to Communion on the tongue arise from a greater reverence for the Eucharist. The reasons for returning to Communion in the hand at this time are not merely historical. The option must increase reverence for the Real Presence. Good ritual actions should express and foster an interior spirit of worship. If Communion in the hand cannot do that for an individual, he should not abandon the practice of receiving Communion on the tongue.

### TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

DECENCY WEEK. Doug Allen, Jeff. Parish President, has proclaimed the week of October 16 Decency Week in the Parish of Jefferson. This initiates the program for Decency being sponsored by St. Angela Parish Council. The purpose of this effort is an AWARENESS of how deeply harmful pornography and violence are to our society. The current body of the law of the Supreme Court has, in effect, placed its confidence in the common sense of the American people in American Communities. It is up to citizens who are concerned with Justice and Decency to become informed and make known their desire for vigorous enforcement of existing laws. To this end a CALL TO ACTION meeting will be held in our church on Wednesday, Oct. 19, 8pm. Speakers will be Ivor Trapolin, an Attorney, who will outline dimensions of the pornography issue: John Mamoulides, Dist. Atty. for Jeff. Parish, who will speak on existing laws and enforcement; and Rabbi Kenneth Segal, Gates of Prayer Congregation, who will explain the role of informed, concerned citizens and what they can do to help establish Community Standards.

RELIGION PROGRAM FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. Parent group meetings to discuss textbooks being used in the religion program. Notes regarding meetings were sent home with children. All groups will meet in the Adult Center at times assigned. The number of subsequent meetings will be determined by the interest of the parents in pursuing this study. There are two identical sessions scheduled for the first week - one in the afternoon and one in the evening. You are invited to attend the one most convenient for you.

COMMUNION IN THE HAND is a recognition that the total person is holy. The Christian's whole self - soul and body - is consecreted by the indwelling of God through Christ and in his Spirit through Baptism. Communion in the Hand can be a striking gesture. If you will put your left hand on top of the right (if you are right-handed), and hold them out from the body, certain feelings are almost inevitable: a feeling of humble dependence as that of a trustful child accepting food from his parents; a feeling of wanting, desiring, seeking the Body of Christ, as St. Cyril said, "our hands make a throne of honor for our King; a feeling of patient expectancy, as a sign of confidence and trust that some person is going to give us something good". Communion in the Hand is a more active participation in the Liturgy. The reverent taking of the host is surely an active and meaningful gesture, when compared with the entirely passive reception of the host on the tongue.



### THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS. God is just and doesn't play favorites. But he does have a wider view than we. He sees men's hearts and listens to people we tend not to pay attention to. When friends abandoned Paul, the Lord was faithful. Even the tax collector's prayer was answered. There are so many abandoned people: old people, the physically and mentally handicapped, drunks and vagrants. We could never help them all. But we could do a little bit. We could bring God's love to at least a few. It is so hard to be kind to even one abandoned person. The strength to do it comes from beyond us. In the Eucharist we seek that strength.

MISSION SUNDAY, is this Sunday, the special day each year we dedicate to prayer and sacrifice for those millions in our human family who do not yet know and love Christ. As you receive Him in the Eucharist today, will you pray that His love will be felt throughout the world, and sacrifice, that those serving in the Missions will have the material means to Light the World with Christ! Old attitudes do not easily shift. Today's second reading and gospel relate to the latter of these: it is to be a day of deliverance for the faithful, a day of judgment for others. Yet the reading presents a different picture of the last days: all nations have accepted God's rule and obey his law; therefore weapons disappear and peace reigns. We ought to strive to see this vision of the end realized.
