Have you ever felt hemmed in? Pushed up against the wall? Confined in such close quarters that you couldn't breathe?

Let me share with you the true story of a young Christian mother who experienced these feelings and how she

responded to them.

It was December, the "joy" month, She lived in the small house which they had outgrown with the birth of their second child. Now there were three, and another was on the way. Her husband, a struggling young attorney, was doing all he could to make ends meet. But a move into a larger house just would not fit the budget.

This particular winter morning the weather was too harsh for the children to play outside for very long. So in they came, their wet boots, caps, and mittens turning the neatly picked-up room into a mess. Then the toys came out, and soon it was like the words of the popular song: "Saturday Morning Confusion."

Finally after struggling with the washing, fixing a lunch, and cleaning the kitchen, mother got the children to bed for their afternoon naps.

Blessed quietness! The tense young woman decided to catch a little shuteve as well. But as she walked to her room she stumbled over a wooden tov truck. Her pent-up emotions overflowed in the despairing cry, "No room! There's just no room!" In the silence she heard

her own words echo back to her. The tiny house, full schedule, and pressing needs of her family were getting the best of her. She couldn't believe she had spoken out with such rehellion

Then the radio softly played the holiday carol, "No Room," What a rebuke to her outburst! There by the chair she got down on her knees. "Lord, forgive me," she praved, "I have a wonderful Christian husband, three healthy children, a roof over my head, a carneted floor, and warmth from the cold. Yet I'm complaining because there's no room. Lord, that's what the innkeeper said so many Christmases ago. There was no room for You. You were born in a stable, and a manger was your cradle."

Before she could finish, one of the children awoke. Soon they were all going full-blast again. Then they began to quarrel. Everything was bedlam, Finally she rushed into her room, closed the door, raised an angry fist toward the ceiling and cried, "Lord, how can You do this to me?"

Then her look softened. Her arm fell. She realized that Satan was using her rebellion to bring frustration and turmoil. The Savior Himself had cried out to the Father, "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?" She knew that the Lord lesus had endured the agony and loneliness of the cross that He might complete the work of the Father and give us salvation. He was forsaken that we might never be alone.

So she gave in to the Lord. The crisis was over. She was again willing to let Him lead.

The trials and struggles of everyday living are part of the rugged road to eternity. But the Lord can make us all more than conquerors if we will turn our lives over to Him. So open your heart. Let Him in. He'll gladly enter and bring you peace-if you'll only give Him the room!
