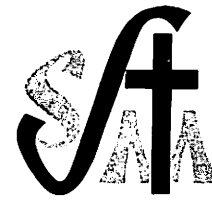

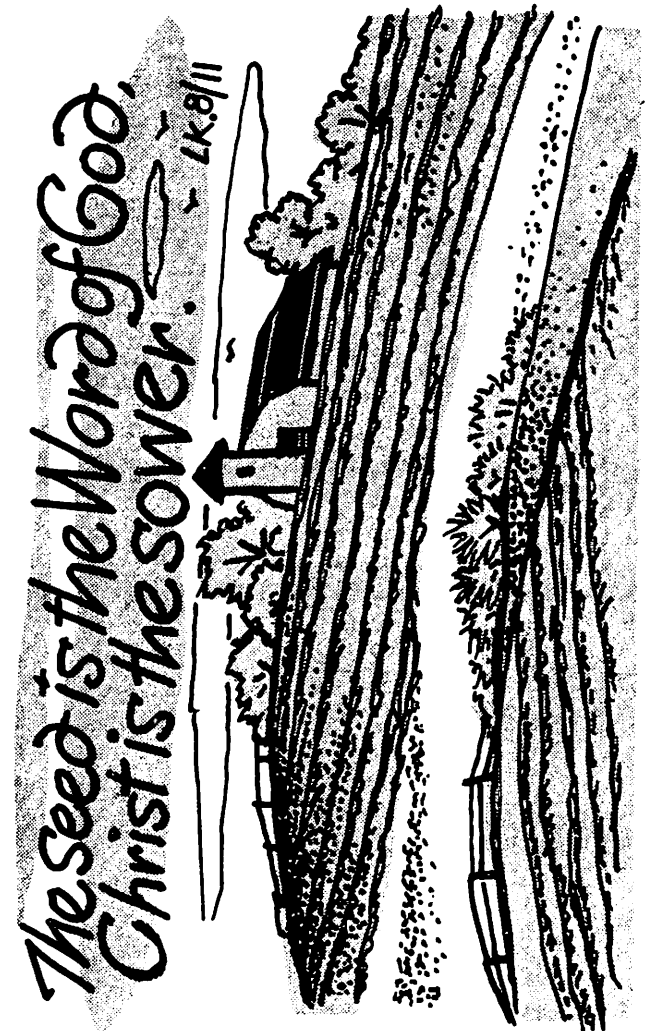

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS: In season or out of season, whether it is in fashion or out of fashion, the Church must preach the Word of God. It is about this word that this Sunday's readings speak. Our Lord compares it to a seed, showing that it will bear more or less fruit according to the response of those who hear it. For many of us, it is not in some great crisis that we lose God's Word, but by a gradual drifting away and neglect. If we neglect it, our whole life will suffer. If we respond to it, our lives will become true manifestations of the visible presence of grace among us.

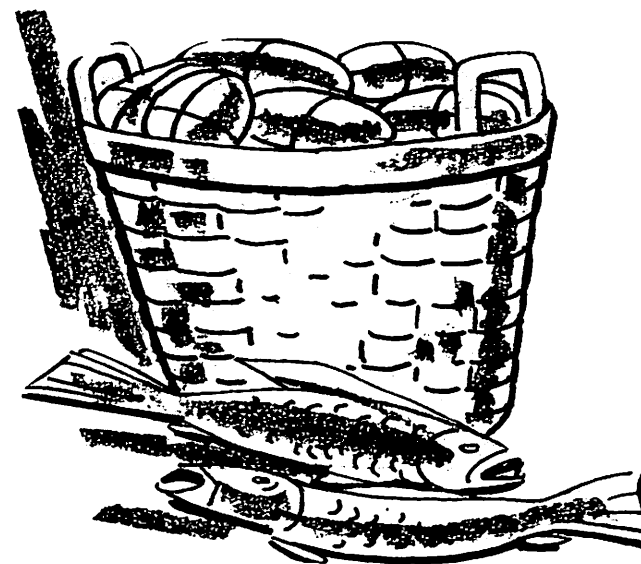

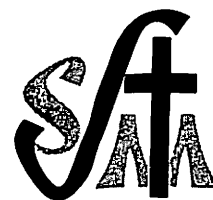

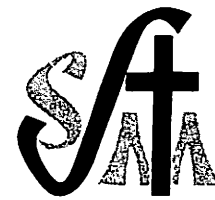
