TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE BIBLE constantly reminds us of God's invitation to repentance and change. Even if we have said "no" to God, we can now say "yes". Not words but deeds count. We ask God to remember his mercies, not our sins. Implicit in this Sunday's liturgical readings is the need for humility. God "guides the humble to justice, teaches the humble his way." 





THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS. How times change. Today we might call the foolish virgins wise for not burning oil all night. (Gospel - Matthew 25/1-13) They were just conserving energy. In the Bible the unwise person was always rushing about not looking before leaping. The wise, examined life and knew that love of God was the source of all wisdom. Do we have wisdom or just a menagerie of facts, quotes and data which does nothing more than confuse us?





FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

NOW IS THE TIME to think about a truly "practical" preparation for Christmas. We don't need any urging to prepare for the externals of Christmas - that's feverish already. But we need to make some definite plans about 'Christian' preparation.


