Why Christ Came

- To fulfill the law (Matthew 5:17). Mankind agonized under the unbearable burden of law. Christ came to fulfill its types and meet its every demand, thereby making its promises come to pass. The unfinished became complete in Him.
- 2. To show what God is like (John 14:7-10; Hebrews 1:1-3). Man had lost the knowledge of God he once enjoyed in Eden, and had substituted idols—grotesque projections of himself. Now Christ would show us God's true nature—that He is holy and just, and a loving and merciful Heavenly Father who tenderly cares for His children.
- To light the way to God (John 12:46). Our pathway was dimmed by the darkness of sin and disobedience. The Lord Jesus came to show us the way to God through repentence and faith in Him.

- 4. To seek and save the lost (Luke 19:10; Matthew 18:11). Like lost sheep, we stumbled through the night of sin, needing One to come after us and bring us back into the fold.
- To give new life (John 10:10). Not only is man lost, he is dead in trespasses and sins (Ephesians 2:1). Christ came to give new life and power to all who believe on Him.
- 6. To give His own life (John 10:11,15).
 The cost of salvation is the shedding of blood. Christ came to die. He took our place on Calvary's cross, giving His life to redeem us (Hebrews 12:2).
- 7. To destroy the works of Satan (John 3:8; John 12:31). The devil works to blind and destroy us, and to keep us walking in the darkness. The Lord Jesus came to break Satan's stranglehold on us, and to help us walk in the light.

My friend, that birth in Bethlehem was God the Son coming into our world as a baby that He might redeem mankind. Right now He offers you the greatest gift of all—the gift of salvation. Have you received Him? Open your life to Him now. Accept Him by faith. He came for YOU!

Matthew applies it to Jesus, seeing now a deliverance from a bondage far deadlier than that brought by the Assyrians. The worst bondage is not that occasioned by military domination. Men are truly slaves when they are caught in the snares of sin and selfishness. Those who expected Jesus to be a political deliverer were disappointed and rejected him. Those who recognize the true difference between bondage and freedom acknowledge Him as the Messiah. When we are joined to Him we are truly free and are enabled to bring His freedom to others.



FEAST OF SAINT ANGELA

At the time when Angela Merici lived, man was awakening to a new conscicusness of his powers. Fascinated by the widening of horizons and increasingly aware of his creative genius, he had begun to claim an independence of the supernatural.

These were times of a self-styled humanism freed from the divine, confusing men's minds and weakening their moral sense. Deeply involved as she was with this world of contrasts so marked by moral suffering, Angela appears to us--a lovely figure of womanliness in her unswerving faith, her purity and her overflowing charity, winning all hearts through her devoted and far-reaching service of others.

Her simple country upbringing and the living example of her parents left their imprint on Angela. Hard work, so much a part of life in the country develops vigor, energy and strength of will. These together with a spirit of daring, marked her character to the end of her life.

Wealth and aristocracy never dazzled her. Though some of her dear friends included the rich and powerful families of Brescia, she kept a singleness of vision, wholly directed to the discovery of something willed for her by God, something foreshadowed but not yet known.

The clear sunlit beauty and the deep silence of the countryside found an echo in her spirit and awoke in her a need for light and for the infinite: a need for God. When she speaks of obedience, truth, knowledge of God or the happiness of heaven, all alike are expressed in terms of light. It seems to fascinate her.

Angela was a contemplative, captured by the Lord whom she sought and found everywhere, following him with love ever alert and faith ever discerning. "Everywhere" for her meant in long hours of prayer; and it also meant everyplace where she had a task to do; every person whom she met, regardless of age, sex or rank; every service that she rendered according to needs and circumstances. For at all times she acted under the influence of love, at once liberating and unifying, which in a single thrust

brought her to God and to her fellow men.

Living beside others, visiting them wherever there was suffering and need, welcoming them to her own poor home—bare of every comfort but filled with the presence of God—Angela led all to Him, helping them to discover the mystery of His saving love, and sharing with them her own out—going joyous spirit of hope. In the midst of a life of austerity, her whole person radiated joy springing from a firm faith and absolute trust in God.

Angela gave her friendship with no thought of self; simply and spontaneously she came to the help of the most unfortunate. Those who knew her learned from her what it is to be "human," open to all and to the whole person, with healthy optimism and genuine love. It was her way of showing the world that the kindness and love of God had appeared on earth.

Active and devoted laymen found in her an inspiring leader, deeply faithful to the Church, with a keen perception of all that concnerns man's salvation. Angela read the "signs of the times." Reading and interpreting them, she was led by the Spirit to undertake an entirely new form of work which gradually took shape as she moved on, step by step, in response to His call.

Nothing held her back: neither the uniqueness of the undertaking nor her deep-rooted humility, for she was certain that God himself wished to have in the Church—and at that particular time—a Company of consecrated virgins living in the world. And since He had chosen her to be their mother, although she saw herself as a "most inadequate and useless servant," she placed herself in His hands as a willing instrument.

Those who knew Angela saw in her a woman of prayer, in whom contemplation was intimately bound up with daily living and with her apostolate.

Today, too, we, who live under the patronage of Saint Angela in a parish dedicated to her name, have need of a living, dynamic fidelity which, in the midst of our present needs, discerns already the challenges of tomorrow and is ready to respond to them in yet new ways. Angela, always "in our midst" has traced for us the path of the greatest love and of perpetual renewal; and she invites us to go forward in hope and joy.



ACROSS THE NATION. Cities which have enacted zoning ordinances to combat obscenity are now experiencing an overwhelming growth in the number of obscenity outlets. Why? Because zoning for such outlets - - whether contained as in Boston's Combat Zone or scattered as in the Detroit plan - - permits the operation of such outlets and thereby negates existing anti-obscenity laws. An ordinance to permit zoning in Jefferson similar to the Detroit plan was cancelled at the last minute November 30th by the Jefferson Parish Council - "to permit further study and get more information from the public." It will come up again! Existing parish and state anti-obscenity laws are good, but they must be enforced. The recently enacted abatement of nuisance law permits the padlocking of such outlets. Do you want the existing laws enforced? Or do you want a new law to allow more obscenity outlets to open? Your Councilman wants to hear from you. Your signature on the petition opposing zoning for obscenity and calling for enforcement of existing laws will have the double advantage of informing your councilman and providing an excellent statement of community standards - - the basis of all anti-obscenity law. Copies of the petition will be available after the Masses this weekend for you to read and sign.



He seems to understand best of all those who are limping badly in their spiritual lives. This includes everybody...most of us will find our own description somewhere in this gallery of gimpy pilgrims.

MARY THE WOMB OF GOD A book by George A. Maloney S.J. that is a rediscovery of true devotion to Mary not as a speculative doctrine, but as an experience of what Father calls "Mary-Church" through which we can become open to God as Mary was and in touch with our destiny as Christians.

GROWING OLD IS A FAMILY AFFAIR Dorothy Bartolet Fritz begins her book "I had retired from a job I loved at 65 and had just passed my seventieth birthday. My mother and aunt who lived with me were in their nineties. Now to my surprise all of us had become part of a serious social problem." This book is oriented largely to men and women in their middle years—those persons chiefly responsible for the training of the young and the care of the old — IT IS ADDRESSED TO THEIR NEEDS AND OPPORTUNITIES.




