Religious Education Bulletin

We have come to the end of another school year at Saint Angela Merici. I wish to take this opportunity to thank all of the members of the parish who have been a part of the religious education program this year. We have had a very full year and the success of the various activities and projects has been, in a very large degree, a result of the cooperation I have received from teachers, parents and children.

This year we tried to encourage the total parish to be involved as a total community in the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. I am very happy with the response I received.

I want to thank, too, all of you who took part in our adult education programs: Father Douglass' Wednesday evening classes during Lent. The home discussions and Masses conducted by Fathers Favalora, Douglass and Kinney on Mondays during Lent; the Tuesday afternoon Scripture Study class sponsored by SALA; and the regular Tuesday morning discussion group. It is really evident that Saint Angela Merici Parish is made up of dedicated and interested parishoners who are deeply concerned in the spiritual growth of the parish community.

Our parish library in another area which is growing. This year, Sister Angela catalogued all of the books and has been able to help many find books that would aid them in their class work and in their personal spiritual growth. Several parishoners have contributed books to our library and we have procured some books through purchase. In September, you will find a number of new books on the shelves. One of our bulletins contained several book reviews. We hope to do this again early in the new year, or better to have one or more Book Review afternoons. If any of you is interested in reading and reviewing a book at one of these sessions, please contact one of the priests, Sister Angela or Sister Mary Magdalen. Again we invite you to come in just to browse or to read in the Adult Center, or to borrow books to take home to read. Next year, we hope to procure more books which young readers will find interesting.

Regarding Sacramental Preparation

At Saint Angela Merici, we have adopted the policy that Sacramental Preparation must take place in the parish for First Penance and First Holy Communion and in the Parish School, The Religious Education classes on Monday evening or in the Catholic Private Schools for the Sacrament of Confirmation. There must be two consecutive years of religious instruction in preparation for each of these sacraments. We will not receive children into the second or eighth grade CCD classes unless they have been registered in the CCD classes the previous years, or have transferred to a public school from a Parochial school. We have made this decision because we are convinced of the importance of these sacraments and that the preparation is vital to even a minimal understanding of what one is doing when one receives a Sacrament. We know that you as parents appreciate the importance of this decision.

Our Teachers in the religious education program continue to devote time to preparing themselves to do a good job working with your children. During the year 1978-79, it will be possible to have a class for any children in the parish with learning disabilities who could not find the help they needed in the regular CCD class. A teacher has prepared herself for this work. If any of you wish to discuss this with me, I will be available during the first part of August. We will set up classes at this time. I would like to remind the young people who will be seniors in high school next year that we have an excellent program in Marriage preparation for them. This is conducted by a young married couple, Dick and Jan Judlin. This is particularly designed for the CCD, but any seniors in the parish who do not receive this course in their high school program are welcome to be part of the class.

We will be needing new people in our program next year. We have special need for two seventh grade teachers in the CCD religion program. This meets on Monday evening. If anyone is interested in this or in any other phase of the program, or has suggestions as to how our parish program can be improved or developed, please get in touch with one of the priests, or with Sister Mary Magdalen. I will be back in the parish after the eighth of August.


