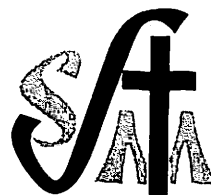

Parenting is like driving

Being a parent today is much like driving down a busy street. You must focus on your immediate situation — the cars in front of you, the stop light, pedestrians — in order to survive.

But you must simultaneously sweep the horizon for traffic signs, lane changes, and roadblocks ahead, so that you reach your destination safely and sanely.

OCCASIONALLY, you run into a driver who focuses only on the immediate surroundings. He never has any accidents but he's always in the wrong lane. He isn't sure how to get where he's going and he spends a lot of time detouring. He doesn't look down the road to see what's ahead so he can't plan for it.

This kind of parent focuses only on today. He's busy running his children to games and lessons without pausing to wonder why. He takes on his children's daily responsibilities like homework projects, scout badges, and paper routes, not seeing them as necessary to mature responsibility later on.

Occasionally, you run into drivers who are so intent on the road ahead they ignore traffic conditions around them. They whip in and out of lanes, make reckless turns, and daydream through traffic signals. They may know where they're going but when they get there, the trip itself is a hazy memory.

This kind of parent focuses only on that day when the children will grow up. He's so frenzied earning the good education for his children that he forgets to learn to know them when they're young. He works hard and long, too hard and long. He misses the little rewards of parenting — the intimate moments, the walks, the talks with the young child.

HE MAY HAVE that dream cabin or yacht trip in his forever starry eyes so that "when the children are grown" becomes a goal, not a wrench. His march to vice-presidency doesn't allow for insignificant things like his child's appendectomy or graduation.

The best driver, like the best parent, is one who balances the present and the future. He's alert to road conditions that change daily and drives accordingly. If there are hazardous drivers who slow up traffic by moving too slowly or who jeopardize lives by speeding and switching from lane to lane, he does what he can to minimize them. Maybe he shows his disapproval by an expression or a honk or maybe he asks for more signs and more patrolling to cut down unsafe driving conditions.

At the same time he is alert to conditions down the road. He reads the signs informing him of new routes and intersections. He yields when he should. He is prepared to stop. He doesn't daydream for blocks. He watches for roadblocks so he can choose the safest and best route with minimal difficulty. He knows where he's going and when he gets there, it's usually worth the trip.

So it is with the best parent. He's alert to signs and signals of change in his children. He may become irritated at the world around him or with his children and their friends but he strives to learn to parent in the midst of some hazardous situations. He tries to improve those situations. He yields when he must. He's always prepared to stop or to speed up if the situation warrants it.

HE WATCHES for roadblocks in his children's development so he can nudge them to adulthood with minimal anguish and complication. He knows constantly his destination — to turn out responsible young adults who can face the world confidently because they have strong beliefs in God, family, and themselves. If he reaches that destination, it's always worth the trip.

2. *Don't be intimidated by whiny or selfish behavior.* If you "lose your cool," or rush out to get the children what they think they want, you've lost the battle. Let the children know you're not interested in petty bickering or constant complaining. Show everyone that they can't pull childish maneuvers to get their way. You may have to ignore them or walk away. But they won't have you running in all directions to satisfy their whims, and they won't destroy your holiday happiness.

3. *Control those self-defeating habits.* Decide early that you're not going to consume too much food or overspend the family budget—then stick with your resolve. You'll be at peace with yourself, and everyone in the family will be happier. Resist high-pressure sales pitches, avoid impulse buying, and overcome the urge to take a second dessert. If you feel good about yourself, it'll be easier for the entire family.

Did you know that the sale of tranquilizers rises significantly during the holidays? And that attacks of depression increase, as well as suicide? Mom, you can have a happy and successful holiday season. It will be more beautiful and fulfilling for you if you'll put some of these suggestions into practice:

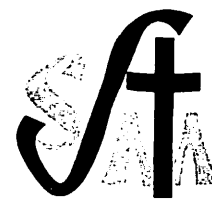

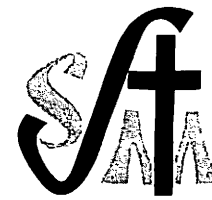

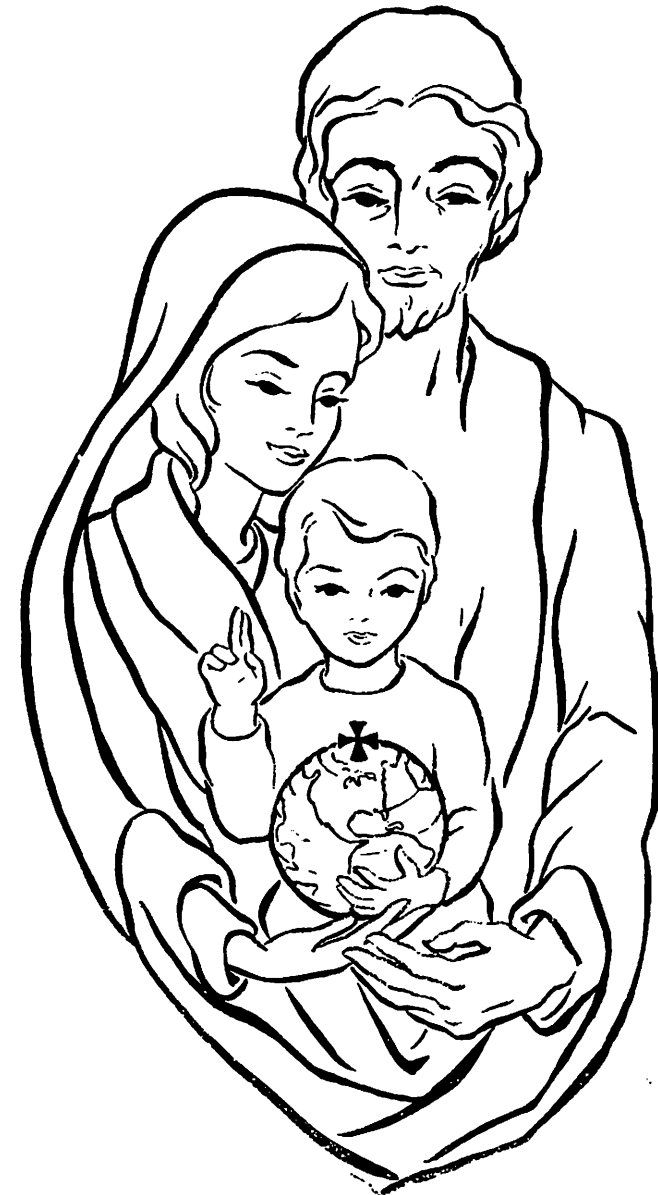
