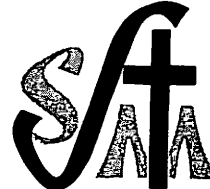

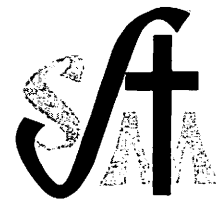

YEAR OF THE FAMILY

"Being aware of the actual conditions that the family of today has to face in our society on the one hand, and the possibilities created by a sound pastoral theology on the other, you have your work cut out for you," Archbishop Jean Jadot told those attending an October 24-26 national workshop on implementation of the U.S. Bishops' Plan of Pastoral Action for Family Ministry. The pastoral plan announced 1980 as the Year of the Family by the American Catholic Bishops, preceded in 1979 by a year of diocesan planning and followed by a decade devoted to continuing family-related research and the development of outstanding family programs.

In this year of the family, it is important for families to realize that "Much of the success or failure of improving the quality of family life depends upon them."

Family prayer, communication, exchange, and sharing with other families are essential for the growth of a family. Through this year of the family we hope to build a more communal church. The danger would be to concern ourselves with communities of individuals. The challenge the church offers to us in 1980 is to make of the parish a community of families.
