





LITURGICAL READINGS. In the first reading this Sunday, Solomon asked not for riches or a long life or power, but for an understanding heart. And the Lord was pleased with this request. When we experience a little bit of the wonder of God in our lives and in our prayers, about all we can say is, "Lord, how good it is for us to be here!"

GOD REMINDS us occasionally that his thoughts are far above ours. In the parable, his goodness goes beyond our concepts of justice. To live is Christ, even when his ways are mysterious and beyond our understanding. Jealousy is found in all humans, as though our neighbor's blessing meant a loss to us. We need to remember that all we have is a gift from God. If some appear more blessed than we, our attitude should be not jealousy but gratitude. Sharing in the Eucharist, we all share in the same Christ. When we receive him we recall that this is not a consequence of our goodness but of his goodness, extended to all.
