FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

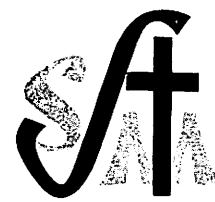

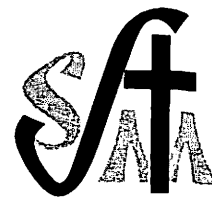

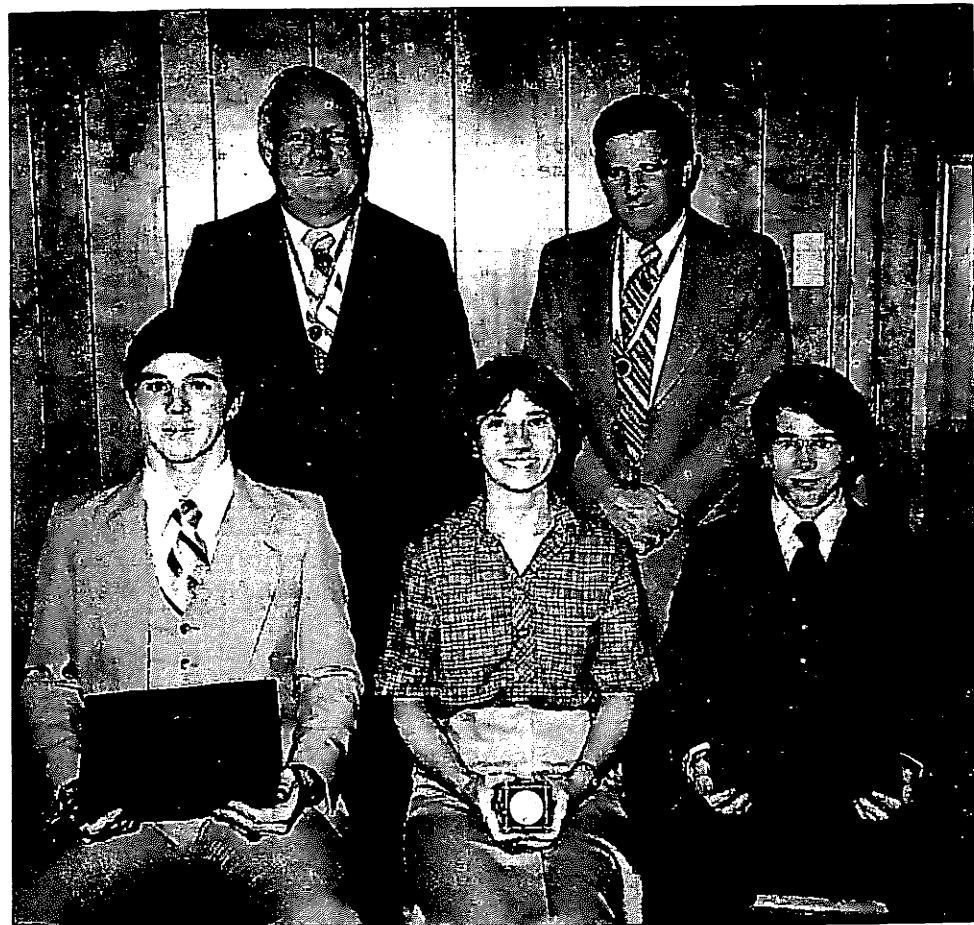

FATHER CALKINS leaves this weekend for his appointment as Associate Pastor at Immaculate Conception Church in Marrero. He will offer the 9:45 Mass here on Sunday, June 24, as a farewell. Parishioners are invited for coffee and donuts in the Adult Center afterwards where they may express their good wishes to Father. We deeply appreciate his being with us at St. Angela since January. His stay was most timely, helpful and spiritually beneficial to the parish. We ask God's blessing on him as he joins the Immaculate Conception Community.

SALA DONATIONS to the Parish were made this week: \$1750 for the furnishing of multi-purpose building; \$100 for School Scholarship Fund and \$200 for fence repairs in the schoolyard. We are grateful to the ladies of SALA for their generous support and for the efforts that made this possible. Their unselfish efforts have always been made for the welfare of the parish. Though they often go unnoticed as they work for the Lord's glory and not for their own, we do appreciate their spirit and cooperation.

IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS: During the summer the concrete parking facility behind the multi-purpose building will be completed, the schoolyard will be resurfaced, a fence will enclose the new property and building, and a new fence will replace the old one in the schoolyard. The Archdiocese has also granted us permission to replace our dying church organ. A new Allen Digital Computer Organ will be purchased and installed. These projects will be done at a cost of \$65,000. We have made a loan from the Archdiocese since at present we will be about \$50,000 in debt as we complete the new building. With your continued generosity we should be out of debt again by the spring of 1980. The various parish organizations are involved in fund raising projects that will serve to provide furnishings for the new building. We appreciate your support for this also.

FRIDAY, JUNE 22, is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and we encourage parishioners to attend Mass on this day.

WEEKDAY MASS-GOERS will notice some new vestments replacing some very old and frayed ones. We thank Mrs. Charmaine Todaro for making them.
